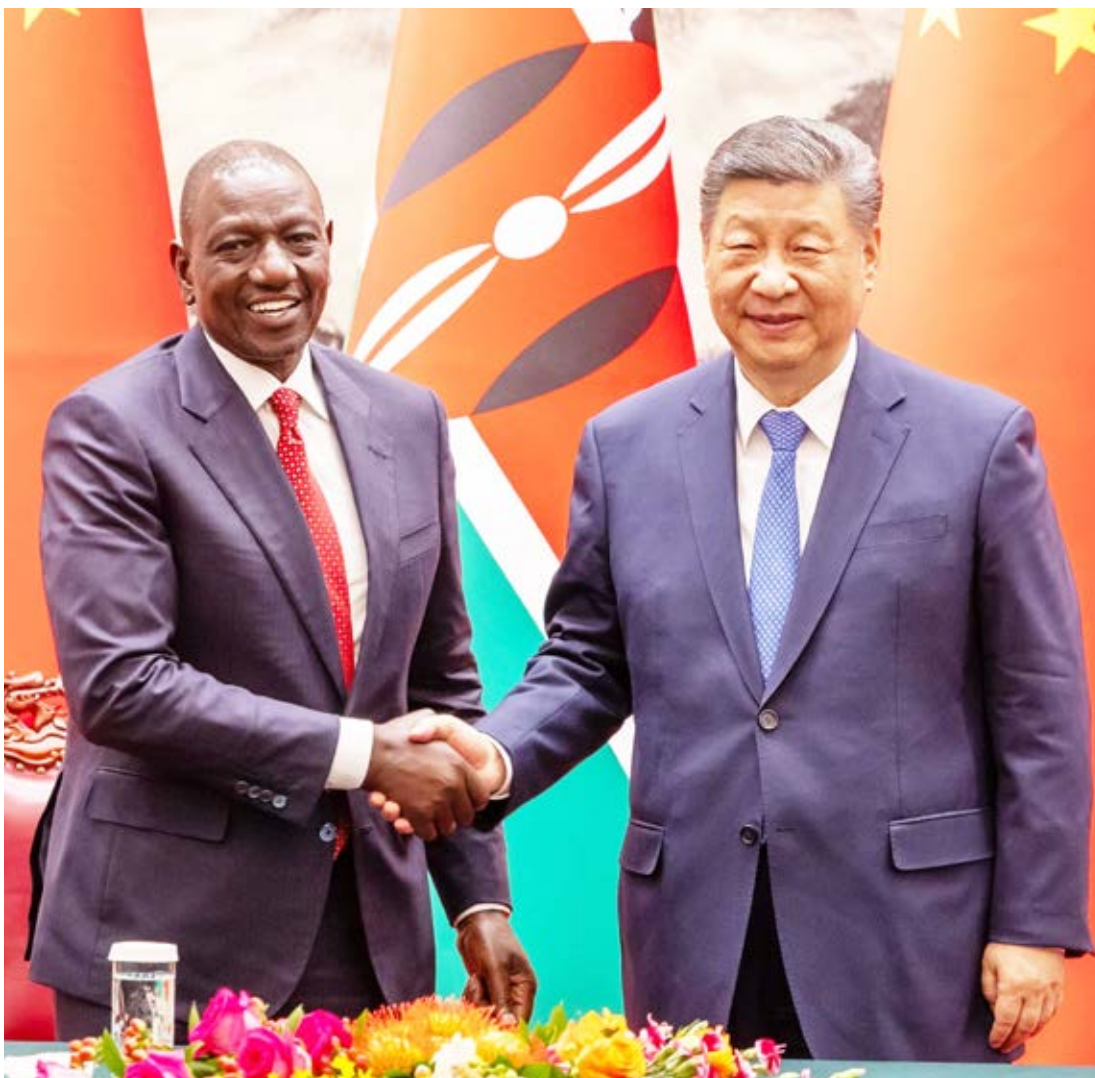

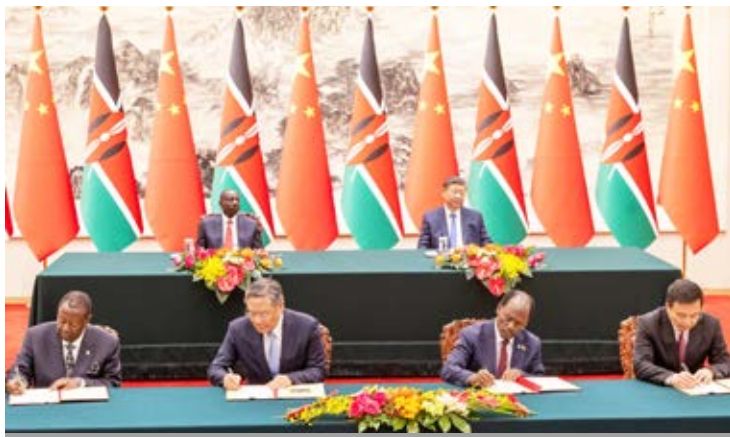

# Kenya na China zatia saina mikataba 20 ya kibiashara

inayounganisha Nairobi na sehemu za Magharibi mwa Kenya. Zaidi ya hayo, mkutano huo uliidhinisha ujenzi wa njia mbili za Kiambu-Northern Bypass, Eldoret Bypass, na daraja la Nithi. Sehemu ya ufadhili wa miradi hii itatolewa na Serikali ya China, huku sehemu nyingine ikitolewa na wawekezaji wa kibinafsi kupitia ushirikiano wa sekta ya umma na sekta binafsi (PPP). Aidha, serikali ya China na wawekezaji wa kibinafsi walielezea utayari wao wa kufadhili barabara nyingine 15 nchini Kenya. “Natarajia kuoanisha vipaumbele vya kisiasa na kijamii-kiuchumi vya Kenya, kuimarisha ushirikiano wetu wa kina wa kimkakati, na kujifunza kutokana na safari ya kipekee ya China katika utawala, maendeleo ya kiuchumi, na uongozi wa dunia,” alisema Rais Ruto wakati wa mkutano na waandishi wa habari pamoja na Rais Xi Jinping kabla ya hafla ya utiwaji saina wa makubaliano. Katika kuonyesha kuimarika kwa uhusiano wa kibiashara, uhusiano wa Kenya na China uliunuliwa kuwa “Ushirikiano wa Kina wa Kimkakati katika Enzi Mpya.”

Rais Ruto alishukuru serikali ya China kwa msaada wa hivi karibuni wa yuan milioni 100 (sawa na KSh1.7 bilioni) kusaaidia miradi mbalimbali, hususan katika sekta ya afya. Pia aliwashukuru wenyeji wake kwa msaada waliotoa kwa waathirika wa mafuriko mwaka mmoja uliopita. “Mkutano huu hauwakilishi tu viongozi wawili, bali mataifa mawili yenye historia ndefu, roho za kujivunia, na mustakabali unaofungamana katika urafiki na maendeleo ya pamoja,” alisema Rais Ruto. Nyaraka za ushirikiano wa pande mbili zilitiliwa saina

na maafisa kutoka nchi zote mbili mbele ya marais hao. Awali, Rais Ruto alipokelewa rasmi nchini China na Rais Xi kwa mizinga 21 katika Ukumbi Mkuu wa Umma. Baadaye, alisafiri hadi Jiji la Fuzhou katika Mkoa wa Fujian, kusini-mashariki mwa China, ambako alipokelewa na maafisa wa jiji wakiongozwa na Zhou Zuyi, Katibu wa Kongamano la Watu wa Mkoa wa Fujian. “Ziara yangu hapa inalenga kuthamini teknolojia ambayo China na Fujian wanajivunia, na kuitumia teknolojia hiyo kwa manufaa ya nchi yetu,” alieleza Rais Ruto.

## Public Notice

### Facilitation of Stripping of Containers for Goods Destined to Zanzibar and Pemba (United Republic of Tanzania)

On 21<sup>st</sup> February, 2018, Kenya Revenue Authority (KRA) through a Press Release, banned the stripping of containers destined for Zanzibar and Pemba in the United Republic of Tanzania on the request of the Tanzania Revenue Authority in its letter dated 28<sup>th</sup> December, 2017.

