"Wakati huo huo, tutaweka ramani na kusajili watoa huduma wote katika wote wanaounga mkono wakulima wetu kama wauzaji wa pembejeo za kilimo, wakusanyaji, wasindikaji, watoa huduma za nyanjani, vituo vya masoko, wafanyabiashara wa usafirishaji, na wengineo," aliongeza.

Alisema hii itawasaidia kuwakutanisha wakulima na watoa huduma muhimu kupitia majukwaa ya kidijitali kama vile huduma za nyanjani na huduma nyenginezo za kidijitali. Waziri alifanua kwamba, baada ya ukusanyaji wa data msingi, takribani wakulima 10 kwa kila kata, jumla ya vijana 13,350 wataajiriwa na kuingizwa katika mikataba kwa kipindi cha miezi sita hadi 12 kutoa huduma mbalimbali za usaidizi ikiwa ni pamoja na ukusanyaji wa data mara kwa mara, huduma

za nyanjani, na ushauri mwingine.

"Pamoja na watoa huduma washikadau wote, Wizara inatumia Mfumo wa Usimamizi wa Kilimo wa Kenya (KIAMIS), ambao unapata msaada kutoka Shirika la Chakula na Kilimo (FAO), Shirika la Maendeleo la Sweden (SIDA), na Benki ya Dunia," alisema. Waziri alieleza kuwa, KIAMIS ni chombo cha ICT kinachounga mkono ukusanyaji wa data wa kidijitali ulioandaliwa, uhifadhi wa data, na kushirikiana. Aidha, mfumo wa KIAMIS unaunga mkono kufanya huduma kuwa za kidijitali kama vile ruzuku ya kidijitali, ushauri wa kidijitali, na majukwaa mengine ya kidijitali. "Wiki hii, baadhi ya kaunti zimeanza kuaajiri vijana katika ngazi ya kata. Nawasihii wakulima wetu wote kujitokeza na awamu ya pili ya usajili wa wakulima wa kina ambayo itaanza wiki ya kwanza ya Septemba 2023," alisema.

Mpango wa kutwaa umiliki wa kampuni ya Kenya Petroleum Refineries Limited (KPRL) na Kampuni ya Bomba la Mafuta ya Kenya (KPC) uko katika hatua za mwisho.

Kwa mujibu wa Waziri wa Nishati na Mafuta, Davis Chirchir, hatua hii ya serikali inatarajiwa kuboresha miundombinu ya ugavi wa mafuta petroli na hivyo kuhakikisha usalama wa ugavi na ufanisi wa gharama kwa kupunguza gharama za kuchelewesha meli kumwaga mafuta. Serikali pia inatarajia kuongeza matumizi ya Gesi (LPG) nchini kupitia ustawi wa vituo vya kuhifadhi na kushughulikia uingizaji mkubwa wa LPG.

Waziri alisema serikali inataka KPC kutumia rasimili za KPRL kuongeza matumizi ya LPG kama nishati mbadala ili kupunguza changamoto za mabadiliko ya hali ya hewa.

kutasababisha matumizi bora ya ekari 370 za eneo la KPRL huko Changamwe kwa kukuza ushirikiano katika washikadau wa mafuta kupitia matumizi yenye ufanisi wa miundombinu ya mafuta ya chini iliyopo.

Alisisitiza kuwa serikali imeweka sera ya makusudi ya kuongeza matumizi ya LPG kutoka takriban kilo saba za LPG kwa kila kijiji kwa kipato

kwa kipindi cha miaka mitatu hadi mitano ijayo na kuhitaji miundombinu zaidi. Waziri huyo alionyesha umuhimu wa kutumia kituo cha kuhifadhi mafuta katika eneo hilo kwa kuzingatia akaunti imara ya KPC ya Sh150bilioni ili kuhakikisha vijana wanapata fursa za ajira.

Bw Chirchir alifanya mazungumzo na uongozi wa Kaunti ya Mombasa kuhusu jinsi wanavyoweza

kuboresha matumizi ya mali za KPRL. Alifichua kwamba, KPRL ilifungwa mnamo 2014 kwa sababu ya changamoto za uzalishaji wa kiwanda, kwani bidhaa zilizotengenezwa hazikuwa zikilingana na pato lililopangwa na hivyo hazikuleta faida.

