Serikali imesisitiza tena dhamira yake ya kuhakikisha usalama wa vyakula vilivyobadilishwa kijenetiki (GMOs) kupitia mfumo thabiti wa kisheria na kitaasisi wa usalama wa kibayolojia, unaongwa mkono na utafiti wa kisayansi uliothibitishwa kuhusu bidhaa mbalimbali. Hakikisho hili linajiri kufuatia kesi nyingi za kisheria ambazo zimezuia utekelezaji wa kibiashara na matumizi ya ndani ya bidhaa mbalimbali za GMO. Ingawa Baraza la Mawaziri liliondoa marufuku ya mi-

aka kumi mwezi Oktoba 2022 kuhusu kilimo na uagizaji wa mazao na chakula cha mifugo vilivyobadilishwa kijenetiki, kesi mpya mahakamani zimechelewesha utekelezaji wake. Kwa mujibu wa Waziri wa Kilimo Mutahi Kagwe, uamuzi wa kuondoa marufuku hiyo ulitokana na tafiti mbalimbali zilizothibitisha kuwepo kwa sera madhubuti, sheria, kanuni na miundo ya kitaasisi nchini Kenya inayohakikisha matumizi salama na ya kuwajibika ya bioteknolojia ya kisasa.

NITA kuwaidhinisha Wakenya 420,000 walio na ujuzi kazini

Mamlaka ya Kitaifa ya Mafunzo ya Viwanda (NITA) inalenga kufanya tathmini kwa watu 420,000 kupitia mpango wa Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) kufikia mwisho wa Oktoba 2025. Mpango huu wa kipekee unalenga kuthibitisha rasmi ujuzi wa wafanyakazi walioupata kupitia elimu ya kawaida au uzoefu usio rasmi, hivyo kuboresha ajira yao na ushindani katika soko la ajira. Zoezi hili ni sehemu ya agizo la rais chini ya mpango wa haraka wa National RPL Rapid Results Initiative (RRI), unaolenga kufanya tathmini na kuthibitisha ujuzi wa Wakenya milioni moja kupitia mashirika mbalimbali ya serikali kufikia Oktoba 2025. Kaimu Mkurugenzi Mkuu wa NITA, Bi. Theresa Wasike, alieleza haya wakati wa kikao cha mtandao na wakuu wa idara katika mkutano wa

kwanza wa kamati tendaji iliyoteuliwa kusimamia utekelezaji wa mpango huo. "Naibu Rais ameeleza wazi matarajio kuhusu RPL, hasa kuhusu idadi ya watu wanaopaswa kutathminiwa. Kama NITA, tumejitolea kutekeleza jukumu hili huku tukidumisha viwango vya juu vya ubora ili kulinda uadilifu wa vyeti vyetu na hadhi ya wagombea wetu," alisema Bi. Wasike. Aliwahimiza wafanyakazi wote wa NITA kuunga mkono mchakato huu kwa bidii na taaluma, na akapongeza juhudi zinazofanywa na timu zinazoshiriki tayari. Bi. Wasike alisisitiza kuwa tathmini hizo zinafuata miongozo ya Mamlaka ya Kitaifa ya Ustahiki wa Kenya (KNQA) na kudumisha viwango madhubuti vya ubora, hasa ikizingatiwa kuwa baadhi ya wagombea watatafuta fursa za ajira nje ya nchi

Hata hivyo, Kagwe alisema kesi hizo mpya ni juhudi za makusudi za kuzuia jamii zisikubali bioteknolojia za kisasa ambazo zina-weza kusaidia kutatua changamoto kama vile wadudu waharibifu, ukame, magugu na magonjwa. Alieleza kuwa uamuzi wa Baraza la Mawaziri ulikuwa ni juhudi za kushughulikia changamoto za usalama wa chakula zilizo-athiriwa zaidi na ukame wa muda mrefu, na kuongeza tija ya kilimo kupitia bioteknolojia. Waziri huyo alipuuzilia mbali madai mapya kuhusu usalama wa GMO ambayo yamekuwa msingi wa kesi hizo, akisisitiza kuwa serikali imeweka mfumo thabiti wa kisheria na kitaasi wa usalama wa kibaiolojia kupitia Sera ya Maendeleo ya Bioteknolojia, Sheria ya Usalama wa Kibaiolojia, na kanuni zake. “Dhamira ya serikali kuwezesha upokeaji wa teknolojia na ubunifu mpya ili kubadilisha hali ya tija ndogo ya kilimo nchini inakwamishwa na kesi zisizoisha,” Kagwe alilalamika. Aliongeza kuwa serikali itaendelea kusimamia uhamisho, utunzaji, na matumizi ya viumbe vilivyobadilishwa kijenetiki ili kuhakikisha usalama wa afya ya binadamu na wanyama, pamoja na kulinda mazingira. Waziri huyo aliongeza kuwa serikali inalenga kutumia bi-