By a letter dated 29<sup>th</sup> November, 2022, the Tanzania Revenue Authority wrote to Kenya Revenue Authority requesting for the review of the ban on stripping to facilitate importers based in Zanzibar and Pemba to be able to tranship their goods from the Port of Mombasa. Kenya Revenue Authority reviewed the same and granted indulgence on stripping of cargo to Zanzibar and Pemba under the following conditions:

- Goods from the Port of Mombasa have to be entered under the Single Customs Territory Framework (SCT) in Zanzibar (Port) before they are allowed to be shipped to Pemba and Zanzibar.
- The shipments are to be cleared under SCT arrangement on duty paid basis and verified by Tanzania Revenue Authority officers stationed in Mombasa before stripping and shipment.
- Kenya Revenue Authority enforcement officers are to supervise stripping and loading of the cargo in the Port of Mombasa before shipment.

This Public Notice is meant to inform, bring clarity and require all stakeholders involved in this process to strictly adhere and comply with the conditions to avoid any inconveniences.

Members of the public and stakeholders are further notified that, this notice supersedes any other public notice issued concerning the procedure in this matter.

KRA will continue to liaise with the Kenya Ports Authority (KPA) to ensure that standard operating procedures and best practices on transshipment are implemented to protect and facilitate legitimate business.

Kwa msaada wa Benki ya Dunia, Serikali imetenga Sh33 bilioni kuunda na kuboresha fursa za ajira na kuwawezesha vijana na wanawake katika kaunti zote 47. Katika mradi wa Fursa za Vijana kwa Maendeleo (NYOTA) na Mradi wa Ajira na Mageuzi ya Kiuchumi Kenya (KJET), Waziri wa Ushirika na Mashirika Madogo na ya Kati, Wycliffe Oparanya alisema kuwa angalau vijana milioni moja wanatarajiwa kunufaika katika kipindi cha miaka mitano. Akizungumza wakati wa uzinduzi wa programu hiyo katika Shule ya Upili ya Musingu katika Jimbo la Ikolomani, Kaunti ya Kakamega, Oparanya alisema kuwa lengo la programu ya NYOTA ni kuboresha ajira kwa vijana, kuongeza mapato, na kukuza akiba miongoni mwa vijana wasiojiweza kwa kuwaunga mkono kwa vifaa na vifaa vya kuzalisha mapato. Katika Mradi wa KJET, angalau Wakenya 45,000 – ikiwa

Programu ya NYOTA inalenga vijana wenye umri kati ya miaka 18 na 29, na hadi miaka 35 kwa watu wenye ulemavu (PWDs), ikiwa na lengo la kushughulikia tatizo la ukosefu wa ajira, kuongeza uzalishaji wa mapato, na kukuza utamaduni wa akiba kati ya vikundi vya malengo. Waziri Oparanya aliwataka vijana kujisajili katika programu hiyo, akisema wataenda mafunzoni kabla ya kupokea fedha ili kuanzisha shughuli za uzalishaji wa mapato. Alisema vijana angalau 70 watateuliwa kutoka kila kata katika majimbo yote nchini. Oparanya alieleza kuwa serikali inajali kiwango kikubwa cha ukosefu wa ajira kwa vijana lakini akaisisitiza kuwa sasa kuna fursa ya kuongeza ajira kupitia maendeleo ya ujasiriamali. “Vijana wengi wanateseka; hawana kazi za kujiunga maisha yao. babu hakuna mtu anayeweza kufanikisha peke yake. Tuifanye idara kuwa kubwa kama inavyostahili," alisema Isaboke, akiwahakikishia wafanyakazi kwamba atawasikiliza na kuwapa msaada wanahitaji. Katibu alikuwa akizungumza wakati wa hafla ya kukabidhi ofisi iliyofanyika katika makao makuu ya Wizara ya Mawasiliano, Telposta Towers. Alikalia wadhifa huo akichukua nafasi ya mtangulizi wake, Prof. Edward Kisiang'ani, ambaye amehamishiwa Ofisi ya Rais kama Mshauri Mkuu katika Baraza la Uchumi la Rais. Mkutano huo ulihudhuriwa na Mwakili wa Idara na Mkurugenzi Watendaji wa Mashirika ya Serikali yaliyo chini ya Idara ya Uenezaji Habari na Mawasiliano. Wakati wa mkutano, Prof. Kisiang'ani alikabidhi baadhi ya nyaraka za Idara ya Serikali kwa mrithi wake. Isaboke pia aliagiza maafisa kuhakikisha kwamba wananchi kutoka ngazi ya chini wanapata huduma kulingana na ilani ya serikali. "Ukimtazama Rais, anazungumzia mahasla. Anaenda kwa watu wengi, sio wachache, wanataka kufikiwa," alisema. Alimsihi Katibu mpya kulinda wafanyakazi dhidi ya nguvu za nje zinazoweza kuathiri utendaji wao ili waweze kutekeleza majukumu yao kwa ufanisi, huku akishukuru maafisa kwa kumsaidia wakati wa utawala wake, jambo ambalo lilifanya kazi yake kuwa rahisi. "Mnapaswa kuendelea na ajenda ya mageuzi na juhudi za kuimarisha Mikakati ya Mawasiliano na Sera ambayo itakabidhiwa kwa Baraza la Mawaziri kwa usindikaji," alisema Kisiang'ani.

Waziri wa Habari, Mawasiliano na Uchumi wa Kidijitali, William Kabogo, alisisitiza kwamba mabadiliko ya Shirika la Posta la Kenya kuelekea enzi ya kidijitali yanatokana na imani ya serikali kuhusu jukumu kuu la sekta ya posta katika kuunganisha jamii. Katika hotuba iliyosomwa kwa niaba yake na Katibu wa Idara ya Utangazaji na Mawasiliano, Stephen Isaboke, wakati wa ufunguzi wa Mkutano wa Viongozi wa Posta wa Umoja wa Posta Duniani (UPU) Afrika huko Nairobi, Waziri Kabogo alieleza kwamba serikali imeunda Mfumo wa Kielektroniki wa Anwani wa Kitaifa, pamoja na sera na mifumo ya kisheria inayounga mkono, ili kumimarisha Posta kwa utoaji wa huduma za mwisho na biashara ya mtandao. “Kamwe nasema, rasimu ya viwango vya Mfumo wa Kielektroniki wa Anwani wa Kitaifa, Sera, na Mswada inasubiri kujadiliwa bungeni,” alisema, akiongeza kuwa mara utakapopitishwa, vyombo hivi vitaleta enzi ya dhahabu kwa Posta, haswa katika biashara ya mtandao na utoaji wa huduma za mwisho. Zaidi ya hayo, Waziri alisema kwamba serikali inatekeleza Mkakati wa Biashara ya Mtandao wa Kenya ili kumimarisha nafasi ya nchi kama kiongozi wa kidijitali barani Afrika. Kabogo alisema mkakati huu utawezesha matumizi ya huduma za biashara za mtandao zinazotegemewa na salama nchini. “Sehemu kuu za mkakati ni kuboresha miundombinu ya biashara ya kidijitali, kukuza uaminifu na ulinzi wa watumiaji katika biashara za mtandao, na kusaidia biashara ndogo, za kati, na za wajasiriamali,” alisema. Ili kuhakikisha kuwa sheria za sekta zinasisaidia ukuaji endelevu wa Posta, Katibu Mkuu alisema kwamba Wizara ya ICT inasukuma kupitia mapitio ya sheria za Posta na ICT ili kuendana na mwelekeo wa kiteknolojia na soko. Kwa hiyo, alifichua kuwa Muswada wa Marekebisho ya Sheria za Mawasiliano na Teknolojia ya Habari wa Kenya 2025 umewasilishwa bungeni kwa ajili ya kujadiliwa. “Marekebisho ya kisheria yatasaidia mdhibiti wa sekta ya ICT - Mamlaka ya Mawasiliano ya Kenya (CA) kuingiza huduma mpya na zinazojitokeza katika soko ndogo la posta na biashara ya mtandao chini ya mamlaka yake ya kisheria,” aliongeza. Utafiti wa UPU unaonyesha kuwa huduma za posta zilizoboreshwa zinaweza kuchangia karibu asilimia saba ya Pato la Taifa (GDP), lengo ambalo linaweza kufikiwa na mashirika yote ya posta katika kanda ya Afrika. Taarifa ya mwaka 2023 ilionyesha kwamba sekta ya posta ya Afrika ilichakata zaidi ya vitu bilioni 1.2, ushahidi wa uvumilivu na umuhimu wa sekta hii, unaochochewa na mageuzi ya kidijitali haraka kote barani.