"Kuna sababu yoyote ile ambayo KPRL haifanyi kazi vizuri kwetu kama mali kuu iliyopo ekari 370 na inayopakana na Bahari ya Hindi. Kile Baraza la Mawaziri lililofanya Julai 18 liliidhinisha ununuzi wa KPRL na KPC kupitia uhamishaji wa hisa - ununuzi kwa njia ya uhamishaji wa hisa," alisema Chirchir. Aidha, aliongeza kuwa KPC ina mtaji wa kutosha hivyo KPRL itaanza tena kufanya kazi na kuboresha uchumi wa Mombasa, kutoa fursa za ajira, na kuvutia wawekezaji.

"Tutashirikiana na Kaunti ya Mombasa kuboresha mali za KPRL ili zifanye kazi kwa faida ya watu wa Mombasa," alisema. kwa sababu tuko

# Kentaste, USAID zaungana kuinua usindikaji na uuzaji wa nazi ng'ambo

Amerika imeanzia ushirikiano na kampuni ya usindikaji wa nazi ya Kentaste iliyoko Kwale, ambayo itasaidia kutoa fursa za kiuchumi kwa zaidi ya wakulima 4,500 wa ndani.

Balozi wa Amerika Kenya, Meg Whitman, alijiunga na viongozi wa Kentaste kwa ajili ya kutangaza mradi huo uliofadhiliwa kupitia uwekezaji uliochangiwa kati ya Shirika la Maendeleo la Marekani (USAID) na Kentaste kwa kiasi cha zaidi ya dola milioni 1.6 (sawa na Sh233 milioni), ambao utasaidia juhudi za kuongeza mauzo ya bidhaa za Kentaste nchini Amerika.

Balozi wa Amerika, am-

baye aliandamana na Luke Williams, Balozi wa Australia nchini Kenya, alitangaza mradi huo wakati alitembelea kiwanda cha usindikaji wa nazi cha

Kentaste, kinachojulikana kama kiongozi katika uzalishaji wa bidhaa za nazi Afrika Mashariki.

Mabalozzi hao baadaye walitembelea mashamba

ya nazi karibu na kiwanda cha Kentaste ambayo hapo awali yalikuwa yakizalisha mafuta ya nazi, maziwa na krimu za nazi, lakini miaka kadhaa iliyopita aina ya bidhaa ilikua kwa kiasi kikubwa na kuanza kuji-muisha, unga wa nazi, na vitafunwa vya nazi.

Msaada wa Amerika kwa mradi huu unakuja kupitia ufadhili kutoka Feed the Future na Prosper Africa. Bi. Whitman alisema ushirikiano huu unatarajiwa kuongeza uwezo wa usindikaji wa Kentaste kwa asilimia 67 hadi kufikia nazi 50,000 kwa siku, kutoa ajira za wakati wote 90, na kuji-unga na wakulima wapya 1,500 kama wazalishaji.

Alisema zaidi ya asilimia 30 ya wakulima wapya watakasajiliwa watakuwa

wanawake, na kuongeza kuwa mradi huo pia utapunguza upotezaji wa chakula na taka la chakula la tani 32,500 kwa miaka miwili ijayo kwa kuongeza ufanisi wa usindikaji.

"Kupitia ushirikiano kama huu, tunaboresha biashara, kuboresha maisha, na kupambana na upotezaji wa chakula na athari zake kwa mabadiliko ya hali ya hewa," alisema balozi huyo.

The Cabinet Secretary, Ministry of Roads and Transport on 4th August 2023, through Gazette Notice Number 10132 of 2023 established the Taskforce on the Development of National Electric Mobility Policy, Strategy, Legislations and Regulations (the **e-Mobility Taskforce**).

Increasing levels of pollutant emissions are of global concern. Promotion of e-mobility is one of the strategies being adopted worldwide to combat Green House Gas (GHG) emissions and resultant climate change. At present, Kenya's Transport Sector is heavily reliant on fossil fuel and following the Paris Climate Agreement of 2015, Kenya made a commitment to reduce emissions by 32% by 2030. This target can be achieved if Kenya transitions to zero emission vehicles (electric vehicles, motor cycles, and vessels) in Kenya.

