Serikali imeanzisha marekebisho ya kina ya mashirika ya udhibiti wa serikali ili kunyoo-sha utoaji wa huduma, kuimarisha viwango, na kuzuia kupotea kwa mali ya umma.

Akizungumza wakati wa kongamano la kutathmini hali ya kampeni ya kufufua na kuwezesha mamlaka za udhibiti na mashirika, Mkuu wa mwaziri Musalia Mudavadi alisema mamlaka za udhibiti zina jukumu muhimu katika kuhakikisha utendakazi mzuri wa mashirika ya serikali.

# Makavazi ya Kitaifa yageuza jengo la wamishonari la miaka 120 kuwa kitovu cha kitamaduni cha kijiji

NA EMMANUEL MASHA (KNA)

Kijiji cha Ngao katika Kaunti ya Tana River kiko tayari kupokea jumba la makumbusho la jamii, kutokana na kazi za ukarabati zinazofanywa na Makavazi ya Kitaifa ya Kenya kwenye jengo la wamishonari ambalo lina umri wa zaidi ya miaka 120 ndani ya kijiji hicho. NMK imepata ruzuku ya Sh2.7 milioni kutoka Heritage International yenye makao yake Ugiriki na imeanza kazi za ukarabati wa jengo hilo lililojengwa kati ya 1900 na 1902 na wamishonari wa Ujerumani. Jengo hilo lilitumika kama sehemu ya kuzindua kazi ya uinjilisti miongoni mwa Wapokomo wa Tana River baada ya jaribio la awali la kuinjilisha Wagalla (Orma) kushindwa. Mkurugenzi Msaidizi wa Makumbusho na Makaburi wa NMK anayesimamia eneo la Pwani, Bw. Athman Hussein, alizuru jengo lililo katika Kaunti Ndogo ya Tarasaa mapema wiki hii kutathmini maendeleo ya kazi zinazoundelea. Alitangaza kwamba jengo hilo lingegeuzwa kuwa jumba la makumbusho ndogo na kufanywa sehemu ya mzunguko wa utalii unaojumuisha makaburi matatu ya vita vya kwanza vya dunia huko Garsen na Kanisa la Methodist lililo karibu. Bw. Hussein pia alitembelea jengo la Kanisa la Methodist lililotelekezwa (lililojengwa kati ya 1903 na 1906), ambalo



liko katika hali mbaya sana, na akatangaza kwamba NMK itaanza ukarabati wake baada ya kazi ya nyumba ya wamishonari kukamilika. "Lengo letu ni kukarabati jengo zima (nyumba ya wamishonari) na kuli-

ili waendeleo kupokea usikivu kutoka kwa Serikali na washirika wengine. "Usalama wa Kenya uko sawa. Waziri wa Masuala ya Ndani Prof Kithure Kindiki amesaidia kurejesha usalama katika eneo la Kaskazini mwa Bonde la Ufa na Lamu. Itae-

ndelea ili serikali itengeneze mazingira mazuri ya kuvutia uwekezaji na utalii. Kenya ni nzuri tena, tuna utulivu wa kisiasa." kila mtu anae-ndelea na shughuli zake, na tumerejea katika mkondo ufaao wa maendeleo ya kiuchumi," Bw Gachagua alisema.

"Wekeza nyumbani na haswa katika mpango wa nyumba. Nyumba hizo ni za bei nafuu, na malipo yanaweza kulipwa kwa muda mrefu. Hata hatahisi unalipia," alielea.

Hatua hii inalenga kuimarisha uendelevu wa kiuchumi kupitia uhifadhi wa mazingira.

Wakati wa uzinduzi wa Awamu ya Tatu ya Hazina ya Kaboni ya Jamii na Shirika la Northern Rangelands Trust (NRT) katika hoteli ya Nanyuki, Gavana wa Laikipia Joshua Irungu alisifu jamii katika kaunti hizo nne, akitaja manufaa ya juhudi zao za kuendelea kuhifadhi mazingira katika eneo hilo. "Tunashukuru kupokea pesa kupitia biashara ya kuondoa kaboni, na wakazi wanapaswa kuelewa kwamba kwa kuhifadhi mazingira yetu, tutaendelea kupata manufaa," Irungu alisema. Alibainisha kuwa kati

ya jumla ya Sh379 milioni, kaunti hiyo ilipokea zaidi ya Sh12 milioni kutoka kwa NRT, ambazo zitatumika kuanzisha miradi ya maji katika Kaunti Ndogo ya Laikipia Kaskazini. Mkurugenzi wa mipango ya kaboni wa NRT Rangelands Mohamed Shibia alisema kuwa Kenya ilizalisha kaboni ndogo zaidi duniani na akaongeza kuwa jamii zimejitolea kuhifadhi ardhi za malisho kupitia ulishaji wa mzunguko.

