

CA yaongeza usalama wa mtandao kutokana na visa vingi vya udukuzi

Shirika la Mawasiliano ya Kenya (CA) limeimarisha usalama dhidi ya mashambulizi ya kintandao. Hii inafuatia ongezeko la visa vya udukuzi kutoka milioni 7.7 mnamo 2018 hadi milioni 444 mnamo 2023, na hivyo kufanya Kenya mionganini mwaa nchi tatu za juu zili-zolengwa barani Afrika.

Mkurugenzi wa Ukaruzi wa Ndani wa CA, Bi. Rosalid Murithi alisema, juhudhi zinalenga kujenga uwezo kwa taasisi kudhibiti vitisho vya mtandao, kurekebisha mapungufu yaliyogunduliwa hivi karibuni na kupambana na vitisho vinavyobuka.

Kikosi cha kitaifa ya kubaliana na changamoto za udukuzi (KE-CIRT), kili-choko katika makao makuu ya Mamlaka, alisema, kinafanya kazi muda wote kuhakikisha Wakenya wako salama. "Vitisho vya mtandao havitabiriki. Huwezi kupanga jinsi itakavyotokea na wakati itatokea. Kikosi chetu katika CA kinafanya kazi saa 24 kufatilia na kutoa maoni kwa taasisi zinazodukuliwa, ili



This includes development and implementation of mining policies, programmes and projects, creating a favorable legal and regulatory environment for investments and building capacity among others. The mineral resources sector is one of the priority sectors under the Economic Pillar of the Kenya Vision 2030, the Bottom-up Economic Transformation Agenda "BETA" and is among Kenya's foremost sectors and frontier earmarked for Foreign Direct Investment (FDI).

In order to effectively deliver on providing leadership in the management of the mining sector, the State Department recognizes the need to develop a Five-Year Strategic Plan ,2023-2027 to affirm its Vision and Mission. Further, the National Treasury and Planning, State Department for Planning has issued guidelines on preparation of the 5th Generation of Strategic Plans.

Purpose of the Consultancy:

The main aim of the consultancy service is to develop a Strategic Plan for the State Department for Mining covering the entire mining eco-system. In developing the Strategic Plan, the consultancy shall align the Plan with the Revised Guidelines for Preparation of the Fifth-Generation Strategic Plans for Ministries, Agencies, Counties, Constitutional Commissions and Independent Offices issued by the State Department for Economic Planning in June 2023. The consultancy shall further review elements of the 2018-2022 Ministerial Strategic Plan that appertain to the State Department for Mining and undertake a directional analysis for the State Department. Scope of Work:



Prof. Xiaoxin Li alisema mafunzo hayo ya likuwa fursa "ya kushirikiana maarifa na wakulima wa Kenya kuhusu teknolojia ya kilimo na usimamizi wenyewe ufanisi wa mtama wa aina ya Foxtail kutoka China ambao ni maarufu sana nchini China."

Prof. Li aliaambia wakulima kuwa mtama unakuzwa zaidi kaskazini mwa China, akitaja faida za mazao hayo ikiwa

ni pamoja na uwezo wa kuhimili ukame, uwezo wa kuhifadhi maji (ukilinganisha na mazao kama mahindi na mpunga), ufanisi mkubwa wa matumizi ya virutubishi, na uwezo wa kuhimili magonjwa.

Pia, alisema mtama aina ya Foxtail hukua vizuri kwenye udongo aina ya 'loam na sandy loam' na akaongeza kwamba mmea huo "unakua haraka zaidi kwa joto kati ya digrii 24-25 Celsius." Prof. Li aliutaja mtama huo kama "mmea unaokuwa katika muda

mfupi unaohitaji mwanga mdogo wa juu.

Aliorodhesha bidhaa za chakula zinazotokana na mtama huo kama vile sushi ya Kijapani, uji, vitafunio, divai ya mtama na bidhaa nyingine ikiwa ni pamoja na uzalishaji wa chakula cha wanyama.

Watafiti walifichua kuwa "kilimo cha mtama aina ya Foxtail kinawezekana zaidi katika sehemu nyinyi za Kenya ya Kati na Mashariki, ikiwa ni pamoja na Kaunti za Nyeri, Machakos, Makueni, na Kiambu."


Serikali yazindua ripoti ya athari kuhusu mradi wa mtando shuleni