The overall objective of the e-Mobility Taskforce is to develop a National Electric Mobility Policy (the e-Mobility Policy) covering all modes of transport (road, air, rail, and maritime) to create an enabling environment for the development, growth and adoption of electric vehicles in Kenya. The following are the key objectives of the e-Mobility Policy to:

- Steer Kenya's economy to a desired low carbon climate resilient development pathway and guide the development of e-Mobility in the country;
- Provide strategic direction in order to create an enabling environment that will enhance uptake of electric vehicles and related e-Mobility infrastructure in the country;
- Provide policy guidance to the county governments on how to promote e-Mobility in their devolved functions;
- Recommend transitional measures for the adoption of electric vehicles;
- Recommend fiscal and non-fiscal incentives for the e-Mobility sector including importation, local manufacture, assembly and e-mobility infrastructure;
- Provide a framework for the end of life and disposal of electric vehicles and accessories in line with Sustainable Waste Management Act, 2022;
- Provide a framework for the development of carbon credits emanating from the e-mobility sector;
- Provide a framework for initiation, development and implementation of standards and best practice in respect of the e-mobility value chain; and
- Provide a framework for monitoring the impact of this policy implementation economically and environmentally.

Guided by Article 10 of the Constitution of Kenya that enshrines public participation as a national value, including in the development and formulation of national policies, the e-Mobility Taskforce hereby invites stakeholders, members of the public and all interested parties to provide:

- suggestion(s)/issues to be addressed;

# Mama Rachel Ruto takes lead in environmental initiatives to combat climate change

As Kenya welcomes the continent to the Africa Climate Summit 2023 in Nairobi this week, Kenya's First Lady, Mama Rachel Ruto, has undertaken several activities to address the nation's environmental challenges.

For instance, last month at Maasai Mara University, Mrs. Ruto inaugurated the Center of Excellence in Nursery Management. The Centre, created in partnership with the Kenya Forestry Research Institute, aims to empower youth and women to initiate change in their communities and build income-generating projects through commercial tree nurseries in their areas.

This project not only promotes sustainable income through commercial tree nurseries, but also significantly boosts Kenya's tree-planting goals. Tree nurseries are the backbone

of any large-scale tree-planting campaign.

After President William Ruto set an ambitious goal of planting 15 billion trees by 2032, this Centre is crucial in enhancing the availability of quality tree seedlings and supporting the national aim to increase tree cover.

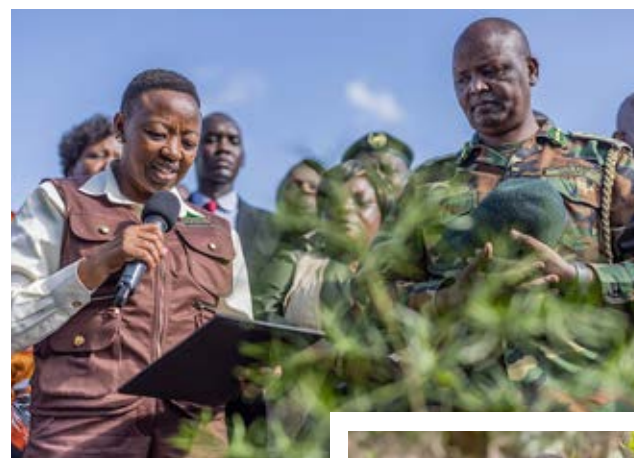
Experts estimate that by the year 2030, 54 per cent of Kenyans will be living in urban areas, which will, in turn, significantly increase the amount of solid waste in urban areas. To inspire a positive culture to-

ward waste management, the First Lady recently led a cleanliness drive in Narok town and donated 100 bins to the county government through her Mama Doing Good Initiative.

Additionally, Mrs. Ruto's engagement with students at St. Mary's Secondary School and Primary School culminated in the planting of 5,000 tree seedlings, which will improve the region's green cover.

In June, the First Lady's environmental activities were paired with a dedication to road safety. On the sidelines of the recent UN Habitat General 2nd Assembly in Nairobi, Mama Rachel Ruto launched the Global Alliance of Cities for Road Safety. This initiative, in alignment with the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs), was symbolized by a 10.8-kilometer bicycle ride from State House to the UN Office, demonstrating a

commitment to protecting cyclists on the road.

Under the "Share the Road" campaign, the First Lady underscored the importance of mutual respect between drivers and cyclists. She highlighted the essential health benefits of cycling, which align with the UN Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) on health, sustainability, and climate action.

Mama Rachel Ruto's greening campaign is spreading countrywide in a bid to inspire the nation

towards conservation and climate change mitigation.

In Kitale, for instance, she advocated for launching the Mama Forest Park by adopting 15 acres of the Kitale town forest for rehabilitation, and in a record time of 15 minutes, over 4,000 trees were planted in this 15-acre forest park. During her address, she emphasized the role of women in environmental conservation and the urgent need to transition to clean cooking tech-

nologies.