"Huu ni mradi wa wafugaji kuboresha mashamba yao ya malisho na kuondoa kaboni kama njia ya kisasa ya uhifadhi wa nyanda za malisho. Kaboni angani ndiyo inayochangia mabadiliko ya hali ya hewa na hilo ndilo tunalojitolea kushughulikia," Shibia alisema.

Alifichua kuwa, mradi wa kaboni wa Northern Rangelands, ambao ni mradi mkubwa zaidi wa kuondoa kaboni, unakadiriwa kuondoa zaidi ya tani bilioni 50 za gesi ya kaboni katika miaka 30 na kuzalisha fedha kwa jamii za wafugaji. "Tunafanya kazi na wafugaji wa ng'ombe kuchanganya njia za jadi na za kisasa za malisho ya mifugo, kurejesha nyasi za savanna," alieleza.

### THE REGULATORY IMPACT STATEMENT IN THE MATTER OF PUBLIC PARTICIPATION ON:- THE DRAFT AFFORDABLE HOUSING REGULATIONS 2024

#### 1. A Statement of the objectives of the proposed Affordable Housing Regulations, 2024

The Proposed draft Affordable Housing Regulations 2024 seek to facilitate full operationalization of the Affordable Housing Act in the development of affordable housing, institutional housing and associated social and physical infrastructure across the country. The main objective and reason for the proposed Affordable Housing Regulations, 2024 is to operationalize Affordable Housing Act, 2024 and provide clarity on its implementation.

Specifically, the Regulations seek to:-

- Provide for eligibility, application, validity and revocation of exemptions from imposition of the Levy under section 6 of the Act
- provide the criteria for application for allocation and re-allocation in case of default of an affordable housing unit under section 48
- prescribe the requisite deposit for affordable housing unit under section 49(2)(a)
- Provide for inclusivity, and diversity within affordable housing schemes pursuant to Section 59(2) (i) of the Act
- Provide for the criteria for change of affordable housing unit under Section 59(2);
- Provide for loan interest rate or administration fee under section 51 of the Act
- Provide for procedure relating to off-take of affordable housing units;
- Provide for the eligibility criteria to enter into an agreement to develop institutional housing
- Provide for the application procedure for approval to develop institutional housing through implementing agencies
- Provide for eligibility to enter into agreement to finance off-take, application for approval
- Provide for application for approval to offer off take
- Provide clarity on development of associated physical and social infrastructure
- Provide for conduct of Public participation by the Board
- Provide for notice of affordable housing on settlement
- Provide for withdrawal of voluntary savings under Section 52;
- Provide for rural affordable housing unit
- Provide for restrictions on disposal of affordable housing unit.

#### (2) The effect of the proposed Affordable Housing Regulations 2024 include the following:

- The proposed regulations will provide guidance on the implementation of the provisions of the Affordable Housing Act 2024.
- The implementation of the Regulations will ensure achievement of the Government housing commitment which is to turn housing challenge into an economic opportunity; and ensure housing production to create quality jobs for the 100,000 or so young people graduating from TVETs every year directly in the construction sector and indirectly through the production of building products.
- These Regulations will facilitate achievement of the economic and social rights guaranteed in Article 43(1)(b) of the constitution through:
  - increasing the supply of housing to 250,000 per annum; increasing the supply of affordable homes from 2 per cent to 50 per cent;
  - structuring affordable long-term housing finance schemes;
  - growing the number of mortgages from 30,000 to 1,000,000 by enabling low-cost mortgages;
  - strengthening Jua Kali industry capacity to produce high quality construction productions and materials; and
  - Providing for collaborations and partnerships with developers to participate in the affordable housing program
- The enactment and implementation of these regulations will open up affordable home financing for development of sustainable fully serviced affordable housing schemes with integrated communities and households with all the requisite social and physical infrastructure.
- These Regulations will cushion Kenyans against high rentals; high lending rates by financial institutions therefore promoting home ownership across the Country.
- The Regulations will further provide for charging of an affordable and sustainable home financing on loans to cushion the vulnerable from largely inaccessible lending
- The Regulations will guard against market distortions by ensuring that envisaged partnerships with the Fund, are not exclusive or preferential and do not confer market advantage to any partners over competitors.
- The implementation of the Regulations will enable the Government to enhance economic participation of special interest groups and micro, small and medium enterprise in the creation of jobs and general economic development.
- Further, the Regulations will promote economic growth by linking MSMEs and Jua Kali sector to the affordable housing projects.

