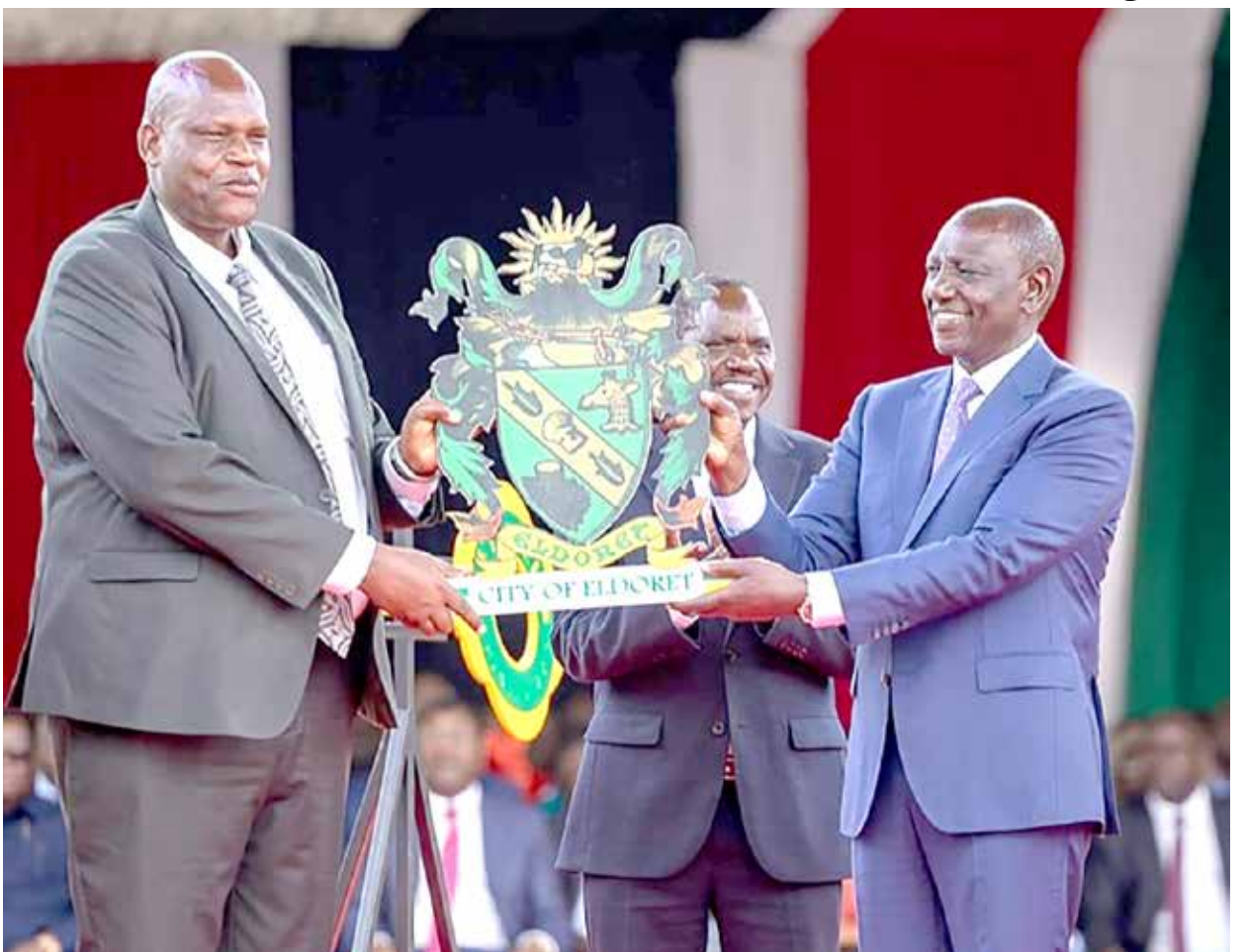

“Katika uvumbuzi wa huduma ya afya, tumeanzisha huduma za ndege zisizo na rubani katika Huruma Hub, na kuleta mapinduzi katika utoaji wa huduma za afya kupitia usafirishaji wa haraka wa vifaa vya matibabu na matokeo ya vipimo,” alisema. Mkuu huyo wa kaunti

