Mamlaka ya Kitaifa ya Kupambana na Matumizi ya Dawa za Kulevya (NACADA) imezitaka serikali za kaunti kutumia sehemu ya mapato zinazokusanywa kupitia leseni za pombe kuimari-sha huduma za kukabiliana na ulevi na dawa za kulevya katika kaunti zao.

Afisa Mkuu Mtendaji wa NACADA Bw Victor Okioma anasema, kaunti nyingi hazina mipango ya kuwarekebisha wanaume na wanawake ambao wameharibiwa na unyaji pombe kupita kiasi na dawa za kulevya Mkuu huyo wa NACADA alisema idara za ukusanyaji mapato ya serikali za kaunti zimeboresha njia za kuongeza mapato ya leseni za pombe bila kujali kabisa aina ya pombe inayotumiwa na athari zake hasi.

Alipendekeza kamati itakayopewa jukumu la kusimamia kiwango cha uraibu wa pombe na dawa za kulevya katika ngazi ya kaunti ambayo inajumuisha wawakilishi kutoka Serikali za Kitaifa na Kaunti wak-iwemo wahusika wengine husika wasio wa serikali.

Kulingana naye, kamati hiyo pamoja na mambo mengine itachangia pakubwa katika kupendekeza njia za kuwasaidia waraibu wa pombe na mihadarati ili waweze kurejea katika maisha yao ya kawaida.

Afisa Mkuu Mtendaji huyo aliwahimiza maafisa wa polisi wa Kaunti ya Nandi, wakiongozwa na Kamishna wa Kaunti hiyo Caroline Mueni waliohudhuria mkutano huo kuhakikisha kuwa hakuna viwanda vya kutengeneza vileo haramu katika kaunti hiyo. Alifichua sehemu hizo za kutengeneza pombe haramu hutumia kemikali hatari iliyochang-anywa na ethanol kuharibu maisha ya watumiaji wengi wasio na hatia. Kamishna Mueni kwa upande wake alikaribisha wazo hilo na kusema ameshirikiana na makamishna wa kaunti za Kisumu, Vihiga kudhibiti pombe hiyo.

Gov't signs bilateral labour deals to secure jobs for Kenyans abroad

The Ministry of Labour and Social Protection has signed bilateral labour agreements with seven countries to assist qualified unemployed Kenyans secure jobs abroad.

Labour Cabinet Secretary, Ms Florence Bore said, so far, seven agreements have been signed adding that the initiative will benefit thousands of Kenyans in different cadres as the government moves to address rising unemployment in the country.

Among the agreements signed, she said, was between Kenya and Saudi Arabia where about 130, 000 opportunities have been identified for qualified Kenyans to tap into.

Kenya, she added, was looking beyond the gulf countries which have traditionally absorbed Kenyan workers to ensure that as many Kenyans as possible benefit from the programme.

Negotiations, she disclosed, were at an advanced stage with Canada,

South Korea and Germany to secure more job opportunities.

"Germany will be here next week. They have assured us that they have about seven million jobs. This is huge and we want our people to benefit," she said.

To make the programme a success, the CS said the ministry was working on packaging job seekers to ready them for the available opportunities abroad.

"What we have as a country is the human resource. People have graduated with various degrees and courses but do not have jobs. We want to sell this out there and be able to secure opportunities for them," she said.

The ministry, she added, was in the process of reviewing existing bilateral labour relations with different countries to safeguard Kenyans working outside the country.

This comes against the backdrop of Kenyans being tortured and mistreated abroad with the CS assuring that the review targets

to address teething problems affecting the programme.

Through the initiative, the government aims to ensure that all Kenyans who secure jobs abroad are put in the right cadres, get the right salaries and work in a conducive environment.

Bore added that the government was equally developing a national labour policy and a National Labour Management Bill to regulate and control recruitment agencies.

This, she disclosed, has seen the number of registered recruitment agencies reduced from 900 to 500 adding that the vetting will continue to ensure only agencies that meet the set standards are allowed to operate.