#### (3) Possible alternative and practicable means of achieving the foregoing objectives, including other regulatory as well as non-regulatory options:

The Affordable Housing Act under Section 59 gives powers to the Cabinet Secretary in consultation with the Board to prepare and table the regulations within 30 days of commencement of the Act. The preparations and submission of the Affordable Housing regulations 2024 to parliament is therefore a legal requirement under the Act and thus does no other option is available.

#### (4) Assessment of the costs and benefits of the proposed Affordable Housing Regulations, 2024 and of any other practicable means of achieving the same objectives;

The implementation provides a framework for the delivery of Affordable Housing and Institutional Housing. The implementation of the proposed Affordable Housing Regulations, 2024 may have some potential challenges. The resultant effect may include an increase in the cost of business that may adversely impact businesses that are financially weak.

It will also however create employment opportunities for businesses in the Real Estate sector or businesses supporting the Real Estate sector owing to increased opportunities. Further the lack of adequate capacity by some of Kenyans to acquire and be allocated affordable housing units due to lack of income to support the repayments of the allocated unit may result in (i) default by unit purchasers that may affect the Fund and subsequent repossession of the units where it is impracticably possible for a unit buyer to remedy the situation; (ii) Non-performance by the implementing agencies who have been entrusted to implement the affordable projects under the Affordable Housing Act, 2024; and the risk of inadequate affordable housing units in the initial period of the program.

However, enactment of the proposed regulations will not occasion any additional costs towards implementation, as it seeks to further provide clarity on the implementation of the various provisions within the Affordable Housing Act, 2024. The proposed Regulations seek to provide a robust implementation mechanism for provisions identified under Section 59 (2) and further enable better implementation of the Act. The development of the proposed regulations therefore will create a positive impact in the achievement of the intended objective of the Affordable Housing Act, 2024.

#### (5) Any other matter specified by the Regulations

The proposed Regulations provides the basis for effective and structured way of undertaking development of affordable housing and provision of affordable homes to Kenyans. The regulations provides a well cordinated approach and application for off take thus incorporating the private sector in provision of the affordable housing. The regulations also provides flexibility for innovation and eligibility across income levels as well as provisions for voluntary savings towards home ownership. Lastly, the regulations also encourage participation of implementing agencies from National and County Governments.

#### (6) Draft copy of the proposed statutory rule.

Bandari ya Mombasa imekaidi msukosuko wa kiuchumi wa kimataifa na kuwa na utendakazi bora katika kipindi cha miezi kumi na miwili iliyopita kwa kuongeza upitishaji wa shehena bandarini kwa asilimia 6.2 na kufikia tani 35.98.

Ukuaji huo unachangiwa na ongezeko kubwa la shehena za kontena, ambalo lilisababisha kupanda kwa kasi kwa asilimia 14.8, na kuchangia zaidi ya nusu ya mizigo inayoshughulikiwa katika Bandari hiyo.

Mkurugenzi Mkuu wa Mamlaka ya Bandari ya Kenya (KPA), Kapteni William Ruto, alisema bandari hiyo pia ilisajili ukuaji wa asilimia 11.9 katika idadi ya makontena, na kufikia jumla ya kontena milioni 1.62 za futi ishirini.

Ruto alisema ukuaji huo ulitokana na kuboreshwa kwa nyakati za kubadilisha meli, ushughulikiaji wa makontena, na muda wa kushughulikia lori, ambazo zimeonyesha kuimarika.

KPA, alisema, itaendelea kuboresha ufanisi wa utendakazi kupitia upanuzi wa uwezo na juhudi za kisasa ili kukidhi mahitaji yanayokua ya biashara.

Hii, alisema, itahakikisha kwamba Bandari ya Mombasa iko katika nafasi nzuri ya kudumisha hadhi yake kama mhusika mkuu katika biashara ya kimataifa.

