"Hakikisheni kuwa serikali kuu ikifuta deni la mashirika ya sukari, hakikisheni madeni ya wakulima na wadeni yanajumuishwa pia," aliwaambia viongozi.

Rais William Ruto alitangaza kufuta deni la Shilingi bilioni 117.64 ambalo kampuni tano za serikali zinadaiwa na KRA.

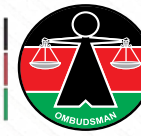

Specifically, the Regulations seek to –

- set out the registration procedure for maritime transport operators licensed by related Government Agencies;
- establish a framework to revise and introduce other fees and charges payable by maritime transport operators;
- outline the scope of services for maritime transport operators;
- provide a mechanism for coordination and collaboration for maritime transport and logistics services;
- promote professionalism through continuous capacity building within the maritime transport sector;
- promote the participation of Kenyan citizens in the maritime transport and logistics sector;
- provide a complaints resolution mechanism;
- provide processes for the establishment of performance standards; and
- provide compliance and enforcement mechanisms in the provision of maritime transport and logistics services.

1. Background of the feasibility study

The Kenya Government continues to spend over two (2) billion Kenya shillings in the importation of inorganic fertilizers, which are expensive and continue to acidify the soils over time. This increase in soil acidity has led to the deterioration of soil fertility causing a decline in yields per acreage despite the use of such inorganic fertilizers. For increased agricultural production and productivity, appropriate and optimal use of fertilizers is recommended. However, there is a need to seek alternative sources of fertilizers that is affordable and at the same time improve soil health for increased production.

The challenge of poor unproductive soils is countrywide but more pronounced in regions that experience the heavy application of inorganic fertilizers by farmers. In order to address this challenge, it's recommended that the use of organic fertilizers such as bio deposits found and mined from lakes be promoted. These organic fertilizers have the potential to maintain soil structure and improve soil fertility.

The Lake Olbolossat bio-deposit projects aim at availing organic fertilizers for increased agricultural productivity. Uwanja wa ndege, kulingana na Murkomen, ni wa

pili kwa shughuli baada ya Uwanja wa Kimataifa wa Jomo Kenyatta, ukiendesha tani 12,000 za bidhaa kila mwaka.

Kwa bahati mbaya, bidhaa ambazo uwanja wa ndege unashughulikia ni za uagizaji, haswa bidhaa kavu kama elektroniki, nguo, na vipande vya magari," alibainisha.

Alisema ingawa Eldoret ina eneo kubwa ambapo mazao ya mboga na matunda hufanya vizuri, kuna haja ya kukuza mkakati wa pamoja wa masoko na kuwa na eneo la usambazaji la kudumu ili kuhakikisha uwanja wa ndege unatumika kikamilifu.

Hata hivyo, alionya kwamba mustakabali wa kilimo katika ardhi inayolimwa nchini ulikuwa hatarini kutokana na kugawanyika kwa ardhi kwa kiwango kisichofaa ambacho umwishowe hakitawezesha uchumi wa kilimo.

"Huu ndio wakati mwanafaka kuchukua hatua kali kama nchi kuhusu kugawanyika kwa ardhi ambayo ndio changamoto kubwa kwa kilimo, vinginevyo

katika miaka 10, ikiwa tutataendelea njia hii, hatutafikia malengo yetu," alisema Murkomen.

Linturi kwa upande wake alisema ingawa kilimo kilikuwa sekta inayokua haraka zaidi, kulikuwa na haja ya kuhamasisha wakulima zaidi kujaribu sekta hiyo ili kuongeza uzalishaji. "Kilimo ndicho njia ya haraka ya kuongeza uchumi na kuunda ajira kwa vijana, lakini hii inaweza kufanyika tu kupitia ongezeko la uzalishaji." Waziri wa Kilimo alisema serikali ilikuwa ikitumia bidii kuweka soko kwa bidhaa za kilimo, "Hivi karibuni nitapeana ndege ya kwanza kwenda India kwa parachichi, Pia tumepata soko la nanasi na samaki nchini Israel, lakini hatungeweza kuzalisha nanasi za kutosha, licha ya soko la tayari, tunazalisha vya kutosha kujaza ndege za mizigo nje?" aliohoji.