Kenya yaimarika kutoka mwagizaji sukari na kuanza kujitegemea

Juhudi za Serikali za kufufua sekta ya sukari zimeanza kuzaa matunda, huku nchi ikiacha kugiza sukari kutoka nje ya nchi kuwa na uzalishaji wa kutosha kwa matumizi ya ndani na hata kuwa na ziada. Waziri wa Kilimo na Maendeleo ya Mifugo Dkt Andrew Karanja alisema mipango endelevu ya serikali ya kubadilisha sekta ya sukari imepata matokeo chanya, huku viwanda vya ndani sasa vikizalisha sukari ya kutosha kuki-dhi mahitaji ya ndani. Dkt. Karanja alisisitiza kuwa, mageuzi yanayoendelea katika sekta ya kilimo ni muhimu kwa kufikia malengo ya nchi ya viwanda, nguzo muhimu ya Ajenda ya Mabadiliko ya Kiuchumi ya Chini-Juu (BETA). Akizungumza jijini Nairobi wakati wa uzinduzi wa Mpango Mkakati wa

Mamlaka ya Kilimo na Chakula (AFA) 2023-2027, Waziri huyo alibainisha kuwa, ufanisi katika sekta ya sukari unahitaji kuigwa katika nyanja zingine ili kuhakikisha nchi inajitosheleza katika uzalishaji wa chakula. Dkt. Karanja alitoa changamoto kwa AFA kufanya kazi katika kupunguza muswada wa uagizaji wa chakula nchini huku akiahidi kufanya kazi na washikaduu wote ili kuhakikisha kuwa nchi ina uwezo wa kuwa msafirishaji wa chakula nje ya nchi. “Katika mpango mkakati mpya wa AFA, tunafaa kuja na mpango wa mawasiliano kuwafahamisha Wakenya kuhusu kile ambacho serikali inafanya. Mojawapo ya changamoto kama sekta, wizara na serikali imekuwa mawasiliano hafifu ambapo hatuwaunganishi hasa vijana kama Gen Z's na kuwafahamisha mambo

mengi mazuri yanayoendelea katika sekta hiyo,” alisema Dkt. Karanja. “Ukiangalia mipango iwe ni Vision 2030, Mkakati wa Mabadiliko na Kukuza Uchumi katika Sekta ya Kilimo (ASTGS), Mipango ya Muda wa Kati, Ajenda ya Mabadiliko ya Kiuchumi ya Chini-Juu (BETA) zote zinasisitiza jukumu kuu la kilimo katika kuimari-

sha uzalishaji, uchumi na kutengeneza ajira.” Katibu wa Kilimo Dkt. Kipronoh Ronoh alisema takwimu za hivi punde kutoka kwa sekta ya sukari zinaonyesha kuwa, nchi inazalisha tani 83, 500 kwa mwezi dhidi ya mahitaji ya tani 80, 000 ambayo inamaanisha kuwa kuna uzalishaji wa ziada ambao unaweza kusafirishwa nje ya nchi.

Dkt. Ronoh alisema kutokana na juhudi katika Ajenda ya Mabadiliko ya Kilimo, sekta ya sukari ni miongoni mwa sekta zinazowiana zaidi hivi sasa na kupitia mageuzi hayo ya AFA wameweza kutamka kuwa huku-takuwa na uingizaji tena wa sukari nchini. “Hii haijawahi kutokea nchini Kenya, ukweli kwamba tunaweza kuzalisha vya kutosha kwa matumizi ya ndani na kuwa na ziada ni ushahidi kwamba mageuzi katika sekta ya sukari yamefanya kazi na ninataka kupongeza AFA, wakulima wa miwa na viwanda kwa kufikia matokeo haya,” alisema Katibu. Alitoa wito kwa AFA kujinua katika ubunifu, teknolojia na uvumbuzi katika kuendesha kuelekea kufikiwa kwa mpango mkakati wao na kubuni bidhaa mpya ili kuvutia masoko mapya yanayoibukia. “Kwa mfano katika sekta ya chai, kuna haja ya kuja na bidhaa mpya za kibunifu ambazo zinavutia kizazi cha vijana ambao hawatumi tena chai ya kawaida nyeusi. Tuna-hitaji kuangalia bidhaa mpya za kibunifu kama vile chai ya kijani, zambarau, chai ya friji, chai ya barafu, chai ya hibis-