Speaking at Tom Mboya Labour College in Kisumu during the World Day for Safety and Health Celebrations, Ms Bore asked all unemployed Kenyans to register with the National Employment Authority to benefit from the opportunities being sought abroad.

The National Health Insurance Fund (NHIF) is a State Corporation established in 1966 with a core mandate of providing medical insurance cover to all its members and their declared dependants. The original Act of Parliament that set up the Fund has, over the years, been reviewed to accommodate the changing healthcare needs of the Kenyan population and the restructuring in the health sector.

The NHIF Act (1998) was amended and passed in Parliament on 21st December 2021 and assented into law on 10th January 2022.

IT IS THEREFORE NOTIFIED for information to the public that following the public participation held on the draft regulations in 2022, NHIF has taken into account the feedback received and consolidated the draft Regulations, 2023 to facilitate implementation of the provisions of the NHIF Act No. 9 of 1998.

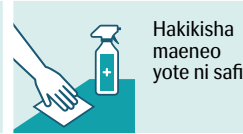
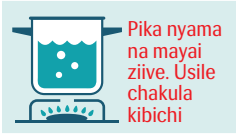

Commission urges counties to create own sources of revenue

The Commission on Revenue Allocation (CRA) is urging county governments to improve their own revenue sources in order to cater for their needs as well as develop those hitherto marginalized areas.

Speaking in Meru County during public participation

in the thirteen marginalized areas in the devolved unit identified by the commission, CRA Commissioner Dr Isabel Waiyaki said the counties have the potential to raise more revenue on their own to benefit their marginalized areas.

“When all counties depend on the national cake, then it becomes a bit hard

because they can raise much more for the benefit of the marginalized areas, as well as their own unique development projects,” Dr Waiyaki said.

Beyond what they are getting from the national government as the equitable share, she added, the County Government of Meru for instance can raise

Sh3 billion but has been raising Sh316 million which has improved this year to about Sh400 million.

She however applauded the Meru County Government for the improvement adding that they were making efforts to raise their own income.

“If you look at all the counties, currently from their own source revenue, they are only raising about Sh35 billion but they have the potential to raise Sh216 billion,” said Dr Waiyaki.

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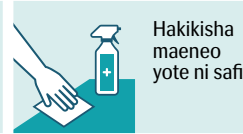
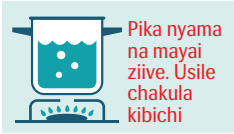
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Stakeholders call for creation of national horticulture taskforce to tackle disasters

Stakeholders have called for the creation of a national horticulture taskforce to help prepare for future pandemics and emergencies as the effects of Covid-19 continue to be felt many years after the outbreak.

The experts, drawn from government agencies, ministries and departments, in collaboration with the private sector made the proposal while deliberating ways to strengthen the horticultural value chain to tailor it to more resilient agri-food systems.

The experts spoke in Nairobi during a national workshop on the collaboration between the state and business actors in the agriculture value-chain.

Horticulture was one of the most affected sectors during the Covid-19 pandemic with producers, processors, and exporters of French beans and avocado still reeling under the effects of the pandemic.

Besides a rise in interceptions of their products in Europe due to exceeding Maximum Residual Levels (MRLs), farmers experienced delayed harvesting of their produce, low demand, delayed planting, and reduction of cultivated areas leading to losses, decreased income,

and layoffs.

This was due to interruptions, especially of transport and other logistics, because of restrictions imposed by the government to control the spread of the SARS-CoV-2 virus.

The effects were experienced in both avocado and French beans value-chains, consequently affecting the economy and food security according to

research by the Institute of Development Studies (IDS) in collaboration with Centre for African Bio-Entrepreneurship (CABE).

"The study was about looking at the governance, the interaction between state and non-state actors in responding to the impact of the Covid-19 pandemic in the horticultural sector to make it resilient, especially drawing lessons on what we can learn from the impact of Covid-19 to be better prepared for future shocks and stresses," said DrHannington Odame, the CABE Executive Director.