# Ufundishaji wa walimu, mabadiliko ya mtaala kupisha utekelezaji wa CBE

Serikali imesisitiza tena kujitolea kwake kufanisha Elimu Inayoangazia Uwezo (CBE), na kuiweka kama mfano wa mabadiliko muhimu katika ajenda ya maendeleo ya nchi. Akizungumza wakati wa uzinduzi katika Kituo cha Kimataifa cha Mikutano cha Kenyatta (KICC), Waziri wa Elimu, Julius Migosi Ogamba, alitangaza kwamba CBE, inayojulikana pia kama Elimu Thabiti, ni msingi wa mfumo wa elimu unaojumuishwa na unaojikita katika ujuzi, ulio designed kuandaa wanafunzi kwa hali halisi za karne ya 21. “Nyuma ya kila mageuzi ya elimu kuna mtoto, ambaye ndoto zake zinategemea hilo. Sote tupo katika hili pamoja,” alisema Ogamba. Waziri huyo alisisitiza pia kwamba mfano wa CBE unategemea mashauriano ya msingi na unawakilisha sauti za jamii kote nchini. “Hisabati sasa itakuwa lazima katika njia zote

za shule za sekondari za juu,” alisema Waziri huyo, akiongeza kuwa timu ya kiufundi itafanya kazi kwa karibu na Taasisi ya Kenya ya Maendeleo ya Mtaala ili kuongoza utekelezaji wake. Vilevile, Ogamba aliwataka waelimishaji kukumbatia mbinu mpya za ufundishaji: “Lazima tuachane na kujifunza kwa kurudia (mbinu ya kukumbuka habari kwa kurudia badala ya kuelewa maana halisi au muktadha). Mwelekeo wetu ni katika mbinu za kisasa, zinazozingatia mwanafunzi, zinazochoea ubunifu, fikra za kina, na utatuzi wa matatizo,” aliongeza. Akiyasema hayo, Katibu Mkuu wa Elimu ya Msingi (PS) Prof. Julius Bitok alisisitiza kuwa CBE si tu marekebisho ya Mtaala wa Uwezo (CBC) bali ni mageuzi kamili ya mfumo wa elimu wa Kenya. “Hatuongelei tena tu kuhusu mtaala; sasa tunatekeleza mageuzi ya mfumo mzima,” alisema Prof. Bitok. PS alionyesha maoni kutoka kwa mashauriano

ya ngazi za kaunti, akitaaja Nakuru, ambapo wanafunzi walionyesha ubunifu na ujuzi wa vitendo unaoonyesha athari za kweli za elimu inayojumuisha uwezo. “Hii si tu mabadiliko ya mtaala; ni mageuzi ya kitaifa, na mustakabali wa watoto wetu unategemea jinsi tunavyotembea kwenye safari hii pamoja, kwani CBE inalingana na Dira ya 2030 na Ajenda ya Mageuzi ya Uchumi kutoka chini kwenda juu,” alisema. Kwa upande wake, Katibu Mkuu wa Elimu ya Juu na Utafiti, Dkt. Beatrice Inyangala aliongeza kusema kuwa CBE pia inabadilisha mbinu za ufundishaji na mazingira ya kujifunza. “Lazima tuachane na kuwafundisha wanafunzi kukumbuka tu. Badala yake, tunapaswa kuwaonyesha jinsi ya kutumia wanachojifunza, na watakumbuka,” alisema. Dkt. Inyangala alisisitiza umuhimu wa mafunzo ya mara kwa mara kwa walimu, ushiriki wa jamii kwa vitendo, na programu za shule

Tunapaswa kuacha kuwafundisha wanafunzi kukariri tu kile wali-chofundishwa darasani.

zilizobuniwa kulingana na muktadha wa eneo kama vipengele muhimu kwa utekelezaji mzuri wa mfano wa elimu inayojumuisha uwezo. Wakati huohuo, maandalizi ya kuanzishwa kitaifa yameanza tayari. Vyuo vikuu, vyuo vya mafunzo ya ualimu, na mashirika ya maendeleo ya mtaala vinajipanga ili kuendana na muundo wa wanafunzi wa CBE watakaotarijiwa kujiunga na vyuo vikuu ifikapo 2029. Wizara pia imedhamiria kupitia mtaala wa elimu

Elimu kwa mahitaji maalum pia imepewa ki-paumbele, huku serikali ikiahidi kuboresha miundombinu na rasilimali za kujifunza.

Upland Crop Limited itasimamia na kuendesha kiwanda cha kusaga mchele kama biashara binafsi, ikielekeza mtaji kutoka sekta binafsi ili kuhakikisha faida na uendelevu wa kifedha. Kiwanda hiki cha kusaga mchele kimeundwa kusaidia wakulima katika miradi ya umwagiliaji ya Magharibi mwa Kenya kwa kutoa soko linaloshindana na lenye faida kwa wakulima wadogo na wa kati wa mchele. Kiwanda hiki kipya, On-

Ushirikiano huu ni hatua kubwa kuelekea kufufua usindikaji wa mchele katika eneo hili

yango alisisitiza, kitasaidia kwa kiasi kikubwa kuongeza uzalishaji wa mchele wa kienyeji na kuchangia kupunguza upungufu wa mchele wa kitaifa, kulingana na Ajenda ya Mageuzi ya Kiuchumi ya Bottom-Up (BETA). Kikiwa na uwezo wa kuzalisha tani 2.5 za mchele kwa saa, kiwanda hiki kinatarajiwa kuzalisha tani karibu 60 kwa siku. 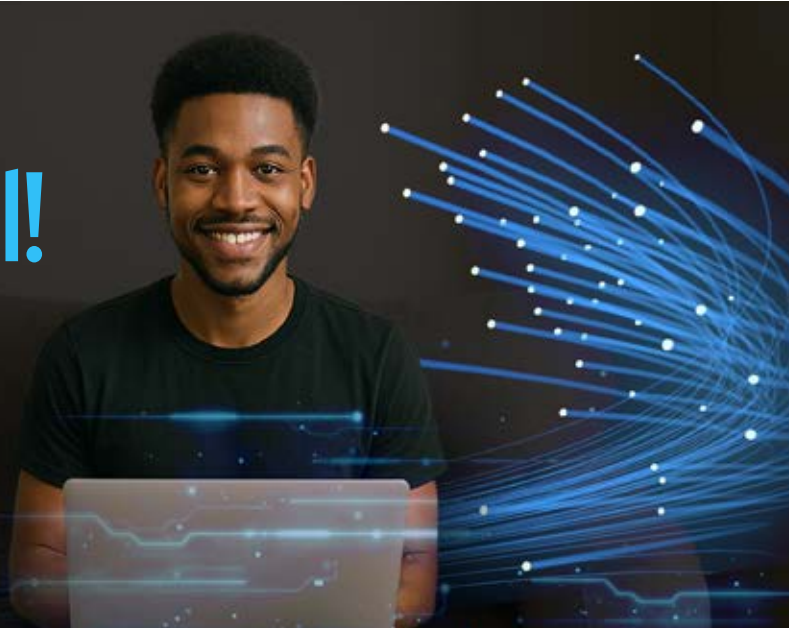

# Wasichana wa Maasai washerehekea utu uzima bila kukeketwa ilivyo desturi

**K**wa Faith Naserian, mwenye umri wa miaka 12, hofu ya Kukeketwa kwa Wanawake (FGM) ilikuwa imemvutia kwa miaka mingi. Katika jamii yake ya Wamaasai, inatarajiwa—karibu ni jambo la lazima—kwamba wasichana watapitia “kukatwa” mara watakapofikia umri wa kubalehe. Utamaduni wa FGM unaonekana kama sherehe ya

kuingia utu uzima, mabadiliko kutokautoto hadi ukuaji wa kike. Lakini Naserian daima alikuwa na ndoto ya kumaliza shule na kufuata taaluma ya uuguzi. Alijua kwamba akifanyiwa FGM, ndoto zake zingekuwa zimeporomoka, kwani angepewa shinikizo la kuacha shule na kuolewa. Aliposikia kuhusu mbadala wa sherehe za kijamii wa kuingia utu uzima (ARP), mwanafunzi huyu wa darasa la sita alijua kuwa hii ilikuwa fursa yake ya

kuachana na utamaduni huu. “Niliogopa. Nilikuwa nikiwasikia wasichana wakubwa wakisema kuhusu maumivu waliyoyapata, na nilijua kwamba sitaki kupitia hayo. Niliposikia kwamba kuna mbadala wa sherehe za kuingia utu uzima, nilijua kuwa hii ilikuwa fursa yangu ya kukwepa kukatwa,” alisema. Kwa msaada wa mama yake, Naserian alijiunga na programu ya ARP katika Shule ya Msingi ya Emarti, Kajiado Mashariki.