cus kati ya nyingine nyingi,” alisema Dkt. Ronoh. Mwenyekiti wa Bodi ya Wakurugenzi wa AFA Cornelny Serem alisema kuwa katika mpango mkakati wao wa 2023-2027 wamebainisha Maeneo Muhimu manne ya Matokeo (KRAs) ambayo yataongoza matendo yao na ni pamoja na kuimarisha usalama wa chakula, lishe na mabadiliko ya kiuchumi; Kubadilisha mnyororo wa thamani wa mazao kuwa biashara zinazofaa kibiashara; Kuimarisha uhakikisho wa ubora na usalama kwa mazao na mazao yaliyopangwa; na Kuimarisha ufanisi wa kiutendaji na uendelevu wa Mamlaka. “Sekta ya kilimo inachangia 21.2% ya Pato la Taifa la Kenya (GDP) na mchango mkubwa zaidi unatokana na uzalishaji wa mazao,” alisema Serem. Mkurugenzi Mkuu wa AFA, Dkt. Bruno Linyiru alisema kuwa mpango mkakati huo ni mwongozo unaozingatia majukumu yao kama ilivyoainishwa katika Sheria ya Mamlaka ya Kilimo na Chakula ya mwaka 2013. “Dira yetu ya kimkakati kama mam-laka ni kuwa mdhibiti wa mazao ya kiwango cha kimataifa kwa ajili ya uboreshaji maisha,” alisema Dkt. Linyiru.

The Board prescribes internal audit procedures and mainstreams best practices for good governance, internal controls and risk management.

Pursuant to the above mandate, the Board, in collaboration with key stakeholders developed the Public Sector Internal Control Guidelines. The Draft Guidelines aim to set a broad and standardized guidance for the public sector entities in developing effective and efficient systems of internal control that adapt to changing business and operating environments, mitigate risks to acceptable levels, and support sound decision making and governance of the entities.

In line with Article 10 of the Constitution of Kenya 2010, PSASB therefore, invites all stakeholders to provide comments on the **Draft Public Sector Internal Control Guideline** before finalization and validation for eventual issuance for adoption and implementation. Teknolojia hii ya mageuzi ilionyeshwa katika kambi ya matibabu bila malipo iliyo-fanyika katika Shule ya Msingi ya Kamureito, Kaunti Ndogo ya Sotik, Kaunti ya Bomet. Kwenye hafla iliyoandaliwa na Safari-com PLC, Wakfu wa M-Pesa, Zuri Health, Amref Kenya, na Hospitali ya Lion SightFirst Eye kwa ushirikiano na Serikali ya Kaunti ya Bomet, kambi hiyo ilianguzia jinsi AI inavyorekebisha huduma ya afya kwa kuwezesha utambuzi, ufuatiliaji na usimamizi wa mgonjwa. huduma kupitia teknolojia ya telemedicine. Kongamano la kwanza la Utalii la Pwani ya Uganda na Kenya lilifanyika Novemba 17, 2022, katika Hoteli ya Pride Inn mjini Mombasa, na kongamano la pili lilifanyika kuanzia Novemba 13-14, 2023, Diani, Kaunti ya Kwale. Kongamano la tatu la Utalii la Pwani ya Uganda na Kenya limepangwa kufanyika Novemba 20-21 katika hoteli ya kifahari ya Speke Resort and Convention Centre huko Munyonyo, Kampala. Serikali ya Uganda imezindua kampeni ya kuvutia wadau wa utalii na wawekezaji wasiopungua 500 wa Kenya kwenye hafla ya mwaka huu. Kampeni hiyo ilizinduliwa rasmi na Balozi Mdogo wa Uganda katika Pwani ya Kenya, Balozi Paul Mukumbya, pamoja na wadau wakuu wa utalii kutoka mataifa yote mawili mjini Mombasa. Akizungumza katika uzinduzi huo, Mukumbya alisisitiza dhamira thabiti ya Uganda ya kuimarisha uhusiano wa kitalii na Kenya. "Ukumbi wa mwaka huu unaonyesha jinsi sisi Uganda tunavyochochua kwa uzito soko la Kenya," Mukumbya alisema, akiwataka wadau wote wa utalii kujiandikisha kwa hafla hiyo. Alibainisha kuwa tovuti ya usajili tayari imeona zaidi ya usajili 300, na watajarajia idadi kufikia