Wakati huo huo, Kaunti ya Uasin Gishu imeona ongezeko la uzalishaji wa mazao ya mboga na matunda ambayo imekuwa sekta kuu ya kiuchumi tangu kuanzishwa kwa ug-

atuzi.

Waziri wa Kilimo wa Kaunti Edward Sawe anasema kuwa tangu serikali ya kaunti iwasaidie wakulima kubadilisha mimea kwa mazao yenye thamani kubwa ya kuuza nje badala ya kutegemea kilimo cha mahindi na ngano cha jadi, ukuaji mkubwa katika mazao ya usafirishaji umeonekana.

"Kupitia mpango wa kubadilisha mazao, kaunti iliwasaidia wakulima kupata vifaa bora vya kupanda. Hadi sasa imegawa miche 200,000 ya parachichi, zaidi ya miche 400,000 ya karanga za macadamia, miche 68,000 ya ndizi za utamaduni wa tishu, na zaidi ya miche 870,000 ya kahawa," alisema Sawe.

Kaunti, aliongeza, inazalisha aina mbalimbali za mboga, matunda, mimea ya viungo, na viungo kwa soko la ndani na la kuuza nje.

Kwa sasa, kaunti ina hekta 2300 za mboga zinazojumuisha maharagwe ya kifaransa, mboga za theluji, mboga za jikoni, na mboga za Kiafrika miongoni mwa zingine.

"Kampeni hii ni sehemu muhimu ya kujitolea kwa Kenya kwa Ufikiaji wa Huduma za Afya kwa Wote (UHC) na kuhakikisha haki ya kila mtoto kwa mustakabali wenye afya, na mafanikio haya yangeweza kutimizwa bila kujitolea kwa wataalamu wa afya, wadau, washirika, na msaada thabiti wa umma," alisema Katibu.

Bi Muriuki pia alifichua kwamba, Wizara ya Afya imekamilisha kwa ufanisi duru ya kwanza ya Shughuli za Kutoa Chanjo za Dharura (SIA) kushughulikia milipuko ya polio iliyoithibitishwa na visa sita.

"Huku tukisherehekea mafanikio haya, Kenya inatambua kazi inayohitajika kwa afya na ustawi endelevu wa raia wake na tunasihhi kila mmoja kubaki macho, kuzingatia hatua muhimu za afya ya umma, na kujiunga nasi katika kampeni za afya ya umma za siku za usoni," alishauri Katibu.

Msongamano wa magari Nyeri kupungua kituo cha mabasi kikifunguliwa

Wasafiri wanaosafiri umbali mrefu kutoka Kaunti ya Nyeri watahitajika, katika wiki mbili zijazo, kuchukua Magari ya Huduma za Umma (PSV) kutoka kituo cha basi cha Field Marshal Muthoni Kirima kilichoanzishwa hivi karibuni, umbali wa kilomita 1.5 kutoka katikati ya Jiji la Nyeri (CBD).

Hii inafuatia tangazo la Idara ya Kaunti ya Upanuzi wa Kimwili na Maendeleo ya Mjini kwa muda wa wiki mbili kwa kuhamisha shughuli zote kubwa za usafirishaji kutoka katikati ya Jiji kwenda kwenye kituo cha basi cha kisasa kilichoanzishwa na Rais William Ruto mnamo Agosti 7.

Wiki iliyopita, kamati inayounganisha sekta nyingi inayosimamia kuhamishwa kwa wafanyabiashara na wachezaji wa usafirishaji kutoka katikati ya Jiji la Nyeri iliruhusu PSV kutumia kituo kipya kama eneo la maegesho kwa muda wakati kaunti inakamilisha zoezi la kuhamisha.