ARP, inayoratibiwa na Amref Health Africa kwa kushirikiana na mashirika ya kijamii na viongozi wa jamii, ni mbadala wa kitamaduni wa sherehe ya kuingia utu uzima badala ya kukeketwa. Inahifadhi desturi na sherehe za kitamaduni katika mpito wa kuingia utu uzima wa kike, huku ikibadilisha “kukata” kwa madhara. ARP inahifadhi vipengele vya kitamaduni kama baraka, nyimbo, na sherehe za alama, ikiruhusu jamii kuhifadhi utambulisho wao huku wakikataa utamaduni wa FGM. Katika kikao cha siku tatu, wasichana zaidi ya 700 wenye umri kati ya miaka 10 na 17 walipokea mafunzo ya stadi za maisha na kufanya maamuzi, afya ya uzazi na ya kijinsia, haki za watoto na usawa wa kijinsia, usafi na huduma binafsi, na malengo ya elimu na taaluma. Baada ya kikao, wasichana walipokea vyeti vilivyothibitisha mpito wao wa kuingia utu uzima bila kukeketwa. Programu pia ilijumuisha vikao kwa wazazi, wakeketeaji wa jadi, na wazee, ambapo waratibu walijadili masuala ya kitamaduni, imani potofu kuhusu FGM, na athari za kisheria za kuendeleza utamaduni huu. Kikao cha ARP kilikamilika na sherehe ya kupendeza, ambapo wasichana walikuwa wakizima mishumaa kuashiria mpito wao wa kuingia utu uzima kabla ya kupokea baraka kutoka kwa wazee, kuthibitisha mpito wao katika utu uzima bila kukeketwa. Ann Simaloi, mmoja wa washiriki, alielezea furaha

yake baada ya kupokea baraka kutoka kwa baba yake na wazee wengine. “Sisi ni furaha sana kupokea baraka kutoka kwa wazee kwani inaonyesha kuwa wametukubali kama tulivyo na kwamba bado tunakubalika katika jamii yetu ingawa hatukupitia FGM,” alisema Simaloi. Mary Mboi, ambaye alikuwa ni mkeketeaji wa jadi, alisema sasa amekataa utamaduni huo baada ya kuona madhara makubwa kwa wasichana. Mboi alifichua kuwa alikeketa wasichana kama chanzo cha kipato na hakujua madhara ya kimwili na kisaikolojia yaliyosababishwa na utamaduni huu hadi aliona msichana mmoja aliyekeketa akikaribia kufa baada ya kupoteza damu nyingi. “Nilipokeketa msichana, nilikuwa nikitoza Sh2000. Nilikuwa nikeketa wasichana kama chanzo cha kipato na pia kama sehemu ya tamaduni zetu, lakini nilipoona madhara niliyokuwa nikisababisha kimwili na kisaikolojia kwa wasichana, nilijua nilipaswa kusitisha,” alisema Mboi. Kwa mujibu wa Sharon Sipitiek, mmoja wa walimu waliowaongoza wasichana kupitia mafunzo, mfano wa ARP ni muhimu sana kwani unatoa mpito mbadala wa kuingia utu uzima kwa wasichana. Alisema kuwa kukubaliana na ARP kutasaidia kupunguza kesi za wasichana kuacha shule kutokana na ujauzito wa utotoni, hivyo kuwapa wasichana fursa ya kumaliza masomo yao na kufuata ndoto zao. “Katika jamii ya Maa, mara msichana anapokeketwa, anachukuliwa kama mwanamke ambaye anaweza kushiriki kwa urahisi katika shughuli za kijinsia. Hii imesaidia kuongezeka kwa kiwango cha ujauzito wa utotoni, ambacho kimesababisha wasichana wengi kuacha shule,” alisema

**H**uawei, kwa ushirikiano na Chuo Kikuu cha Kilimo na Teknolojia cha Jomo Kenyatta (JKUAT), ilisherehekea Siku ya Kimataifa ya Wasichana katika ICT 2025 kwa kutoa mafunzo ya uongozi na kukuza ujuzi kwa wanafunzi 100 wa kike ka-

tika fani za Sayansi, Teknolojia, Uhandisi, na Hisabati (STEM). Sherehe hiyo ilifanyika chini ya kaulimbiu ya “Kujenga Daraja la Kidijitali kupitia Uongozi na Ubunifu,” na ni sehemu ya programu ya Huawei ya Wanawake katika Teknolojia duniani kote na inalingana

Mratibu wa Programu katika Huawei, Eric Munene, alisema Huawei pia inaandaa wanafunzi kwa ajili ya uongozi kupitia Programu yake ya Mafunzo ya Usimamizi (HMTF).

# Mabwawa mapya ya Bonde la Kerio yarahisisha upatikanaji wa maji kwa maelfu

Ukamilishaji na uzinduzi wa miradi ya mabwawa ya Chebagon na Emsoo umegeuza uhaba wa maji kuwa nyingi, na kutoa mwanga mpya wa maisha kwa maelfu ya wakazi. Mwaka mmoja uliopita, wanawake na watoto walilazimika kutembea hadi umbali wa kilomita mbili kila siku kutafuta maji, wakibeba madumu mazito kwenye migongo yao au kutegemea punda katika mabonde ya Wadi ya Emsoo, Kaunti ya Elgeyo Marakwet, ambako mabwawa haya yako. Shukrani kwa Mamlaka ya Maendeleo ya Bonde la Kerio (KVDA), sasa maji safi ya bomba yanatiririka hadi majumbani katika vitongoji vinne: Nyalil, Kap-tum, Emsoo, na Kapchelal. Miradi hii miwili, iliyozinduliwa Aprili 2025, ni sehemu ya mpango mkubwa wa KVDA wa kuboresha maisha kupitia miundombinu endelevu ya maji na uhifadhi wa mazingira. Kwa wakazi wa eneo hili, si mradi tu; ni mwanzo mpya wa matumaini. Francis Chelang'aa, mwenyekiti wa kamati ya Bwawa la Chebagon, alielezea fahari yake kwa mabadiliko yaliyoletwa na mradi huu. "Kabla ya mradi huu, kupata maji ilikuwa changamoto ya kila siku. Sasa, maji yako mlangoni," alisema. "Wanawake hawalazi miki tena kubeba maji mgongoni, na idadi ya punda mabondeni imepungua sana. Maji haya yameturjeshea hesima yetu," aliongeza. Bwawa la Chebagon, ambalo limekamiliwa kwa gharama ya Shilingi milioni 41, sasa linahudumia zaidi ya wakazi 4,200 na linasaidia kumwagilia mashamba ya ekari 300. Sylvia Jepkosgei Kipchumba, mkulima kijana kutoka Chebagon, sasa anaona matumaini katika maisha ambayo hapo awali yalikuwa na kivuli cha ukosefu wa ajira. "Bwawa hili limebadil-

isha kila kitu," alisema akiwa kando ya shamba lake lenye viazi vina-vyokua vizuri. "Hapo awali tulitegemea kijito cha msimu ambacho kilikauka wakati wa kiangazi. Sasa, naweza kulima mwaka mzima," alisema. Aliongeza, "Nimepanda ekari mbili za viazi vya Kiayalandi, na mavuno yanaonekana kuwa mazuri. Kama kijana mwenye fursa chache za ajira, mradi huu wa maji umenipa malengo na kipato." Sylvia, kama vijana wengi katika eneo hilo, anatumia kilimo kukabiliana na changamoto ya ukosefu wa ajira. # Wakulima 150,000 wa viazi wafunzwa kuboresha mavuno na kilimo endelevu



Shamba la viazi katika kaunti ya Nakuru linalofanya mazoea ya kilimo kinachozingatia mabadiliko ya tabia nchi.