kikomo cha washiriki 500 hivi karibuni. Dkt Sam Ikwaye, Mkurugenzi Mtendaji wa Chama cha Wahudumu wa Hoteli na Wahudumu wa Chakula cha Kenya (KAHC), alisisitiza umuhimu wa kukuza uaminifu na ushirikiano miongoni mwa wadau wa utalii, akibainisha athari chanya za safari za kufahamiana na shughuli za biashara kwa biashara zinazoweza hwa na mkutano huo. "Ngazi ya imani miongoni mwa washikadau imeongezeka, na kuwawezesha wendeshaji wa Kenya na Uganda kuendeleza na kubadilishana mawazo," alisema.

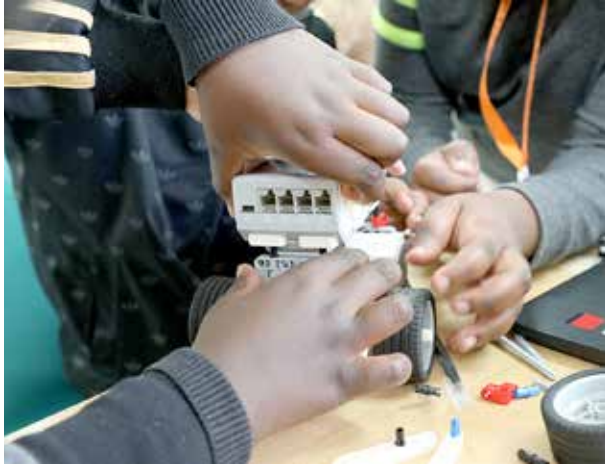

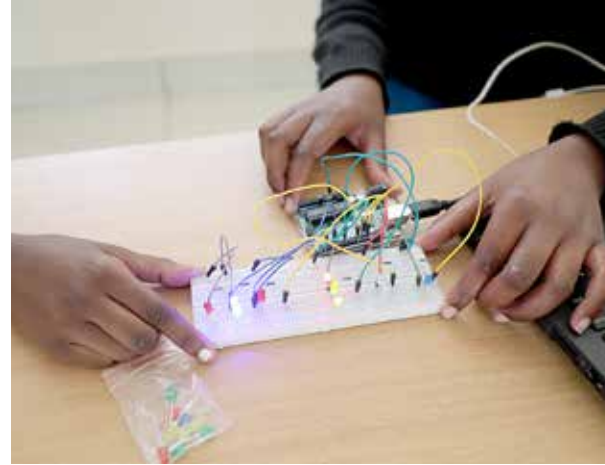

Mpango huu unaweze kana kutokana na ufadhili wa Mradi wa Pili wa Uboreshaji wa Makazi yasiyo Rasmi ya Kenya (KISIP 2). Akiwa na umri wa miaka 30, lakini akizungumza kwa nguvu ya mtoto wa miaka kumi na tano, Bi. Saphine ana uhakika kwamba hangefika kwenye mitaa yenye shughuli nyingi ya mji wa kando ya ziwa kama si mabadiliko chanya yaliyoletwa na KISIP's, afua, ambazo zinalinga zaidi kuleta adabu, utu na usafi katika makazi yasiyo rasmi ya Kenya. "Huwa nafunga biashara yangu jioni, lakini taa za mlingoti zinazozinduliwa leo zitaniwezesha kuendesha biashara yangu hadi usiku wa manane bila hofu ya kuvamiwa au kunyanwaswa. Hii itaniruhusu

kuongeza mauzo yangu," asema mjasiriamali mdogo kwa raha. Saphine pia anaonyesha matumaini kuwa uboreshaji wa barabara uliopangwa utaweze sha waendesha pikipiki (boda boda) kupata masoko kwa urahisi zaidi. Bi. Saphine ni mfano halisi wa maelfu ya wakaazi wanaoishi katika makazi yasiyo rasmi ya mijini nchini Kenya katika kaunti 33 zinazoshiriki ambao wanatazamiwa kufaidika na afua za KISIP, zinazoungwa mkono na Benki ya Dunia, Agence Française de Développement (AFD), na Umoja