Kulingana na Mjumbe wa Kamati ya Mipango ya Kaunti, Ndirangu Gachunia, ambaye pia ni mwenyekiti wa kamati

hiyo, upigaji kura kwa Saccos 36 za PSV unatarajiwa kufanyika, baada ya hapo watapewa wiki moja kuhamia kituo cha basi cha kisasa. "PSV wanatumia kituo hiki kama eneo la maegesho la muda. Tumeidhinisha magari mawili kwa kila Sacco katika vituo vitatu vya zamani vya basi kama njia ya kupunguza msongamano uliosababishwa na ukosefu wa nafasi za maegesho za kutosha. Tumeafikiana kwamba badala ya kuegesha kwenye vituo vya zamani vya basi, PSV wanaweza kuweka magari yao hapa na kusubiri zamu yao," alisema Gachunia katika mahojiano na KNA.

"Tutaandaa upya vituo vya zamani vya basi na kufunga baadhi yao. Pia, tutafanya mipango ya eneo la mzunguko katikati ya jiji ambapo madereva wanaweza kuachisha abiria," aliongeza CEC. Mchakato wa kubadilisha eneo la kutekeza taka la Asian Quarter kuwa kituo cha basi cha kisasa ulianza mnamo 2019.

Kituo cha Kudhibiti na Kuzuia Magonjwa (CDC) Kenya kimepongeza serikali ya Kaunti ya Makueni kwa jitihada zake katika kupambana na HIV/UKIMWI katika kaunti hiyo, huku kiwango cha kudhibiti kirusi cha HIV katika eneo hilo kikifikia asilimia 96 hivi sasa.

Mkurugenzi wa CDC Kenya, Dk. Jennifer Galbraith, alisema huko Wote kwamba, mafanikio nadra yaliyofikiwa na serikali ya ugatuzi yamepatikana kupitia msaada wa Mpango wa Dharura wa Rais wa Marekani kwa Ajili ya Kupambana na UKIMWI (PEPFAR) katika kusaidia juhudi za kuzuia, kuntuza, na kutibu HIV.

"Katika Kaunti ya Makueni, Serikali ya Marekani kupitia CDC Kenya inaweza zaidi ya KSh 200 milioni kila mwaka kusaidia mipango ya kuzuia, kuntuza, na kutibu HIV katika kaunti," alisema Dk. Galbraith.

"Kutokana na msaada huu na kazi nzuri mnayoifanya, kaunti ya Makueni inakaribia kudhibiti janga la HIV. Udhhibiti wa kirusi cha HIV umefikia asilimia 96, ambayo ina uwezo mkubwa wa kupunguza maambukizi ya HIV na kuendelea kuwawezesha watu wanaoishi na HIV kuwa

na afya njema," alisema. Dkt. Galbraith alizungumza wakati wa uzinduzi wa Ramani ya Mipito ya HIV ya kaunti, ambayo ni nguzo muhimu katika kufikia uimara wa mipango ya HIV katika Hospitali ya Mama na Mtoto Makueni.

Aliambatana na Gavana Mutula Kilonzo Jr, maafisa wa afya, na washirika kutoka CIHEB Kenya na LVCT. Pia, katika tukio hilo, Dk. Galbraith pamoja na Gavana Mutula walishuhudia mahafali ya watoto 40 ambao hawana HIV waliokuwa na wazazi wenye HIV.

"Kutokana na juhudi za kuzuia maambukizi ya HIV kutoka kwa mama hadi kwa mtoto, watoto 2,607 wamehakikishiwa kuwa bila HIV miezi 24 baada ya kuji-fungua kati ya mwaka wa fedha 2017-2022," aliongeza Dkt. Galbraith.

Aliendelea kusema kuwa watu 21,672 wanaoishi na HIV wanapokea matibabu, ikiwa ni pamoja na watu wazima 18,942, vijana 1,812, na watoto 918. Alisisitiza kuwa Makueni imetekeleza mikakati ya ubunifu na kuonyesha uwezo wa kukuza maendeleo endelevu kwa kukuza sekta ya afya. Na Ronald Rono (KNA)