Zaidi ya wakulima 150,000 wadogo wa viazi wana-patiwa mafunzo kuhusu uvumbuzi na teknolojia endelevu za kilimo ili kusaidia kuongeza uzalishaji wa viazi kwa matumizi ya ndani na kuuza nje. Kupitia ushirikiano kati ya Baraza la Viazi la Kitaifa la Kenya (NPCK), Shirika la Utafiti wa Kilimo na Mifugo la Kenya (KALRO), na Chuo Kikuu cha Egerton, mafunzo haya yanakusudia kukuza uzalishaji endelevu wa viazi kwa kutumia mbinu za kilimo zinazoendana na mabadiliko ya tabia nchi. Mwenyekiti wa Bodi ya NPCK,

Prof. John Ndiritu, alisema kuwa ushirikiano huu unatekeleza mradi wa miaka mitatu uitwao “Mradi Endelevu wa Viazi Kenya” (KSPI), ambao unalenga kuongeza uzalishaji na mapato ya wakulima 150,000 wa viazi huku pia ukiunda fursa za ajira kwa zaidi ya vijana 4,000. Prof. Ndiritu alionyesha kuwa mradi wa Sh195 milioni (dola milioni 1.5) pia utawanufaisha wakulima wengine 300,000 kwa njia ya kuongeza thamani katika mnyororo wa uzalishaji. Kati ya wakulima 150,000 waliolengwa, asilimia 40 inatarajiwa kuwa wanawake, na asilimia 10 nyingine itawakilisha vijana. Mwenyekiti aliongeza

kuwa KSPI inazingatia kaunti nne kubwa za uzalishaji wa viazi nchini: Nyandarua, Meru, Laikipia, na Nandi. Kupitia mpango huu, NPCK inakusudia kuimarisha vikundi 400 vya wakulima wa viazi katika kaunti hizi kwa kuwapatia mifumo ya kibiashara iliyoandaliwa. “Mpango huu utasaidia kidijitali vikundi hivyo, kuwapatia pembejeo za kilimo, kuwafungulia masoko na kuwapa bei nzuri ya mazao yao,” aliongeza. Wakati huo, Prof. Ndiritu alisema kuwa NPCK inawapatia maafisa ugani na wataalamu wengine wa kilimo mafunzo ya jinsi ya kufundisha wakulima wa viazi kuhusu mbinu za kil-

imo za kisasa zitakazosaidia kupunguza hatari kama vile ukame, mafuriko, wadudu na magonjwa yanayosababishwa na mabadiliko ya tabia nchi. Akikitaja kuwa ukosefu wa mbegu zilizothibitishwa na mbinu duni za masoko zimeendelea kuathiri biashara ya viazi nchini, Prof. Ndiritu alisema kuwa lengo kuu la mpango huu ni kuongeza uzalishaji wa mbegu kutoka tani 900 za sasa hadi mara tatu zaidi ya kiasi hicho katika kipindi cha miaka mitatu ijayo. Alieleza kuwa uhaba wa mbegu za viazi zilizothibitishwa nchini umesababisha uzalishaji wa zao hili kudorora, ambapo uzal-

ishaji wa sasa ni tani saba kwa hekta huku uwezo wa uzalishaji ukiwa tani 40 kwa hekta. Profesa aliona kuwa mahitaji ya mbegu za viazi nchini ni tani 30,000 kwa mwaka lakini alilalamika kuwa Nakuru, ambayo ni mzalishaji wa pili mkubwa wa viazi nchini baada ya Nyandarua, inazalisha tani 6,700 pekee, huku wakulima wengi wakitumia mazao ya msimu uliopita kama mbegu, jambo alilolilaumu kwa uhaba unaoshuhudiwa nchini. Mwenyekiti alieleza kuwa kupitia mradi huu, washauri wa vijiji watafundishwa kuhusu teknolojia za kilimo cha viazi zinazozingatia mabadiliko ya tabia nchi, uvumbuzi na mbinu za usimamizi, pamoja na njia za kupunguza hasara baada ya mavuno kwa asilimia 50. Aliongeza kuwa wakulima watapata mafunzo ya kilimo cha viazi kwa mashine na mbinu za kilimo endelevu kama vile kutumia nishati ya kijani. Prof. Ndiritu alionyesha kuwa NPCK inakusudia kujenga mfumo madhubuti na wa kisasa wa uzalishaji wa mbegu za viazi ambao utaongeza upatikanaji wa mbegu bora za aina zinazofaa kwa wakulima. “Pia tunakuza usawa kwa kuhakikisha fursa sawa kwa masoko, fursa za biashara na upatikanaji wa huduma za kifedha kwa wakulima wadogo wa viazi,” alisema. Alisema kuwa kupitia mafunzo ya kina kwa wakulima kuhusu umuhimu wa mbegu zilizothibitishwa, mahitaji ya vifaa safi vya kupanda yatapanda kwa kiasi kikubwa. Prof. Antony Kibe, anayehusika na jukumu la Chuo Kikuu cha Egerton katika mradi wa KSPI, alieleza kuwa viazi ni chakula cha pili kinachotumika zaidi nchini baada ya mahindi, hivyo kuwa sehemu muhimu ya lishe na uchumi wa nchi. Alieleza kuwa zao hili ni chakula cha kimsingi na pia ni zao la biashara, linazalishwa na wakulima zaidi ya 800,000 nchini na linaajiri watu zaidi ya milioni mbili, na kuongeza kuwa linachangia zaidi ya Sh50 bilioni (takriban dola milioni 385) katika uchumi wa nchi. “KSPI pia itatoa fursa za mafunzo kwa wanafunzi wetu ambapo watapata uzoefu wa moja kwa moja katika uzalishaji na usimamizi wa viazi,” aliongeza.

## Vihiga yazindua sera ya Agro-jolojia, 2025

Kaunti ya Vihiga imezindua sera ya agro-ecology inayolenga kuongeza uzalishaji wa chakula kupitia ujumuishaji wa rasilimali za kikaboni kama pembejeo za shamba na utekelezaji wa mbinu za kikaboni. Hii ni kaunti ya pili nchini kuzindua sera kama hii baada ya Murang'a mwanzoni mwa mwaka huu.

Akizungumza wakati wa uzinduzi, Gavana wa Vihiga, Dkt. Wilbur Otichilo alisema anatumia kuhusu manufaa ya kiafya na kiuchumi ya sera hii kwa watu na aliwataka wakaazi wote kuikubali ili kuhakikisha utekelezaji wake unafanikiwa kwa ufanisi. “Kama kaunti, tutatenga rasilimali zinazohitajika kuhakikisha utekelezaji kamili wa sera hii kwa ku-

# Mabadiliko ya kidijitali na ujumuishaji wa ArdhiPay wazolea idara pato la Sh13 bilioni

Idara ya Ardhi na Upangaji wa Miji imetengeneza zaidi ya Sh 13 bilioni kama mapato mwaka huu. Mafanikio haya yamechochewa na matumizi ya dijitali, ujumuishaji wa ArdhiPay na jukwaa la kitaifa la eCitizen, na mageuzi ya usimamizi. Katika ngazi ya kitaifa, idara imetoa zaidi ya hati miliki 223,000 katika mwaka wa kifedha wa sasa pekee, na zaidi ya milioni moja tangu utawala wa sasa uingie madarakani. Kulingana na Waziri wa Ardhi, Alice Wahome, dijitalishaji kamili ya rekodi za ardhi imefanikishwa katika Nairobi na Murang'a kupitia jukwaa la Ardhisasa, huku kazi ya dijitalishaji ikiendelea Mombasa, Isiolo, na Marsabit. Idara ilishika nafasi ya kwanza katika tathmini ya hivi karibuni ya Idara za Serikali kulingana na muamala wa muda wote kwenye jukwaa la eCitizen. Wiki iliyopita, serikali ilitoa hati miliki 1,283 kwa wakazi wa Kipini East Ward katika Kaunti ya Tana River. Tukio hilo, lililofanyika katika mji wa Kipini, lilikuwa na mafanikio makubwa kwa Mpango wa Makazi wa Kipini wa ekari 7,000. Ardhi hii, iliyonunuliwa na Serikali kutoka kwa Nairobi Ranch, ina maeneo binafsi 1,283, ikijumuisha 32 zilizotengwa kwa matumizi ya umma. Bi. Wahome aliwataka wakazi kuthamini hati za umiliki wa ardhi na kufanya maamuzi yaliyo bora kuhusu matumizi yake. “Unapopata hati yako, nakushauri ufanye mashauriano ya familia—usiwe na haraka kuuza ardhi,” alisema. Vilevile alitoa hati miliki 17 za ardhi ya jamii, ambazo ni za aina ya kwanza katika eneo la Pwani. Waziri alionmba serikali kuu na viongozi wa kaunti kusaidia usajili wa ardhi za jamii ambazo bado hazijasajiliwa kwa kuwasilisha orodha kamili za

mali na kukabiliana na upotoshaji kuhusu mchakato huo. “Kama viongozi, tunapaswa kuchukua jukumu kubwa zaidi katika kurahisisha usajili huu. Hii ni kuhusu kulinda maisha, urithi, na maendeleo kwa jamii,” alisema. Waziri Wahome pia alitangaza mipango ya ujenzi wa soko la kisasa huko Kipini chini ya Mpango wa Msaada wa Miji ya Kenya, unaolenga kusaidia shughuli za uchumi za maeneo ya hapa, hasa biashara ya samaki inayostawi.