Msitu huo, ambao sehemu yake kubwa kwa sasa iko chini ya uzalishaji wa Kawi ya mvuke, na Shirika la Maendeleo ya Kawi la Mvuke, utakuwa eneo kubwa zaidi la kiikolojia la mijini barani Afrika, na ufu-fuaji wake unakusudiwa kuuweka kwenye ramani ya utalii wa ikolojia.

## PUBLIC NOTICE

### FRAUDULENT ACTIVITIES BY KEBS IMPERSONATORS

It has come to the attention of the Kenya Bureau of Standards (KEBS) that certain individuals, working for a private company going by the name **Multi-Works and Rights Enforcements Co. Ltd** which identifies as a **consumer rights/protection organisation and purports to be affiliated with KEBS**, are defrauding Kenyans under the guise of conducting product inspections in retail outlets that, allegedly, are in breach of the Standards Act and enabling legislation.

KEBS has received numerous complaints raised against the afore-mentioned organisation by retailers across the country. These complaints range from invasion of business premises, seizure of goods, on-the-spot fines, solicitation of bribes, to arrests and detention of the individuals in charge of the retail premises for the sake of extorting ransom money from them.

**As the government premier conformity assessment body in the country, KEBS places high premium on its reputation, security and trust of its stakeholders, including the business community. We therefore advise the public as follows:**

1. When KEBS staff are out of station in the execution of its legal mandate, which includes conducting market surveillance, they **officially identify themselves** and, where applicable, produce the Certificates of Appointments and KEBS Staff Identification Cards confirming authenticity of the assignment. This identification can be further confirmed by sending an **SMS with HR#Staff Number to 20023**.
2. KEBS routinely conducts market surveillance as per its approved workplans, where goods available for retail in markets are sampled for analysis, and conducts entry, search and seizure activities pursuant to the Standards Act, **KEBS does not impose on-the-spot penalties/fines, neither does its Inspectors possess arresting powers**. In addition, during a market surveillance field inspection activity, and in line with the provisions of the Fair Administrative Action Act, KEBS Inspectors issue Sample Collection Forms and Seizure Notification Forms to culprits and give them sufficient timelines to respond to KEBS findings.
3. KEBS is not affiliated with **Multi-Works and Rights Enforcements Co. Ltd and persons purporting to be employed by the organisation**, who have gone around the country impersonating KEBS Inspectors and conducting illegal activities in the name of KEBS ranging from invasion of business premises, illegal seizure of goods, illegal on-the-spot fines, solicitation of bribes, to arrests and detention of the individuals in charge of the retail premises for the sake of extortion. **KEBS is consequently engaging with the relevant authorities with the aim of instituting criminal proceedings against the organisation, its members and its enablers.**
4. Economic operators confronted by individuals claiming to work for KEBS, who fail to identify themselves and their assignment as described here in above, and who conduct illegal invasion of business premises, illegal seizure of goods, illegal on-the-spot fines, solicitation of bribes, and illegal arrests and detention of the individuals with the aim of extortion, should immediately report the matter to **KEBS during working hours from 8.00 AM - 1.00 PM and 2.00 PM - 5.00 PM, Monday to Friday through Toll-Free Line 1545 and the DCI through Toll-Free Line 0800 722 203**.
5. Please note that payments for KEBS services are made **ONLY** via the E-Citizen platform, using the pay bill number 222222. **Do not send money to individual mobile phone numbers.**

