Basi la kwanza la kutumia umeme ambalo limetengezwa nchini limezinduliwa, kwenye hatua muhimu katika sekta inayokua ya kutumia kawi safi nchini.

Maendeleo haya ni hatua kubwa kuelekea usafiri wa mijini endelevu, huku makampuni zaidi ya magari yakichukua "usafiri endelevu" kwa kuzingatia ajenda ya serikali kuhusu mazingira na mabadiliko ya hali ya hewa.

Basi hili, linaloitwa 'Roam Move,' liliumbwa na kutengenezwa na kampuni ya Roam, kampuni ya teknolojia ya Kiswidi

inayofanya kazi nchini. Roam inajishughulisha na maendeleo, ubunifu, na kupeleka magari ya umeme katika mataifa ya Afrika.

Kulingana na Dennis Wakaba, Mkurugenzi wa Mauzo wa Roam nchini, basi hili hutoa uzalishaji sifuri wa kaboni na ina betri ya kWh 170, inayoweza kusafiri kilomita 200 kwa mjazo moja kwa kasi ya kilomita 80 kwa saa.

Pia hutumia malipo ya haraka ya betri, ambayo huhakikisha basi linajaa kabisa ndani ya saa na nusu. Alisema hii inahakikisha huduma isiyoingiliwa kwa siku nzima ili kukidhi ma-

Kamishna wa Kanda ya Pwani.

Serikali itaendesha sheria yake ya kwanza kabisa ya usalama wa mtandao kwa lengo la kulinda nchi dhidi ya mashambulizi ya mtandao.

Wizara ya Usalama wa Ndani na Utawala wa Kitaifa ilipendekeza kanuni za mwaka 2023 za Matumizi Mabaya ya Kompyuta na Uhalifu wa Mtandao (Miundombinu ya Habari Kuu na Usimamizi wa Uhalifu wa Mtandao) ili kuwezesha utekelezaji wa Sheria ya Matumizi Mabaya ya Kompyuta na Uhalifu wa Mtandao (CMCA) ya 2018.

Hata hivyo, utekelezaji wa Sheria hiyo ulikum-bana na changamoto kubwa kutokana na kesi za mahakama zilizopinga uhalali wake, lakini mnamo 2021, Mahakama ya Rufaa ilitoa idhini, na hivyo kurahisisha mchakato wa kuandaa kanuni hizi.

Ombati aliongeza kuwa makampuni yote ya-

nayotoa miundombinu muhimu kwa umma yanatarajiwa kuwa na vituo vya uendeshaji. Wanjiku Mbiyu, mwanachama wa Kamati ya Kitaifa ya Kudhibiti Uhalifu wa Kompyuta na Uhalifu wa Mtandao (NC4), alisema wanataka maoni mengi kutoka kwa Wakenya wa kila fani ili yaweze

kujumuishwa katika ripoti ya mwisho kabla ya kuwasilishwa kwa Bunge. Alisema sheria hizo zilisababishwa na mchakato wa haraka wa kidijitali na haja ya kulinda Wakenya na miundombinu muhimu ya habari ya kitaifa kutokana na mashambulizi ya mtandao.

Ufanisi mkubwa Kenya ikiunda basi lake la kwanza la umeme

hitaji ya wasafiri wa mijini.

Kulingana naye, gharama za uendeshaji wa basi hili ni asilimia 50 chini kwa sababu halihitaji matengenezo mengi ikilinganishwa na mabasi yanayotumia mafuta ya petroli na kwa sababu linajengwa na sehemu chache zinazosonga.

"Viwango hivi vilivyojumuishwa huleta akiba kubwa, hadi Sh 35 kwa kila kilomita iliyosafiriwa," Wakaba alisema.

Basi lenye uwezo wa kubeba abiria 51, mbali na kutotoa moshi wa sumu, ni tulivu na kuchangia kidogo kwa uchafuzi wa kelele ambao ni kawaida katika mae-neo makubwa ya mijini.

"Basi hili pia lina vifaa vya usalama vya kisasa, ikiwa ni pamoja na mfumo wa kuepuka ajali, msaada wa dereva wa juu, na utimilifu imara wa muundo," Wakaba alisema.

Awali, Roam ilizindua Roam Rapid, basi la umeme la usafiri wa umma lililoundwa kwa ajili ya mfumo wa Usafiri wa Haraka wa Basi



(BRT) na kuzindua kiwanda cha kutengeneza pikipiki za umeme katika hafla iliyo-funguliwa na Rais William Ruto, pamoja na vituo vya malipo vitatu.