Alikuwa ameongozana na Katibu wa Utawala katika Idara ya Ardhi na Upangaji wa Kimwili, Mohamed Maalim, Mregistrar Mkuu wa Ardhi David Nyandoro, na

maafisa wengine wakuu kutoka Wizara. Mbunge wa Garsen, Ali Wario, alikaribisha hatua hiyo, akisema, “Watu wa Kipini wamefaidika kwa njia kubwa. Hati miliki zitasaidia kutatua migogoro ya ardhi ya muda mrefu, nyingi ambazo zimechochewa na siasa. Nawaomba serikali kuhakikisha soko linajengwa kusaidia uchumi wa hapa.” Seneta wa Tana River, Danson Mungatana, alikubaliana na maoni hayo, akisema, “Tuna furaha kuwa na hati zetu leo.

Sasa tumepewa haki kamili ya nchi yetu. Tumekaa miaka mingi tukisubiri. Tumejitolea kuhakikisha hati zote zilizobaki zitatoa. Masuala yoyote yatakayojitokeza yatashughulikiwa.” Mbali na tukio la utoaji wa hati, Idara ya Ardhi na Upangaji wa Kimwili ilielezea mipango kadhaa kwa kaunti, ikiwa ni pamoja na ununuzi wa ekari 5,000 kila moja katika Kibusu na Kon Dertu kwa ajili ya kuhamisha waathirika wa mafuriko.

## Kaunti, Climate Fund wasambaza miche ya thamani kwa wakulima

Serikali ya Kaunti ya Uasin Gishu, kupitia Mpango wa Ufadhili wa Hatua za Kukabiliana na Mabadiliko ya Tabianchi Zinazoongozwa na Jamii (FLLoCA), imezindua miche 166,000 ya mazao ya thamani ya juu kwa wakulima katika kaunti hiyo ili kuhamasisa utofauti wa mazao. Akizungumza wakati wa uzinduzi huo katika makao makuu ya kaunti mjini Eldoret, Gavana Jonathan Chelilim alisisitiza dhamira yake ya kuwawezesha wakulima, kuongeza uwezo wa kustahimili mabadiliko ya tabianchi na kuendeleza hatua za kulinda mazingira.



Gavana wa Uasin Gishu, Dkt. Jonathan Chelilim (wa 3 kutoka kulia) akiwa na Gavana wa Kaunti ya Turkana, Jeremiah Lomurukai (wa 4 kutoka kulia) na maafisa waandamizi wa Kaunti, wapiga picha wakati wa uzinduzi wa miche 166,000 ya mazao ya thamani ya juu katika makao makuu ya Kaunti, Eldoret, Uasin Gishu.

Dkt. Chelilim aliwataka wakulima kukumbatia utofauti wa kilimo kwa kulima mazao ya thamani ya juu kama kahawa, parachichi, macadamia na mengineyo, akisema kuwa hatua hiyo itasaidia kuboresha hali yao ya kiuchumi. Pia aliwashauri wakulima kuhakikisha upatikanaji wa maji kwa miche mara baada ya kuipokea, hasa wakati wa msimu wa ukame, ili kuhakikisha uendeleu wa kilimo cha mazao ya biashara. Gavana wa Turkana, Jeremiah Lomurukai, ambaye alikuwa ziarani katika kaunti hiyo, aliwahimiza wakazi wa Uasin Gishu kuendeleza kilimo kwa bidii kwa kuwa ndiyo uti wa mgongo wa uchumi wa taifa. Aidha, alimwomba

serikali kuu kutumia rasilimali ya maji yaliyoko kwenye bonde la Lotikipi, Kaunti ya Turkana, ambayo inaweza kuhudumia nchi nzima kwa zaidi ya miaka 72 na hivyo kuongeza uzalishaji wa chakula kutokana na upatikanaji wa maji ya kutosha kwa ajili ya umwagiliaji. Miche hiyo itasambazwa kwa wakulima wa vyama vya ushirika katika wadi za Tabsagoi (Turbo) na Tulwet-Chuiyat (Kesses), ambapo Tabsagoi itapokea miche 76,000 na Tulwet-Chuiyat miche 90,000. Wengine waliokuwepo kwenye hafla hiyo walikuwa Afisa Mkuu wa Mazingira, Mabadiliko ya Tabianchi, Rasilimali Asili na Nishati wa Uasin Gishu, Mark Some



# Mradi wa KEMFSED waimarisha sekta ya uvuvi katika kaunti za Pwani

Serikali ya Kaunti ya Kwale inatumia sekta ya uvuvi ili kuboresha maisha endelevu miongoni mwa jamii za pwani. Kwa kushirikiana na mradi wa Maendeleo ya Kiuchumi ya Jamii ya Uvuvi ya Kenya (KEMFSED), kaunti ya pwani inakuza sekta za uvuvi na ufugaji samaki katika Mombasa, Kwale, Kilifi, na Lamu. Lengo la mpango huu ni kuwasaidia wavuvi kuongeza mavuno yao na kuboresha maisha ya jamii za pwani. Mradi wa KEMFSED unatekelezwa na Idara ya Nchi ya Uchumi wa Buluu na Uvuvi kwa msaada wa Benki ya Dunia. Ukiendelea kutoka mwaka 2020 hadi 2025, mradi huu umepokelewa na fedha jumla ya Sh10 bilioni. Sekta ya Uchumi wa Buluu inajumuisha uvuvi, bioteknolojia ya baharini, ufugaji samaki, utalii, na usafirishaji wa majini na usafiri. Gavana Fatuma Achani alisema kuwa mradi huu umefanya hatua kubwa katika kujenga mfumo endelevu wa chakula cha majini. Aliongeza kuwa ushirikiano huu unafungua polepole uwezo wa uvuvi wa Kwale na kuboresha miundombinu ya uvuvi ili kushughulikia changamoto na kukuza ukuaji. Gavana pia alifichua kwamba mpango huu umewezeza katika maendeleo ya ujuzi kwa kuwafunza wavuvi 76 wa hapa kama makocha waliohibitishwa, wakiwemo wanawake wanne, kuendelea vyombo vya uvuvi na kufanya safari za uvuvi za bahari kuu. “Mradi huu si tu kuhusu