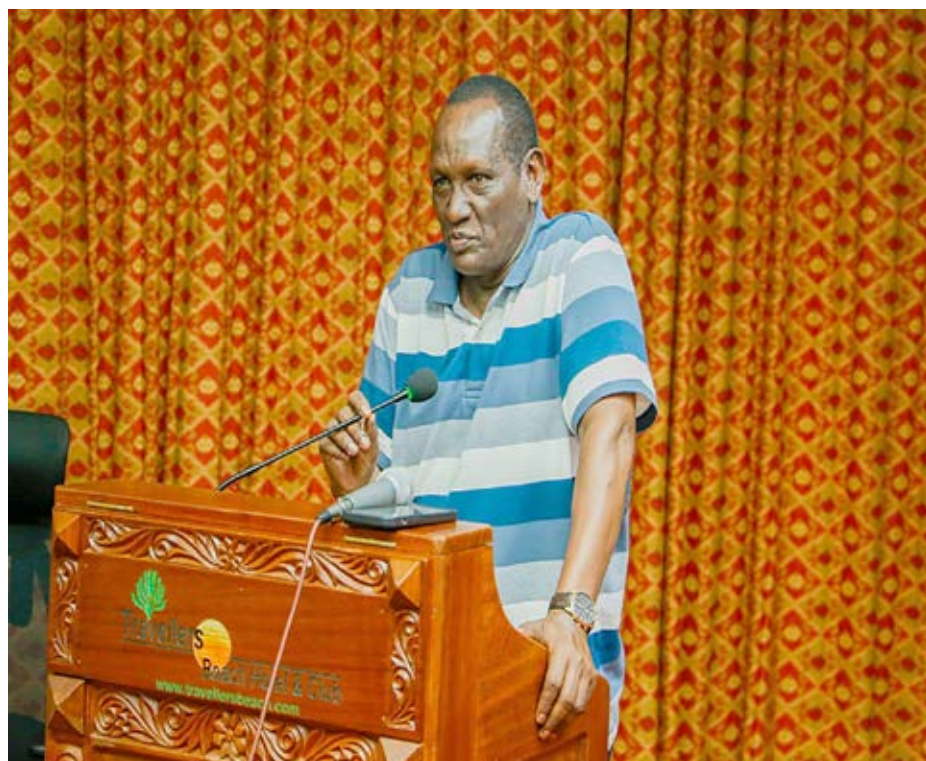

## Government to support gender-responsive interventions to climate change

The Government has underlined its commitment to support gender-responsive approaches to mitigate the effects of climate change among men, women and children.

To achieve this, the Government wants to design appropriate interventions which highlight the differential impact of climate change on different genders through their varied interactions with the environment.

Speaking while officially opening the Pre-SB 60 Strategy meeting to chart the continent's Unified Climate Action Agenda, Gender and Affirmative Action Principal Secretary, Ms Anne Wang'ombe said the Government recognizes that climate change does not affect everyone equally and any meaningful climate action must prioritize gender-responsive approaches to ensure inclusivity and equity.

“Climate change disproportionately impacts

women and girls, particularly those in marginalized and vulnerable communities.

We have the daunting task of addressing the climate crisis while striving for gender equality and social justice. I am confident that together we can overcome these challenges,” said Ms Wang'ombe.

The PS lauded the meeting's convener, the African Group of Negotiators Expert Support (AGNES), for successfully completing the first National Gender and Climate Change vulnerabilities hotspot mapping exercise which highlights how the effects of climate change are often shaped by aspects such as socio-economic status, access to resources and gender inequalities.

“We believe that the conclusions and recommendations of this mapping exercise will go a long way in informing appropriate interventions in the target sectors of Water, Energy and Agriculture, with a hope to

extend the same to other sectors in future.

The findings will further be very useful to our upcoming National Gender and Climate Change Action Plan that ought to be informed by current data from across sectors,” said the PS.

Ms Wang'ombe called for unified efforts and forging of a common agenda in confronting the climate crisis and to amplify the voices of women and other vulnerable groups so as to integrate gender perspectives into our climate policies and actions.

The Africa Group of Negotiators Experts Support (AGNES) strategy meeting is meant to deliberate and formulate a unified position of the African climate agenda based on the outcomes of COP28 which underscored the need to address gender, health, agriculture, water security among other components, ahead of the sixtieth session of the Subsidiary Bodies (SB 60) to be held in Germany in June this year.

Kwa mujibu wa Sheria ya Madini ya mwaka 2016, serikali ina mamlaka ya kupata asilimia 10 ya hisa za Riba Zilizobebwa kwa ajili ya shughuli kubwa za madini. Katibu wa Idara ya Mambo ya Nje ya Madini, Elijah Mwangi, anasema msukumo usiokoma wa kuanzishwa kwa vituo vya kuongeza thamani ya madini nchini Kenya ni kiini cha mageuzi yanayotarajiwa katika sekta ya madini. Anasema kuwa wachimbaji wadogo ambao wanashikilia nyadhifa za chini kabisa katika mfumo wa ikolojia wa uchimbaji lazima wapate haki zao zinazostahiki kupitia faida iliyoimarishwa kutokana na biashara ya dhahabu iliyoachakatawa. Anabashiri kuwa kiwanda hicho cha kusafisha sio tu kitatengeneza nafasi za kazi kwa maelfu lakini pia kitavutia maendeleo zaidi katika eneo hilo. “Azimio letu thabiti limekuwa kuwa na wachimbaji madini wapate thamani ifaayo kwa bidhaa zao. Hili litawezekana kwa kukuza vitega uchumi ambavyo vitachakata madini na kusababisha bei nzuri ya madini yao na kutengeneza ajira.