"Basi hili la umeme linawakilisha mchanganyiko wa ubunifu, teknolojia, na dhamira ya mazingira. Linatarajiwa kubadilisha usafiri wa umma kwa kutoa suluhisho la uzalishaji sifuri linaloshughulikia changamoto za ubora wa hewa, kupunguza kutegemea mafuta ya petroli yanayoagizwa, na kukuza matumizi ya nishati

mbadala ya ndani," alisema Wakaba.

Kulingana naye, uanzishwaji wa basi hili unalingana kikamilifu na wito wa Kenya wa kuendeleza suluhisho za usafiri endelevu zinazofanya athari chanya kwa mazingira na jamii ya Wakenya.

"Uzinduzi wa basi hili la umeme unaonyesha sio tu hatua kubwa mbele katika ahadi yetu ya uendeleu bali pia uthibitisho wa talanta na uwezo uliopo ndani ya tasnia ya utengenezaji bidhaa Kenya," alisema.

Serikali kuzindua mpango wa matibabu baada kustaafu kwa watumishi wa umma

Wizara ya Utumishi wa Umma inatarajia kuzindua sera, mwongozo, na mpango wa matibabu baada ya kustaafu kwa watumishi wa umma, walimu, na wafanyakazi wa vyombo vya ulinzi na usalama.

Katibu wa Idara ya Utumishi wa Umma, Bw Amos Gathecha, anasema kwamba, Mpango wa Matibabu baada ya Kustaafu kwa watumishi wa umma, walimu, na wafanyakazi wa vyombo vya ulinzi na usalama utasaidia kupunguza msongo wa akili wa kutumia mafao yao kuli pia matibabu wanapokuwa wazee.

Akizungumza katika Harambee House wakati wa kusaini Mkataba wa Mazungumzo ya Pamoja kati ya Idara yake na Chama cha Watumishi wa Umma cha Kenya (UKCS), Gathecha alisema Serikali pia inaendeleza masharti bora na mazingira bora ya utumishi kwa watumishi wa umma.

"Idara yangu imechukua hatua za kuthubutu katika kuboresha ustawi wa watumishi wa umma, na maeneo muhimu tunayosimamia ni pamoja na kukamilisha mfumo wa Mazungumzo ya Pamoja kati ya Utumishi wa Umma," Gathecha alisema.

Pia, aliongeza kuwa Seri-

kali ilikuwa pia inafanya kazi kwenye Mpango Kamili wa Bima ya Afya na Bima ya Maisha kwa watumishi wa umma.

"Tunaendelea kufanya kazi kwenye maeneo yenye ugumu na malipo ya marupuru kwa watumishi wa umma wanaofanya kazi katika maeneo hayo yaliyo na changamoto," Gathecha aliwaambia kikosi cha UKCS kilichoongozwa na Katibu Mkuu Tom Odege na Mwenyekiti Bw Alisokor Mahamud.

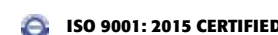

THE CLIMATE CHANGE (CARBON MARKETS) REGULATIONS, 2023

Kenya, as a signatory Party to the International Paris Agreement (PA), having ratified it on 28th December, 2016 is obligated to prepare and submit her Nationally Determined Contributions (NDC) to fulfil the Paris Agreement's objective of keeping the increase in global temperature to well below 2°C with respect to the pre-industrial era, and further aim to limit it to 1.5°C.

Art 4.2 of the PA, states that each Party shall prepare, communicate and maintain successive Nationally Determined Contributions (NDCs) that it intends to achieve. Parties shall pursue domestic mitigation measures, with the aim of achieving the objectives of such contributions.

Kenya's updated NDC, submitted to UNFCCC on 24th December 2020, commits to abate GHG emissions by 32% by 2030 relative to the BAU scenario of 143 MtCO₂eq; and in line with Kenya's sustainable development agenda and national circumstances. The NDC acknowledges the intention to use voluntary cooperation under Article 6 of the Paris Agreement, if applicable, with the guidance adopted by CMA. It also indicates that Kenya will develop domestic legislation and institutional frameworks to govern her engagement in carbon market and non-market mechanisms.