Given the unpredictability of pandemics, inflation and or depreciation of the local

currency, the experts argued that it is time to come up with a policy brief to inform a policy or policy review to address unforeseen challenges in the horticulture sub-sector which contributes to 33 per cent of the Agricultural Gross Domestic Product (GDP).

"The policy brief will indicate areas that stakeholders think need addressing and review of either existing policies or coming up with new policies that address particularly issues of resilience because our systems are disrupted every now and then," said David Ombalo, Principal Agricultural Officer and a policy analyst at the Ministry of Agriculture, Livestock and Fisheries.

According to the stakeholders, besides the national horticulture taskforce, there is a need to improve communication in the sub-sector by embracing digital technology to enhance virtual certification and decentralized field inspections through self-regulation.

They indicated that there is a need to change the governance of horticulture value-chains post-Covid-19 to diversify and maximize emerging horticultural markets in Asia, the African Continental Free Trade Area (AfCFTA) and the East Africa Community.

Taasisi kujenga kiwanda cha kusafisha maji chafu Pwani

Taasisi ya Utafiti wa Majini na Uvuvi ya Kenya (KMFRI) inajenga mradi wa kusafisha maji taka wa Sh40 milioni ili kuhifadhi mfumo wa ikolojia wa baharini eneo la Mikindani, kaunti ya Mombasa. Mradi huo unaofadhiliwa na Muungano wa Ulaya (EU) kupitia Shirika la Mazingira la Umoja wa Mataifa (UNEP), utaimarisha ubora wa Tudor Creek ambako mikoko imeharibiwa kutokana na shughuli za kibinadamu. KMFRI itatumia tekinolojia ya ardhiyeu iliyojengwa ambayo inaiga michakato ya asili ya ardhiyeu kwa kutumia mimea ya ardhiyeu, udongo na vijidudu kusafisha na kusafisha maji taka kwa kutumia, kemikali na kibayolojia.

"KMFRI kupitia watafiti wake imekuja na mfumo wa kuweka dawa maji taka kupitia ardhi oevu iliyojengwa. Maji hupitishwa kupitia miamba, mawe na mimea. Tunatumia viumbe vya asili kusafisha maji, na maji yanapoinja baharini yanakuwa maji safi," alisema Mkurugenzi Mkuu wa KMFRI Prof James Njiru na kuongeza kuwa maji hayo yanaweza kutumika kwa kilimo. Prof Njiru alibainisha kuwa ardhi oevu iliyojengwa ni ya gharama nafuu na mfereji wa maji utapita

kupitia mvuto wa nguvu za ardhi.

Wakazi wanaoishi nyanda za chini katika kijiji cha Runyu kata ya Mikindani wamekuwa wakisumbuliwa na harufu mbaya inayotokana na maji taka yanayotoka maeneo ya Kwa Shee na Mikindani.

"Tulipofanya utafiti wetu, tuligundua kuwa ni muhimu kuwasaidia wenyeji ili kukabil majitaka haya. Tutapanua hadi maeneo mengine tutakapopata ufadhili," Prof Njiru alisema. Naibu Gavana wa Mombasa, Francis Thoya, alisema wakazi wa Runyu wamekuwa wakilalamikia maji taka yanayopitia kijiji chao kuelekea baharini.

"Hili ni tatizo kubwa; maji taka yanayotoka kwenye nyumba hizo yameathiri mikoko kwa kiasi kikubwa. Nusu ya mikoko ambayo ilikuwa sehemu ya Ganahola imetoweka leo kwa sababu ya maji taka haya," alisikitika. Thoya alibainisha kuwa mradi huo utahifadhi mfumo wa ikolojia wa mikoko na kuchochea ukuaji wa kilimo katika Kata ya Mikindani.

Aliongeza kuwa iwapo mradi huo utafaulu kurejesha msitu wa mikoko, utachangia katika uzalishaji wa samaki, na kuinua utalii wa misitu.