wa Ulaya (EU), mshiriki wa hivi punde zaidi katika mradi huu mkubwa. Miezi mitatu iliyopita, alipokuwa akizungumza wakati wa uzinduzi wa Mpango wa Pili wa Kusaidia Miji ya Kenya (KUSP2), Rais William Ruto alisema kuwa utawala wake hautasimama chochote kusaidia Wakenya kuondoka katika makazi yasiyo rasmi. Mkuu wa Nchi alibainisha kuwa zaidi ya asilimia 60 ya Wakenya wanaoishi mijini kwa sasa wanatoka katika makazi yasiyo rasmi. "Ninasema haya kwa asilimia 60 kwa moyo mzito

sana kwa sababu makazi yasiyo rasmi ni machafu sana na maeneo yasiyofaa ambapo Wakenya wanaisi, na ni lazima tufanye lolote tuwezalo, kwa kutumia rasilimali tulizo nazo," akabainisha Rais. Kulingana na Mratibu wa Mradi wa Kitaifa wa KISIP 2 George Arwa, lengo ni kuboresha upatikanaji wa huduma za msingi na usalama wa umiliki wa ardhi kwa wakazi katika kushiriki makazi yasiyo rasmi ya mijini na kuimarisha uwezo wa kitaasisi kwa ajili ya kuboresha makazi duni nchini. "Tayari, tumeanza kutekeleza afua kadhaa kuhusu uboreshaji wa miundomsingi katika kaunti 23, ikiwa ni pamoja na kuhamasisha wanakandariasi na timu za kaunti. Kazi za uboreshaji zinazendeleva katika kaunti tano: Kakamega, Nakuru, Homa Bay, Kilifi, Kisumu na Nyamira," asema Mratibu wa Mradi huo ulioanza kutekelezwa Machi 17, 2021 na unatarajiwa kufungwa Julai 31, 2025. KISIP2 inatekelezwa katika kaunti 33 zinazoshiriki.

KWS kujenga ua wa ulinzi ili kupambana na migogoro ya binadamu na wanyamapori

Naibu Msemaji wa Serikali, Mwanaisha Chidzuga, amewahakikishia wananchi kwamba Shirika la Huduma ya Wanyamapori nchini (KWS) linashughulikia suluhu bora zaidi ili kukabiliana na mzozo kati ya binadamu na wanyamapori unaoathiri wakazi wanaoishi kando ya njia za wanyama. Akizungumza mjini Taru alipokuwa akisambaza chakula cha msaada kwa familia ambazo mashamba yao yalivamiwa na ndovu na mimea yao kuharibiwa, Chidzuga alisema kuwa mzozo kati ya binadamu na wanyamapori unaoshuhudiwa katika eneo hilo utashughulikiwa, huku KWS tayari ikifanya mipango ya suluhu la kudumu. "Kama Rais alivyotaja wiki jana wakati wa ziara yake katika Taasisi ya Kinango na Chuo cha Ufundi, maafisa wa KWS wako katika harakati za kujenga uzio mzuri wa kuwaweka wanyama porindani ya mbuga na kupunguza visa vinavyoongezeka vya migogoro kati ya binadamu na wanyamapori," Chidzuga alisema.

Alisisitiza kuwa serikali imejipanga kukabiliana na changamoto hiyo ili kuhakikisha wananchi wanaoishi kwa amani na kulima kilimo endelevu, ambacho ni muhimu kwa usalama wa chakula kulingana na mpango wa BETA. "Serikali imejitolea kukabiliana na changamoto hii ya migogoro ya binadamu na wanyamapori ili muweze kuishi kwa amani na kufanya kilimo endelevu kwa ajili ya usalama wa chakula kama ilivyoainishwa katika BETA," aliendelea. Hata hivyo Chidzuga pia alisema kuwa miradi ya serikali inalenga kuwawezesha wenyeji na kuboresha maisha yao. "Miradi hii ambayo inatekelezwa na serikali inakusudiwa kuwa fursa ya uwezeshaji ili iweze kubadilisha maisha yenu," alisema. Chidzuga alibainisha kuwa rais William Ruto amewahakikishia wakenya kuwa vituo vya JITUME vitakuwa katika kila eneo bunge ili kusaidia vijana kujikimu kimaisha.