**Jumuiya ya wenyeji pia imeletwa kama washikaduu wakuu katika mchakato huo,” Katibu**

Haya ni matokeo chanya ya vifaa vya uongezaji thamani katika sekta ya madini,” alieleza. Kiwanda cha Kusafisha Dhahabu cha Kakamega kinakuwa mkataba mwingine mkuu wa uwekezaji na serikali baada ya kutiwa saini Februari kwa kandarasi ya Sh4.8 bilioni na Soy-Fujax Limited ya kufufua Fluorspar Mining katika eneo la Kimwarer katika Kaunti ya Elgeyo Marakwet. Kulingana na Utafiti wa Kiuchumi wa 2022, wastani wa uzalishaji wa dhahabu nchini Kenya kutoka 2017 hadi 2021 ulikuwa kilo 360. Sehemu kubwa ya uzalishaji huu ilifanywa na wachimbaji wadogo ambao idadi yao inakadiriwa kuwa zaidi ya laki mbili. Hata hivyo, kusekana kwa soko zuri na unyonyaji wa daima unaofanywa na madalali wasio waaminifu kumewaweka wachimbaji wadogo kwenye maisha ya ufukara. Ni mzunguko huu ambao serikali inataka kuvunja na kuingiza faida katika biashara zao. Uwekezaji wa pamoja wa mwekezaji huyo, Kampuni ya Uchina ya Heng Nuo Rongchang Trading Company na H. Nuo Kenya Company Trading Limited, utaona ujenzi wa kinu na maabara ya madini kwenye eneo hilo. Ili kukuza uendeleo wa kiutendaji, mwekezaji anapanga kuingia ubia na vyama vya ushirika vya uuzaji vya wachimbaji dhahabu ili kupanua usaidizi wa kiufundi wa vifaa kwa ajili ya kuongeza tija ya kila siku.

## Walinzi Pwani ya Kenya waongeza doria vitisho vikiongezeka Bahari ya Shamu

Ili kukabiliana na uvuvi haramu na kuzuka upya kwa uharamia katika Bahari ya Shamu, Huduma ya Walinzi wa Pwani ya Kenya (KCGS) inategemea mpango wake madhubuti wa uboreshaji wa kisasa ili kumimarisha doria katika eneo la maji nchini

Mkurugenzi Mkuu wa KCGS Bruno Shioso anasema kuwa shirika hilo liko mbioni kupata meli ya kisasa inayoweza kufanya doria katika bahari ili kusaidiana na meli kuu ya KCGS iliyopatiwa jina Doria.

Mkurugenzi Mkuu Shioso anasisitiza kwamba meli ya MV

KSGS Doria ni imara na inashika doria mara kwa mara ili kuzuia shughuli haramu katika bahari ya Kenya.

Anataja shughuli zake nyingi zilizofanikiwa, ni pamoja na uokoaji wa hivi majuzi wa wavuvi wanne ambao walitoweka baada ya mashua yao kuharibika na kupigwa na wimbi hatari wakati wa msafara wa uvuvi. Huku wavuvi hao watatu wakiokolewa, kwa bahati mbaya, mmoja anaaminika kupoteza maisha baada ya kuzama.

Wavuvi hao waliookolewa walikuwa wamekwama baharini kwa siku 22 kabla ya kuokolewa na meli ya China ya

Lui Quinng Yuan U 108, ambayo kisha iliwakabidhi kwa KCGS.

“Kwa sasa tuko katika harakati za kupata meli za ziada. Tumeshiriki katika majadiliano na wauzaji kutoka nje ya nchi na tumewatembelea wawili kati yao nchini Ufaransa na Uholanzi,” alisema Shioso.

“Bado tunajaribu kuona ni maeneo gani tunaweza kushirikiana na kutafuta rasilimali zinazofaa kutoka kwa serikali kuweza kununua meli zaidi,” aliongeza.

Pia, kama sehemu ya juhudi za kisasa na kupanua ufikiaji wao Pwani na katika maji ya bara, KCGS inajenga vituo vipya vya ofisi ikiwa ni pamoja na

nyumba za wafanyakazi.