Wakati wa mahafala hayo, wasichana hao ambao waliamua kutofanyiwa ukeketaji ambao umeenea miongoni mwa jamii ya Wamasai, walisherhekeka na kutunukiwa zawadi ikiwa ni njia ya kuwatia moyo wasichana wengi zaidi kuachana na desturi potofu za mila.

Bw Daniel Ntokoiwan mzee wa kijiji alisema jamii imekubali kuweka kando tamaduni zozote ambazo ni kinyume na ustawi wa mtoto wa kike kwa kushiriki shughuli za kuzalisha mali ambazo zitakuwa na manufaa kwa ja-mii. "Mimi binafsi nilitoa ardhi ambapo COVAW ilikuwa ikitoa mafunzo kwa wasichana. Wamepitia mafunzo kadhaa kuhusu Ghassia za Kijinsia (GBV) na tuna uhakika watakuwa mwanga kwa jamii," alisema.

Bw Ntokoiwan alisema kuwa visa vya mimba za utotoni na ndoa za utotoni zimepungua tangu mafunzo hayo yaanze mwaka mmoja uliopita, huku

akiwapongeza wazazi na walezi kwa kuwaruhusu wasichana wao kuhudhuria mafunzo hayo. Mzee huyo wa kijiji alitoa wito kwa wazazi kuwa na muda wa kutosha na watoto wao katika msimu huu wa likizo na kufuatilia mienendo yao ili waweze kuwaongoza ipasavyo.

"Ni jukumu letu wazazi kuhakikisha kwamba watoto wetu; wasichana na wavulana wanaendelea vyema. Ikiwa hatutawaongoza watoto wetu, wanaweza kuishia kujiunga na watu wabaya," alisema mzee huyo.

Pia alitoa changamoto kwa wakazi kuripoti visa vya ukeketaji na ndoa za utotoni kwa serikali mapema ili wahuksika wakamatwe na kufunguliwa mashataka. Mary Masako, mwakilishi wa Nyumba Kumi, alitoa changamoto kwa jamii 'kukataa' ukeketaji kwa kuwa imepitwa na wakati na kinyume cha sheria. "Sijasikia popote katika biblia ambapo ukeketaji ulifanyika. Tumekuwa tukifanya FGM kwa miaka mingi sana lakini hatujaona faida yoyote. Huu ndio wakati huu wa kutrejesha nyuma na kuzingatia kujenga jamii," Bi Masako alisema.

Aliyasema hayo mjini Kampala, Uganda wakati wa Mkutano wa wa siku nne wa Mawaziri wa Ulinzi kutoka chini zinazochangia wanajeshi ATMIS ambao ume-kuwa ukiendelea kwa wiki

moja iliyopita. vWaziri huyo alibainisha kuwa ugaidi na misimamo mikali inasalia kuwa tishio la kawaida na kuu la usalama katika eneo

hilo na akataka juhudi za pamoja za kukabiliana na tishio hilo. "Hali ya Usalama katika eneo la operesheni ya ATMIS inasalia kuwa tete

huku Al-Shaabab wakiwa tishio la kudumu. Zinaleta tishio kubwa kwa usalama na uthabiti wa kanda na uchumi wa kimataifa kwa ujumla," alisema waziri.

Alisisitiza kuwa juhudi za kuunda nguvu kwa Vikosi vya Usalama vya Somalia zinaendelea ili hatimaye kuviwezesha kuchukua majukumu ya usalama mara tu utaratibu wa kuondoa wanajeshi kutoka ATMIS utakapoanza ifikapo Desemba 2024.

"Mkutano huu ni muhimu kwani unatoa fursa kwetu kukuza msimamo wa pamoja. Mbinu itakayopitishwa na Mkutano huu inapaswa kuunda uwiano sawia, na kudumisha mafanikio ambayo tayari yamefikwa na vikosi vya ATMIS," waziri alisema.