Neti 480,000 zasambazwa W. Pokot kudhibiti malaria

Serikali imezindua usambazaji wa vyandarua kwa wakaazi wa Kaunti ya Pokot Magharibi kama sehemu ya mpango endelevu unolinga kukabiliana na ugonjwa wa Malaria kote nchini. Usambazaji huo ulizinduliwa na Naibu Gavana wa Kaunti ya Pokot Magharibi Robert Komolle katika Kituo cha Afya cha Kapkoris eneo bunge la Kapenguria. Naibu Gavana Komolle alieleza kuwa mpango huo unalenga kutoa jumla ya vyandarua 480,275 katika kaunti nzima, huku kukiwa na msisitizo hasa katika maeneo ambayo huathirika zaidi na malaria. Alibainisha kuwa mpango huo umeundwa kufikia kaya 111,903, na kunufaisha takriban watu 908,371. Komolle alisisitiza kuwa juhudi za usambazaji wa wavu ni sehemu muhimu ya mkakati wa kina wa kukabiliana na changamoto zinazoletwa na malaria na kuimarisha afya ya umma katika eneo hilo. Alisisitiza umuhimu wa ushiriki wa wananchi katika juhudi za kuzuia malaria na kuwahimiza wanajamii kukusanya vyandarua

vyao kutoka sehemu walizopangiwa kuvisambaza na kuvitumia ipasavyo. "Ukitumia vyandarua vyako ipasavyo, utakuwa na jukumu muhimu katika kupunguza kuenya kwa malaria katika jamii zako," Naibu Gavana Komolle alisema. Pia alisisitiza kuwa kutumia vyandarua ni hatua muhimu ya kujikinga na kuumwa na mbu, hasa wakati wa misimu ya kilele cha maambukizi. Naibu Gavana aliwataka wanajamii wote kuchukua jukumu la kujikinga na magonjwa kwa umakini ili kuimarisha afya na usalama wa familia na jamii zao. DG Komolle aliwakatisha tamaa wananchi dhidi ya matumizi mabaya ya vyandarua, ambavyo ni pamoja na kuvitumia kuinga kuku au kuwekea uzio bustani za jikoni. "Tumia vyandarua kwa madhumuni yaliyokusudiwa tu kwa vyandarua hivyo kuchangia ipasavyo juhudi za kuzuia malaria," alihimiza.

Vifaa vya ujenzi wa Bwawa kuu la Thiba vyasalimishwa kwa kaunti ya Kirinyaga

Mhandisi Mwasia alieleza kuwa NIA imejitolea kukuza uhusiano mkubwa na jamii, kwani mojawapo ya skimu zake kubwa za umwagiliaji, skimu ya umwagiliaji ya Mwea, iko katika kaunti hiyo. "Leo ni siku muhimu kwetu na kwa uhusiano wetu na Serikali ya Kaunti ya Kirinyaga. Tumefika hapa kwa kutii agizo la

Rais la kukabidhi vifaa hivi tulivyovianzisha wakati wa ujenzi wa bwawa hilo," alisema Mhandisi Mwasia. Wakati wa kuzinduliwa kwa bwawa hilo, Gavana wa Kirinyaga Anne Wairiguru alikuwa ameomba usaidizi wa Sh50 milioni kusaidia kaunti hiyo kubadilisha kituo hicho

kuwa kituo kamili cha matibabu ambacho Rais aliahidi kuheshimu. Bwawa hilo lilibadilisha mfumo wa ikolojia wa eneo hilo, na kusababisha magonjwa kama vile malaria na magonjwa mengine yatokanayo na maji na kusababisha kubadilishwa kwa ofisi na mali

zilizochwa kuwa hospitali. Naibu Gavana David Githanda ambaye alimwakilisha Gavana Wairiguru wakati wa hafla ya kukabidhi zawadi hiyo aliahidi kuwa kituo hicho kitatumika vyema kwa manufaa ya jamii. Githanda alitoa shukrani zake kwa uhamishaji mzuri wa mali hizo, akiangazia athari zinazowezekeza za kituo kipya cha matibabu kwenye huduma ya afya ya jamii alisema mali zilizokabidhiwa ni pamoja na nyumba sita zilizojengwa tayari, nyumba tisa za uashi, mabweni mawili, na mabweni manne yaliyotengwa. Nyumba, zote ziko katika hali nzuri. Hata hivyo, uhamishaji wa ardhi ambayo mali hizi zipo utahitimishwa baadaye kwa mujibu wa Sheria ya Usajili wa Ardhi Namba 3 ya 2012.