These tree-planting activities reflect the First Lady's promise to plant 500 million trees in the following decade, in line with the President's directive to enhance tree cover and counteract climate change. She has also committed to enabling every primary school to have a fruit garden called Mama Fruit Garden.

Underscoring this commitment, the First Lady inaugurated the Kakamega Forest Restoration Block at Shikusa Block in Shinyalu Constituency in June, where 30,000 trees were planted. A memorandum of understanding was signed between the Kenya Forest Service and Mama Doing Good to restore degraded forests, mirroring the First Lady's vision for a lush Kenya by restoring degraded forests.

These initiatives, especially following President Dr. William Ruto's declaration of the National Tree Growing Restoration Campaign the previous year, show the Kenyan leadership's unwavering dedication to a sustainable future.

As Kenya progresses towards its green objectives, the First Lady's initiatives show the way for an environmentally mindful na-

Afisa Mkuu wa Maji na Usafi wa Nakuru Margaret Kinyanjui alisema sehemu kubwa ya maji ya chini ya ardhi Kenya ina kiwango cha floraidi ambacho ni kikubwa kuliko vile vilivyopendekezwa na Shirika la Afya Ulimwenguni (WHO).

Mhandisi Kinyanjui alisema kutegemea sana

na wakazi, haswa katika maeneo ya vijijini, kwa vyanzo vya maji chini ya ardhi huwaweka katika hatari kubwa ya fluorosis ya meno na upotoshaji wa mfumo wa mifupa.

Kulingana na wanasayansi, mamilioni ya Wakenya wanakabiliwa na hatari ya kasoro kubwa za mifupa na kubadilika kwa rangi ya meno kutokana na viwango

vikubwa vya fluoride katika maji wanayokunywa. Miaka mitatu iliyopita, wanasayansi walifanya utafiti kuhusu viwango vya fluoride katika maeneo ya Gilgil na Njoro. Utafiti uliofanywa na Patrick Kirita Gevera na Hassina Mouri kutoka Idara ya Jiolojia, Chuo Kikuu cha Johannesburg, na Godfrey Maronga kutoka Idara ya Meno, Chuo Kikuu cha Western Cape, baada ya kuchukua sampuli wagonjwa wa meno katika Hospitali ya St. Mary-Gilgil na Kliniki ya Upasuaji wa Egerton-Njoro. Matokeo yalikuwa ya kushangaza na idadi ya wagonjwa walio na fluorosis ya meno waliokwenda Hospitali ya St. Mary-Gilgil kwa huduma za afya ya meno ikifikia asilimia 86, ambapo asilimia 54 ya wagonjwa walikuwa na fluorosis ya meno ya wastani hadi kali.

Asilimia 32 walikuwa na fluorosis ya meno kali, wakati kiwango cha fluorosis ya meno katika wagonjwa wenye umri chini ya miaka 14 kilikuwa cha juu zaidi kufikia asilimia 92 kuliko wagonjwa wazee.

# Nakuru county teams up with World Bank for Sh 28.7b agriculture initiative

The County Government of Nakuru is collaborating with the National Agricultural Value Chain Development Project (NAVCDP) to increase market participation and value addition among more than 5,000 farmers through a Sh28.75-billion World Bank funded initiative.

The County Executive Committee Member (CECM) in charge of Agriculture, Livestock and Fisheries Leonard Bor said the project will unlock new opportunities for maximizing finance and private sector investments in the value chains through a range of investments such as improved subsidy through e-vouchers and operationalizing warehouse receipt financing.

Speaking during a meeting to discuss plans for rolling out the farmers' registration programme into NAVCDP, Bor said the initiative focuses on farmers engaged in poultry, fruits, (banana, mango and avocado), vegetables (tomato and potato), coffee, cotton, cashew nuts, apiculture and pyrethrum value chains. He urged farmers across the devolved unit to register into the project, noting that it will create numerous opportunities for the county in terms of promoting agricultural development. "By registering farmers, the county will be able to gather important data about agricultural activities and better understand the needs and challenges faced by farmers in the county," the CECM said. He noted that the meeting with the NAVCDP County Project Steering Committee marks a proactive and strategic approach by the county government in promoting agricultural development and growth.

The multi-billion World Bank funded project is targeting at least 500,000 farmers in 26 counties, who are set to benefit from loans to be issued through International Development Association (IDA).

KRA will apply the year of first registration in order to harmonise treatment of used motor vehicles among various Government Agencies so as to address distortion of trade of used motor vehicles and also to bring fairness among consumers.