“Tuna miradi mikubwa mitatu, mmoja kule Baringo; kujenga kituo cha kisasa cha kutoa huduma kwa maafisa huko, imekamilika kwa karibu asilimia 95,” alisema na kuongeza kuw miradi mingine inaendelea Mbita na Ziwa Victoria.

Shioso alieleza kuwa uvuvi haramu, usioripotiwa, na usio-dhibitiwa umesalia kuwa tishio kubwa lakini tangu kuundwa kwa kikosi cha Walinzi wa Pwani, tishio hilo limepunguzwa.

“Kama serikali, tunaelekea kwenye Uchumi wa Baharini. Moja ya mifumo muhimu na inayopatikana kwa urahisi ni

uvuvi. Huduma ya Uvuvi ya Kenya (KeFS) ina jukumu muhimu katika masuala ya uvuvi, lakini tunasaidia kuwezesha utekelezaji,” Shioso alisema.

KCSGS inashirikiana na KeFS kutekeleza shughuli za mara kwa mara kwenye maji ya pwani na bara ambazo zimefaulu.

“Kwa sasa, hakuna ukiukaji mkubwa katika eneo letu la maji la Kenya, lakini bado tunapiga hatua mbele. Tunajaribu kuwekeza katika uwezo wetu wa doria na teknolojia ili tuweze kujua nini kinafanyika au nani anayeingilia maji yetu,” Shioso alisema, akiongeza kuwa kuwa na vifaa zaidi kutaimarisha doria.

## Maabara mpya ya KEPHIS kuharakisha ukuzaji wa mazao na kuongeza mapato ya wakulima

Wakulima nchini wat-anufaika na nyenzo safi za upanzi ili kuongeza uzalishaji na mapato ya kilimo, kutokana na kuanzishwa kwa kituo cha maabara kili-chogharimu Sh260 milioni kinachonuiwa kuharakisha upimaji na kutolewa kwa aina mpya za mazao.

Kushughulikia nyenzo mpya za upanzi chini ya kituo hicho cha kisasa kunatarajiwa kuchukua chini ya miaka mitano ikilinganishwa na kati ya miaka 10 na 13 chini ya taratibu za kawaida. Mkurugenzi Mkuu wa Huduma ya Uku-aguzi wa Afya ya Mimea (KEPHIS) Prof Theophilus Mutui alisema wanashirikiana na Kituo cha Kimataifa cha Viazi (CIP) na Taasisi ya Kimataifa ya Kilimo cha Kitropiki (IITA), na kwamba maabara hiyo mpya itazinduliwa katika muda wa wiki mbili zijazo.

“Maabara ya The Roots, Tubers, and Bananas-East Africa Germplasm Exchange (RTB-EAGEL) inalinga kuleta mapinduzi ya kilimo cha mimea ya mizizi na migomba katika Afrika Mashariki ili kuhifadhi na kuimarisha utofauti wa kijeni wa mazao muhimu kwa usalama wa chakula na maendeleo endelevu ya kilimo,” Prof Mutui aliongeza.

Pia alieleza kuwa maabara hiyo itawezesha ubadilis-

hanaji wa RTB kama vile viazi vitamu, viazi, mihogo, viazi vikuu na ndizi kati ya programu za ukuzaji za CGIAR na washirika wa utafiti wa kilimo katika

kanda (NARES). “Maabara hii itatuwezesha kuimarisha uwezo wetu na ushirikiano na washirika ili kuweza kuongeza uwezo wa kufanya tishu na kuzidisha kwa haraka nyenzo za kupanda na kusafisha,” alisema.

Alieleza kuwa afua tatu kuu zinazolengwa kupitia maabara ya EAGEL ili kuchangia katika kuongeza uzalishaji ni upimaji na kutolewa kwa aina mpya katika nchi mbalimbali, kudhibiti wadudu na magonjwa pamoja na kutoa mbegu bora kwenye mfumo wa mbegu.

“Maabara hii itakuwa ikitoa huduma kama vile kupokea Germplasm kutoka kwa programu za ufugaji, uchunguzi ulioidhinishwa

kimataifa, uondoaji wa pathojeni, na pia usambazaji katika kanda,” alisema.