The Climate Change (Amendment) Act, 2023 amended the Climate Change Act, 2016 and addresses the gap on carbon markets by ensuring: -

- The development, management, implementation and regulation of mechanisms to enhance climate change resilience and low carbon development for the sustainable development of Kenya.
- Guidance in the development and implementation of carbon markets and non-market approaches in compliance with international obligations.
- Guidance and policy direction on carbon markets to the national and county governments, the public and other stakeholders.

Pursuant to Section 16 of the Climate Change (Amendment) Act, 2023, the Ministry of Environment, Climate Change and Forestry has developed the Draft Climate Change (Amendment) Regulations, 2023 to operationalize the said Act. The Regulations are available on the Ministry of Environment, Climate Change and Forestry's website: <https://www.environment.go.ke/>

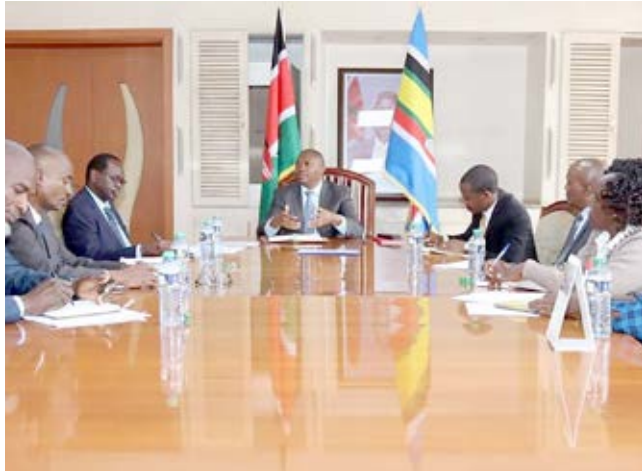

"Usajili huu utatuwezesha kuwasilisha habari kwa wakulima kwa wakati halisi ili kufanya mradi ufanikiwe," alisema Bw Kireger.

Kwa upande mwingine,

aliwahimiza wakulima, haswa katika Bonde la Ufa Kaskazini ambao wameanza kuvuna mahindi yao, kuharakisha mchakato huo na kukausha nafaka kabla ya mvua ya El-Niño inayotabiriwa kuanza mwezi Oktoba.

Akizungumza wakati wa shughuli hiyo, Naibu Mkurugenzi Mkuu wa KALRO anayesimamia Kilimo na Utafiti Dkt. Felister Makini alisema KALRO, msimamizi wa mradi huo, itasaidia kuongeza thamani ya mzunguko wa thamani wa mazao uliolengwa kupitia usindikaji na wakati huo huo kutoa viungo vya masoko ili kuwezesha wakulima kupata mapato zaidi kutoka kwa kazi zao na kuboresha maisha yao.

KURA, Yathrib School zapanda miche 300 ya miti Garissa

Wafanyakazi wa Mamlaka ya Barabara za Mjini Kenya (KURA) kutoka ofisi ya Kanda ya Kaskazini-Mashariki pamoja na wanafunzi wa Shule ya Sekondari ya Yathrib wamepanda zaidi ya miche 300 ya miti ndani ya uwanja wa shule kama sehemu ya mpango wa serikali ya kuongeza kiwango chake cha misitu hadi asilimia 30 ifikapo mwaka 2032.

Zoezi hili lilisimamiwa na wafanyakazi wa Huduma za Misitu ya Kenya (KFS) ambao pia walisambaza miche ya miti. Akizungumza wakati wa hafla hiyo, Naibu Kamishna wa Kaunti wa Garissa Township, Bw Simon Mokuu, alisema kuwa zoezi hili litaimarishwa kabla ya mvua za El-Niño zinazotarajiwa ili kuhakikisha miti iliyopandwa inakuwa hadi kuwa miti mikubwa. Mokuu alisema kabla ya mvua kunyesha, mashirika husika ya serikali na jeshi zitaitwa ili kusambaza maji kwa kutumia magari yao ili kunywesha miti katika maeneo ambayo yanapata maji kupitia mabomba. "Hatutaacha miti ikae bila maji. Ndio maana tutawasiliana na jeshi na ma-

shirika mengine ili waweze kusambaza maji kwa kutumia magari yao," alisema Mokuu. Alisema eneo hilo linakumbwa na ukame mara kwa mara, lakini mvua za El Nino zinazotarajiwa zitaisaidia sana miti kuwa na ukuaji mzuri.

Naibu Kamishna wa Kaunti huyo aliwataka wakazi wa eneo hilo kupanda miti zaidi nyumbani na shambani mwao ili kuongeza kiwango cha misitu katika eneo hilo.