Further, Kenya will implement the EAC Depreciation Schedule for used motor vehicles as follows:

EAC Depreciation Schedule	
Age	Depreciation Rate
More than 1 year and less than or equal to 2 years	20%
More than 2 year and less than or equal to 3 years	30%
More than 3 year and less than or equal to 4 years	40%
More than 4 year and less than or equal to 5 years	50%
More than 5 year and less than or equal to 6 years	55%
More than 6 year and less than or equal to 7 years	60%
More than 7 year and less than or equal to 8 years	65%

### Tax Amnesty on Interest and Penalties for periods up to 31<sup>st</sup> December 2022

The Kenya Revenue Authority (KRA) would like to notify taxpayers that the Finance Act, 2023 introduced a tax amnesty on interest and penalties on tax debt for periods up to 31<sup>st</sup> December, 2022. The tax amnesty will run from 1<sup>st</sup> September, 2023 to 30<sup>th</sup> June, 2024.

The tax amnesty shall be implemented as follows -

- Where a person has paid all the principal taxes that were due by 31<sup>st</sup> December, 2022, the person will be entitled to automatic waiver of the penalties and interest related to that period and will not be required to make an amnesty application.
- Where a person has not paid all the principal taxes accrued up to 31<sup>st</sup> December, 2022, they will be required to apply to the Commissioner for amnesty on interest and penalties and propose a payment plan for any outstanding principal taxes which should be paid not later than 30<sup>th</sup> June, 2024.

The Finance Act, 2023 also deleted the tax waiver and abandonment provisions hence taxpayers are encouraged to take advantage of the tax amnesty. Taxpayers are advised to visit their nearest Tax Service Office to make payment arrangements for outstanding principal taxes and for any further clarification.

"Wakati watu wanavutiwa na maeneo ya mijini, makazi holela huanza kuibuka na Mpango wa Nyumba za Bei Nafuu (AHP) utazuia makazi haya na badala yake watu watapata nyumba bora," Arwa alisema.

Mratibu huyo wa Kitaifa wa KISIP alisema mkakati huo utashushwa hadi kuigwa na kaunti ili kushughulikia suala la makazi holela ambapo watu wanaishi katika

mazingira mabaya.

Arwa alisema: KISIP im-eundwa kuborsha makazi holela na makazi duni kwa kuunda mkakati wa kitaifa wa kutafuta njia za kujenga miundo rasmi na kaunti 33 tayari zinafanya kazi na KISIP kuhusu swala hili lakini kaunti zote hatimaye zitatafidika na mpango huo.

KISIP ina ufadhili kutoka Benki ya Dunia na Benki ya Agence Française de Développement (AFD) ya Ufaransa katika kuboresha makazi holela katika maeneo ya mijini.

Arwa alifafanua kuwa, KISIP haifanyi ujenzi wa nyumba lakini hupata umiliki kwa watu katika makazi holela kwa kuwapatia hati za umiliki ili maslahi ya watu yalindwe kupitia hati hizi na hii itawapa ujasiri wakati wanaopunga mkono uboreshaji wa makazi holela.

"Tayari tumetoa hati za umiliki 25,000 ambazo zimewafaa watu milioni moja na mara tu Mkakati huu utakapohitishwa, utaanza kutekelezwa mara moja," alisema.

### KARLO yazindua teknolojia ya uzalishaji mbegu za mahindi

Uzalishaji wa mbegu za mahindi nchini utaimarika hivi karibuni baada ya utafiti wa miaka 7 kuhusu teknolojia mpya inaozalisha mbegu za kisasa zenye mavuno bora na gharama nafuu kufanywa na Shirika la Utafiti wa Kilimo na Mifugo la Kenya (KALRO). Hii pia itapunguza gharama za bidhaa na ugumu wa kuzalisha mbegu. Maendeleo ya Teknolojia ya Uzalishaji wa Mbegu kwa Afrika (SPTA) na KALRO ziifanikishwa kupitia ushirikiano kati ya taasisi mbalimbali za utafiti na hutumia jeni ya mahindi inayojulikana kama Ms44 ambayo inaondoa umuhimu wa kuondoa tassels (sehemu ya kiume ya maua) wakati wa hatua zote za uzalishaji wa mbegu za mahindi za hybrid. Kulingana na KALRO, tassels ndiyo sehemu inayotoa poleni kwenye mimea ya mahindi na kwa kawaida hufutwa ili kuzuia kujamiiana kwa mimea hiyo ambayo inaweza kusababisha uzalishaji wa mbegu zisizo na ubora. Mkurugenzi Mkuu wa KALRO, Dkt. Eliud Kireger, alisema kwa sasa, watayarishaji wa mbegu na makampuni Afrika, ikiwa ni pamoja na Kenya, wa-