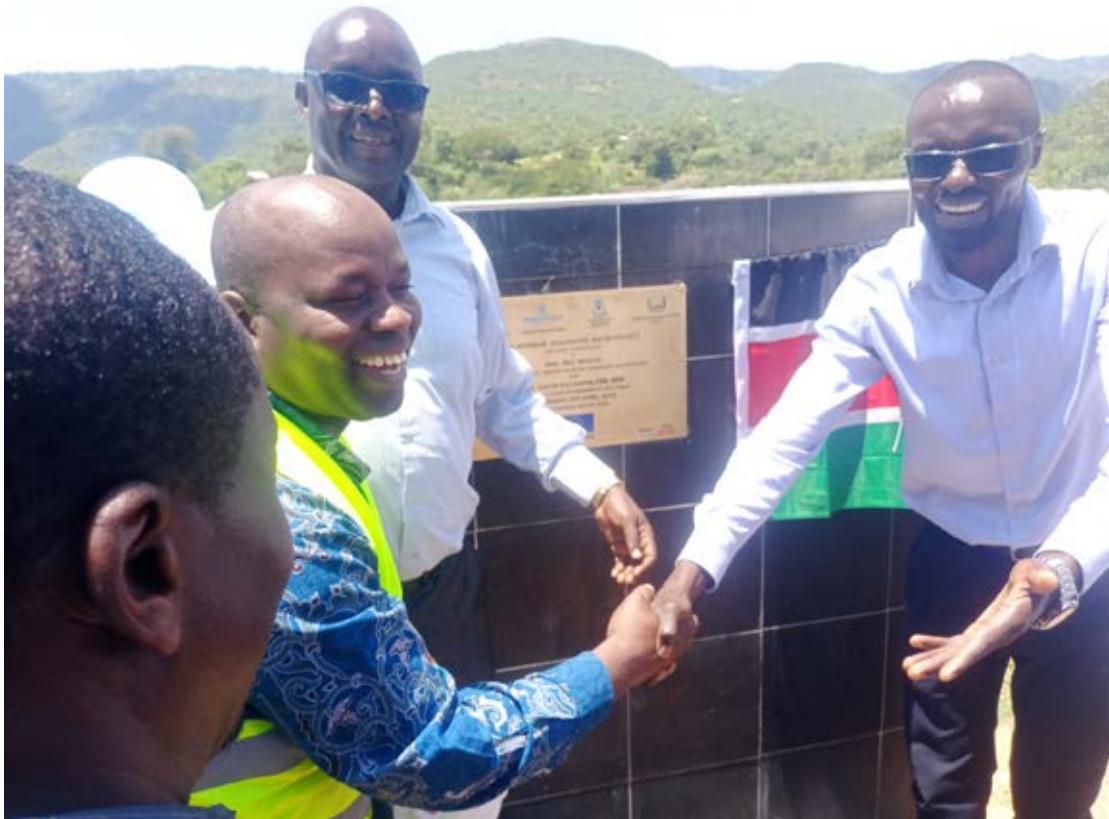
kuongeza wingi wa samaki; ni kuhusu kuboresha maisha ya wavuvi na familia zao,” alisema Achani, na kuongeza kuwa ni hatua kuelekea kuhakikisha ustawi wa muda mrefu kwa jamii za wavuvi. Achani alisema sekta ya uvuvi ya Kwale ina jukumu muhimu katika usalama wa chakula na lishe na ukuaji wa uchumi, na kwamba serikali ya kaunti inahakikisha upatikanaji wa vifaa bora, miundombinu ya kutosha na msaada wa kifedha wa kutosha. Alisema serikali inayojitawala imesambaza boti 60 za kisasa za uvuvi zenye injini za nje, vikorokoro vya uvuvi, vifaa vya GPS, na vifaa vya kisasa vya kuongeza thamani ya samaki. Vitu vingine vilivyogawanywa ni pamoja na nyavu za uvuvi za multafilament, masanduku ya baridi, miali, liners za bondi, mapambo ya maisha na majaki ya maisha kwa wavuvi wadogo ili kubadilisha uvuvi kuwa biashara yenye faida. Alisema kwamba uwekezaji huu umeboresha sana mavuno ya samaki, na kuongeza mavuno ya kila siku kwa wavuvi wa hapa katika vijiji vya uvuvi vya Tsunza, Waa, Tiwi, Mwape, Msambweni, Mkwiro, na Vanga kutoka kilo mbili hadi tatu tu hadi zaidi ya tani 1.5. “Upatikanaji wa injini za nje na vifaa vya kisasa vya uvuvi umewawezesha wavuvi wetu kuongeza kiasi cha samaki wanavovua,” alisema, akiongeza kuwa sasa wavuvi wanaweza kuvua kwa usalama na kwa njia endelevu. Mkuu wa kaunti ya pwani alisema vifaa vya kisasa vya uvuvi kama vile vyombo vya uvuvi vya bahari kuu vimewaruhusu wavuvi kufika kwenye eneo la kiuchumi la kipekee. Eneo la Kiuchumi la Kipekee la Kenya (EEZ) ni umbali wa maili za baharini 200 (370 km), unaoanza kutoka ufukweni, na kuwapa nchi haki ya kisheria juu ya rasilimali zake kama vile uvuvi, mafuta na gesi na madini mengine ya chini ya bahari ndani ya eneo hilo. Achani alisema awali, boti zilizokuwa zikitumika na wavuvi wa hapa hazikuwa na uwezo wa kuvuvi katika maji ya eneo la kiuchumi la kipekee. “Upatikanaji mdogo wa vifaa vya kisasa vya uvuvi, ujuzi usio wa kutosha, na athari zinazongezeka za mabadiliko ya tabianchi zimezuia uzalishaji wao na mapato kwa miaka mingi,” alisema. Alisema kwamba pamoja na usambazaji wa vifaa, mradi wa KEMFSED umewezeza ujenzi wa maeneo tisa ya kupokea samaki yaliyojaa vifaa vya kisasa vya kuhifadhi baridi na vifaa vya kushughulikia samaki katika vijiji vya uvuvi vya Shimoni, Vanga, Gasi, Chale, na Tsunza. Mshiriki wa Kamati ya Utendaji ya Kaunti (CECM) ya Kilimo na Uvuvi, Roman Shera alisema kwamba vifaa vipya vimewaruhusu wavuvi kuhifadhi samaki wao kwa muda mrefu, kupunguza upotevu na kuongeza faida. Shera alisema kwamba vifaa vya kuhifadhi baridi vimewaruhusu wavuvi kusambaza samaki freshi ambayo inauzwa kwa bei ya juu kuliko samaki waliokauka kwa masoko ya uvuvi ya baharini ya nje.

Mradi wa maji, ulio katika vi-

11,000 kwa kuwapatia maji safi,

duzi wa mradi huo, Waziri wa  
Maji na Usafi wa Mazingira,  
Eric Mugaa, alisema kuwa  
mpango huu ni hatua muhimu  
katika kuhakikisha upati-  
kanaji wa maji katika maeneo  
ya mbali na yaliyotengwa.  
Mugaa alibainisha kuwa mradi  
huu umepokea takriban Sh50  
milioni kutoka kwa wizara kupi-  
tia Mfuko wa Sekta ya Maji, uki-  
unganishwa na mchango wa Sh30  
milioni kutoka kwa serikali ya  
kaunti. Alifichua kuwa mifumo  
ya ufadhili ya ushirikiano ina-  
sisitiza umuhimu wa ushirikiano  
kati ya serikali kuu na vitengo  
vya serikali za kaunti katika  
kushughulikia masuala muhimu  
ya maji katika ngazi za chini.  
Waziri huyo alisisitiza kuwa  
Mradi wa Maji wa Mtem-  
bur-Kitelakapel utasaidia zaidi  
ya shule 20, hospitali za ki-  
jamii, na mahitaji ya mifugo,  
pamoja na utoaji wa huduma  
muhimu za maji kwa jamii.  
Alisema tayari miundombinu  
muhimu ikiwa ni pamoja na  
vibanda vya maji na mizinga  
vimeshachanganywa kwenye  
mstari wa usambazaji ili ku-  
punguza umbali wanaopaswa  
kutembea wakazi ili kupata maji  
kwa matumizi ya nyumbani.  
Waziri alisema vipengele muhimu  
vya mradi ni pamoja na kazi za  
kupokea maji, kitengo cha uchu-

ya maji taka ya Chepareria-Makutano, vyote vikiwianisha kuboresha usafi na upatikanaji wa maji kwa wananchi. Wakati huohuo, alieleza shukrani kwa uongozi wa kaunti ya West Pokot na wadau wa jamii,

akisisitiza kwamba utekelezaji wa mafanikio ya miradi ya serikali unahitaji juhudi za pamoja. Waziri pia alianzisha mpango wa Kenya Equality Water and Sanitation (KEYWAS), ambao unalenga kunufaisha kaunti 19 zilizo hatarini. Alifichua kuwa West Pokot ni miongoni mwa washindi wa mpango huo unaolenga kuboresha upatikanaji wa maji, usafi na huduma za usafi katika maeneo ya chini. Mugaa aliongeza kuwa mpango wa KEYWAS unalenga kuhakikisha upatikanaji sawa wa huduma muhimu na kukuza maendeleo endelevu. Katika hotuba yake, Gavana wa West Pokot, Simon Kachapin, alisisitiza umuhimu wa maji kama kipaumbele cha kimsingi kwa kila mtu, akisisitiza pia umuhimu wa kulinda na kuhifadhi rasili-mali hiyo ya thamani.

Alionyesha imani kuwa mradi wa maji ulioanzishwa utaweza kuwahudumia wakazi wa Mtembur na Kitelakapel ipasavyo, akibainisha faida zake ikiwa ni pamoja na kuwa unaendeshwa kwa mvuto wa mvuto, jambo linalopunguza gharama za matengenezo kwa ajili ya uendeleo. deleza uhifadhi wa mazingira. angalau miti milioni 1.4, na Kaunti ya Busia inachangia miti 50,000 kati ya hiyo,” alisema.