Mkurugenzi Mkuu alishukuru msaada kutoka kwa serikali ya Kenya na mfadhili GIZ kwa kuchangia baadhi ya pesa za ujenzi wa maabara ya RTB-EAGEL chini ya mpango wa Crops to End Hunger (CtEH).

“KEPHIS iko tayari na itaunga mkono mradi huo. Maabara mpya kabisa yenye vifaa vipya sio tu itaimarisha uwezo wetu wa miundombinu na vifaa lakini pia itatoa mafunzo kwa wafanyikazi ili kutekeleza majukumu yao,” Prof Mutui alisema.

Dkt Morag Ferguson kutoka IITA na meneja wa mradi huo alisema lengo kuu la maabara litakuwa kuwezesha usafirishaji wa mizizi, na migomba, ili kuzuia wadudu na magonjwa katika nyenzo zao za kupanda na kuwezesha harakati za kikanda katika nchi tofauti sawa na KALRO katika kanda hii na Afrika Kusini mwa Sahara.

“Mara nyingi, huwa kuna vikwazo katika suala la kuhamisha aina mpya kutoka ambapo zinazalishwa hadi nchi nyingine. Tunataka kuwezesha hili na kulifanya lifanyike kwa haraka zaidi na kuharakisha mchakato wa jinsi wakulima wanavyopokea nyenzo,” alisema.

vitatibiwa hapa, na hivyo kupunguza msongamano katika Hospitali ya Mafunzo na Rufaa ya Jaramogi Oginga Odinga (JOOTRH) na Hospitali ya Rufaa ya Kaunti ya Kisumu (KCRH), ambapo

visa vingi kama hivyo vinasughulikiwa kwa sasa,” Dkt Owili alisema.

Afisa Mkuu wa Huduma za Matibabu, Afya ya Umma na Usafi wa kaunti Dkt Lusi Ojwang, alitangaza kuwa

hospitali hiyo ya Level 4 kwa sasa imekamilika kwa asilimia 98 na imeratibiwa kufungua milango yake kwa umma Juni 2024.

Hospitali hiyo ina kumbi mbili za kisasa zaidi zenye uwezo wa kushughulikia dharura kama vile waathiriwa wa ajali na nyingine ya huduma za matibabu. “Kitengo cha upasuaji akina mama wajawazito kitachangia kwa kiasi kikubwa kupunguza vifo vya uzazi, wakati kitengo cha watoto wachanga kitaimarisha utunzaji wa watoto wachanga katika hatua ya kuboresha huduma za afya kwa akina mama na watoto wachanga katika eneo hili,” Dkt Lusi alisema.

### Serikali kujenga masoko ya kisasa Narok kwa Sh 1.3B

IDARA ya Serikali ya Makazi na Maendeleo ya Miji, kupitia Mpango wa Kuchochea Uchumi (ESP), iko tayari kujenga masoko manane katika vituo mbalimbali vya biashara katika Kaunti ya Narok kwa gharama ya Sh1.3 bilioni. Gavana wa Narok Patrick Ntutu aliidhinisha miradi hiyo katika vituo vya biashara vya Ololulunga na Ntulele, ambavyo ni miongoni mwa miji itakayounganika na masoko ya kisasa. Kujengwa kwa masoko haya kutaleta fursa hiyo kwani mamia ya watu wa eneo hilo wataajiriwa katika kazi ya ujenzi,” alisema. Ntutu

aliongeza kuwa wanawake waliokuwa wakifanya kazi chini ya jua wakiuza bidhaa zao sasa watajengewa soko la kisasa.

Mkuu huyo wa kaunti alijitolea kuweka ua kuzunguka masoko hayo ili kuimarisha usalama kwa wafanyabiashara hao na bidhaa zao kwani soko hilo litakuwa likifanya kazi kwa siku sita kwa wiki.

Serikali ya kaunti, alisema, imetenga Sh2 milioni kujenga eneo la kutupa taka katika kituo cha biashara cha Ololulunga kwa usafi ufaao mjini. Ntutu alizitaka kamati za masoko kuhakikisha watu wanaonufaika na masoko hayo ni wafanyabiashara wa ndani, ambao wamekuwa wakifanya biashara hapo.

Kwa upande wake, Mbunge wa Emurua Dikirr, Johana Ngeno ambaye alikuwa ameandamana na mkuu wa kaunti alisema ujenzi huo utakamilika ndani ya miezi minne na utakuwa na mtandao wa intaneti ili vijana waweze kufanya biashara kidijitali.