nazuia kujamiiana kwa kutoa tassels kwa mkono, ambao ni mchakato unaohitaji wakati na rasilimali nyingi, na unahusisha kuondoa tassels zinazozalisha poleni kwenye mimea ya mahindi inayozalisha mbegu. "Mchakato huu wa kutoa tassels ni wa wafanyakazi wengi, wa kubuni na unachukua muda mrefu, na ikiwa haujafanywa vizuri, unaweza kusababisha kujamiiana kwa mimea hiyo inayoweza kuathiri bidhaa za mbegu za hybrid na kupunguza uwezo wa mavuno wa mbegu za kibiasara," Dkt. Kireger alisema. Alibainisha kuwa, kupitia utafiti mkubwa uliofanywa katika vituo vya utafiti vya KALRO vya Kiboko, Embu, Kakamega na Kitale na majaribio kwa wakulima katika maeneo ya Embu, Kirinyaga, Kakamega, Busia na Bungoma, faida za SPTA kwa wakulima ni pamoja na ubora wa uhakika wa mbegu na mavuno makubwa katika mazingira yenye mavuno duni. "Teknolojia hii au bidhaa tunayoiwasilisha leo, mtu anaweza kutambua kuwa mbegu itakayozalishwa inafanya vizuri sana, inakomaa mapema hivyo inaweza kuepuka ukame. Na Wangari Ndirangu(KNA)

### Serikali yapanga kufungua vituo zaidi vya Huduma Kenya

Serikali inapanga kuboresha utoaji wa huduma kwa Wak- enya kwa kufungua vituo zaidi vya Huduma nchini kote. Afisa Mtendaji Mkuu wa Huduma Kenya, Bw Ben Kai Chilumo, alisema hili linafanyika kulingana na maono ya taasisi hiyo ya kuwahudumia Wakenya zaidi kwa kuendelea kusambaza huduma kwenye ngazi za kaunti ndogo, tayari wana vituo 52 vya Huduma katika kaunti 47 na Molo itakuwa ya tano katika ngazi ya sub-kaunti mara tu itakapofunguliwa. Akizungumzia mpango wa Huduma Mashinani unaofanyika angalau mara kumi kwa mwaka, alisema mara tu ofisi ya kaunti ndogo itakapoanza kazi, itapunguza mzigo wa kifedha unao-kuja na kutekelezwa kwa mpango huo. "Timu yetu inawafikia watu katika mazingira ya vijijini kupitia Huduma Mashinani lakini ni shughuli ghali, hivyo kuna haja ya kuwa na wadau na washirika zaidi kujiunga ili kuimarisha utoaji wa huduma," alisema Chilumo. Aliongeza kuwa hatua hiyo inafuata maoni ya umma kote nchini ya kuwa na vituo karibu na wao kutokana na gharama zinazopatikana wanapohitaji

huduma ya serikali, na vituo zaidi vitafunguliwa kwenye ngazi ya kaunti ndogo. "Tuna mpango wa kujenga kituo cha Huduma sio tu katika kaunti ndogo ya Molo bali pia katika kaunti ndogo nyingine ili kusaidia kupunguza shida zinazowakabili wenyeji na wale katika miji jirani wanapohitaji kupata huduma kutoka kwa serikali," Kai alisema. Kulingana na Afisa Mtendaji Mkuu, hii itasaidia kuokoa muda na gharama zinazotumiwa na wenyeji kupata huduma kutoka jijini. Afisa Mtendaji Mkuu alisema kuanzishwa kwa vituo vya Huduma ni kusaidia Wakenya kuelewa jinsi ya kunufaika na huduma za serikali, haswa huduma za serikali 5,000 zinazopatikana kwa njia ya dijitali. "Wafanyakazi wetu lazima waambie Wakenya jinsi ya kuki-tumikia wenyewe kwa urahisi kupitia simu zao bila msaada kutoka kwa ofisi ya serikali. Tuna nataka kuongeza upatikanaji wa huduma za serikali na pia kuwa njia ya kurudisha maoni juu ya jinsi serikali inavyoweza kuwahudumia bora," alisema. Na Emily Kadzo(KNA)