Mhandisi Micheal Mugo, Naibu Mkurugenzi wa Kanda ya Kaskazini-Mashariki wa KURA, alisema shirika hilo lilikuwa linajitahidi kuhakikisha upandaji wa miti unaimarishwa katika eneo hilo.

"Kama KURA, tumejitolea kuhakikisha upandaji wa miti unaimarishwa nchini kote, na hasa katika eneo la Kaskazini-Mashariki ambako mvua ni nadra na kiwango cha misitu ni kidogo," alisema Mhandisi Mugo. Alisema shirika hilo lilikuwa likishirikiana na shule ili wanafunzi wawelee umuhimu wa miti katika uhifadhi wa mazingira.

Serikali itaanzisha vituo vya ukaguzi wa kusafirisha ili kuthibitisha kontena zote zinazosafirisha madini njiani na katika bandari ya Mombasa ili kukabiliana na uchimbaji madini haramu nchini.

Waziri wa Madini, Uchumi Baharini, na Masuala ya Bahari, Salim Mvurya, alisema hatua hiyo ni moja kati ya hatua mpya zilizoanzishwa na wizara kudhibiti uchimbaji madini haramu na upotevu wa mapato.

"Mbali na kufunga maeneo ya uchimbaji madini haramu, pia tunazindua ukaguzi wa usafirishaji ambapo kontena za madini zitafungwa na pia kukaguliwa njiani kabla ya kufika bandarini Mombasa," alisema Mvurya huko Mbuvo, Kaunti ya Makueni.

Alisema wizara hiyo imejitolea kuboresha sekta ya uchimbaji madini ikiwa ni

Washikadau kutoka Ziwa Turkana wametoa ombi kwa Serikali kujenga bandari katika ziwa hilo ili kuchochea biashara kati ya kaunti mbili za Turkana na Marsabit ambazo zinashirikizi ziwa hilo. Wamesema ukosefu wa vituo vya kutia nanga pia umekwamisha usafirishaji wa majini wakati kuenea kwa mwani wa baharini kwa kiasi kikubwa kinasimamisha ukuaji na upanuzi wa sekta ya uvuvi na shughuli nyingine za kiuchumi karibu na ziwa kubwa zaidi la jangwa ulimwenguni, Kaskazini mwa Kenya.

Haya ni baadhi ya masuala yaliyoibuliwa na watumiaji wa Ziwa Turkana wakati wa mkutano wa washiriki na mchakato wa ushiriki wa umma ulioandaliwa na Idara ya Usafirishaji na Masuala ya Baharini mjini Lodwar ili kuthibitisha Rasimu ya Sera ya Usafirishaji wa Baharini ya Kitaifa (NMTP) na Sera ya Elimu na Mafunzo ya Baharini (MET).

Akitoa mchango wake kwa Kikundi cha Kazi, Dkt. Tioko Logiron, Mkurugenzi wa Kitengo cha Kuzalisha Mapato katika Chuo Kikuu cha Turkana, alitoa onyo kwa waandaliwa wa Sera ya Usafirishaji wa Baharini kutojaribu kufanya kuwa

wa kawaida usafirishaji wa baharini, akisema maji tofauti yanawasilisha changamoto za kipekee ambazo zinapaswa kushughulikiwa kwa njia tofauti.

"Sera ya Usafirishaji imefanywa kuwa ya kawaida, lakini hali ya usafirishaji wa baharini katika Ziwa Turkana sio sawa na katika maeneo mengine ya maji, kama Bahari ya Hindi au Ziwa Victoria," alisema mhadhiri wa chuo kikuu.

Idara hiyo hadi sasa imekamili mchakato wa miezi miwili wa ushiriki wa wadau na ushiriki wa umma ambao ulilenga kaunti sita za eneo la Pwani na kaunti kadhaa zinazotumia njia za maji ndani ikiwa ni pamoja na Turkana, Homabay, Kisumu, na Nakuru ili kuhakikisha ushiriki wa watu katika maendeleo ya sera hizo mbili.

Sera ya Usafirishaji wa Baharini itashughulikia maeneo ya usafirishaji wa baharini ikiwa ni pamoja na usalama, ulinzi wa mazingira ya baharini, urahisi wa biashara ya baharini, uwekezaji na miundombinu, na kazi za baharini wakati Sera ya Elimu ya Baharini itaongoza na kuhakikisha uotoaji wa mafunzo bora ya baharini nchini.