Alisisitiza kwamba afya na ustawi wa jamii yako moja kwa moja na afya ya mazingira, akionye-

sha umuhimu wa kupanda miti zaidi na kuhifadhi mazingira. “Miti hii si tu kuongeza uzuri wa mandhari yetu; ni mapafu ya dunia yetu, ikicheza ju-kumu muhimu katika kudhibiti hali ya hewa yetu, kusafisha hewa na maji yetu, na kuzuia mmomonyoko wa udongo,” alisema. CS aliongeza kuwa suluhu ya uharibifu wa mazingira inapaswa kuwa jukumu la pamoja kwa wadau wote kwa manufaa ya vi-zazi vijavyo ili kupunguza athari za mabadiliko ya tabia nchi. Kamishna wa Kaunti ya Busia, Mwachaunga Chaunga, aliwasili wakazi kupanda miti inayotoa matunda. “Tunafurahi kwamba wakazi wamekubali kupanda miti. Kila nyumba ina mti ulio pandwa. Ningependa mpande miti inayotoa matunda pia kwa sababu ya manufaa yake. Hii itatoa

chakula, kuni, mbao, kivuli na manufaa mengine,” alisema. Mwachaunga alikumbusha wakazi kuhakikisha kwamba miche yote ya miti inasajiliwa kwenye programu ya Jaza Miti kupitia viongozi wa maeneo yao kwa ajili ya kumbukumbu sahihi. Mwenyekiti wa Hifadhi ya Misitu ya Kaunti ya Busia, Brance Wanyonyi, alisema kwamba wafanyakazi wa msitu wa Port Victoria watahakikisha kuwa miti iliyopandwa inatunzwa. “Leo tumepanda miche 5,500 ya miti. Lengo letu ni kupanda miti 20,000 na tunahakikisha kabla msimu wa mvua haujaisha, tutakuwa tumepanda miti iliyobaki. Katika Bunyala, tunao ekari 601 za ardhi chini ya msitu,” alisema. Mratibu wa Kamati ya Msalaba Mwekundu wa Kaunti ya Busia, James Akello, alisema kwamba shirika linapanga kupanda miti 200,000 katika Kaunti ya Busia.

tiza umuhimu wa uhakikisho wa ubora duniani, akionyesha kuwa mataifa yanapendelea huduma zilizothibitishwa katika maeneo kama vile afya, miundombinu, na biashara. “Katika sekta ya miundombinu ya ubora (QI), lengo letu ni kuboresha ubora huku tukisaidia biashara. Nchi nyingi zinapendelea kuagiza bidhaa na huduma zilizopimwa na kuthibitishwa na taasisi zilizothibitishwa. “Kadri CSI inavyopanuka, tunawahimiza wafikirie kupanua huduma zao katika ukaguzi na uthibitishaji, pamoja na upimaji,” alisema Dkt. Ongeti. Alisisitiza kwamba KENAS itaendelea kufa-

Kwa ushirikiano na Ubalizi wa Jamhuri ya Watu wa China nchini Kenya, Chama cha Wafanyabiashara wa Kenya na China, na Hunan HaoTong Group, KEPROBA ilifanya kongamano la ngazi ya juu jijini Nairobi ambalo liliwaleta pamoja wadau wakuu kutoka

serikalini, vyama vya wafanyabiashara, na sekta ya mauzo ya nje. Lengo lilikuwa kuwapa wafanyabiashara wa Kenya maarifa na zana zinazohitajika ili kupenya na kustawi katika soko la Uchina kabla ya maonyesho, yaliyopangwa kufanyika Juni 12-15, 2025, Changsha, Mkoa wa Hunan. Akizungumza katika hafla hiyo, Afisa Mkuu Mtendaji (CEO) wa KEPROBA Bi. Floice Mukabana alisisitiza umuhimu wa ushirikiano katika kuziba pengo la kibiashara la Kenya na Uchina.

“China inasalia kuwa mshirika muhimu wa kibiashara na uwekezaji kwa Kenya. Mnamo 2024, mauzo ya Kenya kwa Uchina yalifikia dola milioni 196.8, wakati bidhaa kutoka China zilifikia dola bilioni 4.3 - kukosekana kwa usawa wa kibiashara ambao lazima tufanye kazi kwa bidii ili kushughulikia,” Bi. ### Serikali kuajiri walinzi wa misitu na maafisa wa misitu 3,000 zaidi

Wizara ya Mazingira, Mabadiliko ya Tabianchi na Misitu imeandaa Muswada wa Marekebisho ya Uhifadhi na Usimamizi wa Misitu wa mwaka 2025, pamoja na rasimu nane za kanuni na nyaraka mbalimbali zilizolengwa kurahisisha shughuli katika sekta hii na kuibadilisha kuwa biashara ya ushindani inayotoa ajira. Akizungumza wakati wa kikao kilichofanyika katika makao makuu ya Huduma ya Misitu ya Kenya (KFS), Waziri wa Baraza la Mawaziri, Deborah Barasa, alieleza kuwa Wizara imepiga hatua kubwa katika kuimarisha mfumo wa kisheria na wa kanuni unaosimamia sekta ya misitu. Waziri huyo alibainisha kuwa Wizara iko katika hatua za mwisho za kuan-daa nyaraka hizo. “Marekebisho yali-yopendekezwa yataleta mifumo ya utekezaji wa sheria, yataimarisha ushirikiano na serikali za kaunti, na kuboresha ushirikiano na vyama vya jamii vya misitu kupitia

mifumo ya kugawana faida kwa haki na uwazi,” alisema. Akizungumzia mfumo wa malipo, Barasa alihimiza sekta binafsi kuanzisha njia mpya za kufadhili na kuhifadhi misitu. “Kama watumishi wa umma, tuna jukumu wazi la kuunga mkono na kutekeleza sera za serikali kwa uadilifu na kwa kujitolea kwa maslahi ya umma,” alisisitiza. Barasa pia alitangaza kuwa serikali imepeleka askari wa misitu 2,664, wakaguzi wa misitu 102, maafisa 306, na wana-misitu 465 katika vituo mbalimbali, akitambua kuwa usimamizi wa misitu unategemea rasilimali watu yenye uwezo na ya kutosha. “Uwekezaji huu wa kimkakati katika rasilimali watu unalenga kuboresha kwa kiwango kikubwa uungalizi, ulinzi, na usimamizi endelevu wa misitu,” Barasa alieleza. Waziri huyo alithibitisha kuwa, kama sehemu ya ajenda ya mageuzi, KFS italazimika kutafuta njia za kujitegemea kifedha zaidi ya ufadhili wa serikali.

Gavana Gladys Wanga alisema kuwa kituo hicho kitahudumia idadi inayoongezeka ya wagonjwa wa saratani katika eneo hilo, akibainisha kuwa wanaouguza ugonjwa huo wanakumbana na changamoto kubwa za kupata huduma za matibabu. “Kuanzishwa kwa kituo cha huduma za saratani kutakuwa hatua kubwa kwa watu wetu. Wagonjwa wa saratani wamekuwa wakisafiri hadi kaunti nyingine kutafuta matibabu, jambo ambalo limeongeza gharama ya kudhibiti ugonjwa huo,” alisema. Gavana alisema makubaliano kati ya serikali yake na Hospitali ya Aga Khan kuhusu kuanzisha kituo hicho yatasaidia kupunguza gharama ya jumla ya usimamizi

wa ugonjwa huo. “Kuanzishwa kwa kituo hicho cha saratani, ambacho kitapatwa makazi katika Hospitali ya Mafunzo na Rufaa ya Kaunti ya Homa Bay, kitakuwa miongoni mwa urithi wangu, na ninatoa wito kwa wadau wote kukisaidia,” alisema. “Tutajitahidi kadri ya uwezo wetu kuhakikisha tunazuia ugonjwa huu usiwadhuru watu wetu, kwa sababu kinga ni bora kuliko tiba,” alisema gavana huyo. Kituo hicho kitaanzishwa kupitia mradi uitwao East Africa Comprehensive Cancer Project (EA-CCP) kwa kipindi cha miaka minne. Akizungumza baada ya kusaini makubaliano hayo katika makao makuu ya kaunti mjini Homa Bay, Mkurugenzi Mkuu wa Hospitali ya Aga Khan Kisumu, Jane Wanyama, alisema EA-CCP, unaotarajiwa kuzinduliwa Machi 2029, utanufaisha wanawake 88,900