oteknolojia ya kisasa kuongeza uzalishaji katika minyororo ya thamani ya kilimo na kujenga uwezo wa kukabiliana na athari za mabadiliko ya tabianchi. Kauli hiyo ilisomwa kwa niaba yake na Katibu wa Utawala katika Wizara ya Kilimo, Rashid Khator, wakati wa ufunguzi wa Mkutano wa 13 wa Mwaka kuhusu Usalama wa Kibaiolojia, ulioangazia juhudi za kujenga imani ya umma kuhusu usalama wa GMO. Profesa Jenesio Kinyamario, Mwenyekiti wa Bodi ya Usalama wa Kibaiolojia, alisema kuwa licha ya maendeleo ya GMO za

hapa nchini, kuondolewa kwa marufuku hiyo kumezua kesi kadhaa dhidi ya Mamlaka hiyo, ambazo zimeendelea kukwamisha utekelezaji kamili. Alisema Mamlaka hiyo tayari imeidhinisha mazao kadhaa ya GMO, ikiwemo pamba ya Bt, mahindi ya Bt na muhogo unaostahimili virusi, ambao kwa sasa uko kwenye majaribio ya kitaifa. Akizungumza kupitia Mkurugenzi Hussein Mohammed, Prof. Kinyamario alisema Mamlaka pia imeidhinisha GMO kama vile viazi vitamu vinavyostahimili virusi huko Kakamega,

muhogo ulioongezwa virutubisho huko Alupe (Kaunti ya Busia), na viazi vya Ireland vina-vyostahimili kuvu wa blight huko Molo (Kaunti ya Nakuru). Miradi mingine iliyopitishwa ni pamoja na mahindi yanayostahimili ukame na mtama ulioongezwa virutubisho (ABS) huko Kiboko, Kaunti ya Makueni, pamoja na majaribio ya chanjo za GMO za kudhibiti homa ya bonde la ufa kwa ng’ombe, mbuzi, kondoo na ngamia. Kwa mujibu wa Kaimu Mkurugenzi Mkuu wa Mamlaka hiyo, Nehemiah Ng’etich, maabara ya kupima GMO imeanzishwa ili kuendeleza utafiti muhimu kabla ya utekelezaji wa kitaifa. Hata hivyo, Ng’etich alilalamikia upotoshaji mkubwa unaozunguka suala la GMO nchini Kenya, na kusisitiza umuhimu wa kampeni za uhamasishaji ili kuondoa hofu ya wananchi kuhusu usalama wake. Profesa Douglas Miano kutoka Chuo Kikuu cha Nairobi alisema marufuku ya mahakama inayoundelea imezua hali ya sintofahamu licha ya miongo ya utafiti. Aliongeza kuwa Kenya inaeendelea kusalia nyuma katika biashara ya bidhaa za GMO kutokana na viziuzi vya muda mrefu vya mahakama, huku mtazamo hasi wa umma kuhusu usalama ukibaki kuwa kikwazo kikuu. Miano alibainisha kuwa Kenya, kama baadhi ya nchi nyingine za Afrika, imefikia kiwango cha chini ya asilimia tano tu cha upokeaji

kupitia mipango ya uhamaji wa wafanyakazi. “Lazima tulinde sura ya Mamlaka pamoja na nchi yetu,” aliongeza. Hadi sasa, NITA imewasajili karibu wagombea 2,000 kwa ushirikiano na wadau mbalimbali. Miongoni mwao ni shirika la Shining Hope for Communities (SHOFCO) ambalo limejitolea kusajili wagombea 1,000, huku Serikali ya Kaunti ya Nyandarua ikitarajia kufanyia tathmini wafanyakazi 400. Wadau wengine wanaounga mkono mpango huu ni pamoja na Shirika la Kimataifa la Uokoaji (IRC), Idara ya Nyumba na Maendeleo ya Mijini, Baraza la Wakimbizi la Denmark, Chama cha Wazalishaji Kenya (KAM), na Chuo cha Ufundi na Mafunzo ya Kazi cha Kibra, miongoni mwa wengine. Ili kuendeleza utekelezaji wa lengo hili la kitaifa, NITA inapanga kuandaa jukwaa wiki ijayo litakalowakutanisha Mawaziri wa Elimu na Mafunzo ya Ufundi kutoka kaunti zote 47. Jukwaa hilo litalenga kuchunguza maeneo ya ushirikiano katika utekelezaji wa RPL katika ngazi ya kaunti.

Waziri wa Habari, Mawasiliano na Uchumi wa Kidijitali, William Kabogo, amesisitiza tena dhamira ya serikali kuhakikisha upatikanaji wa intaneti ya kasi katika taasisi zote za umma. Akizungumza wakati wa ziara ya kufahamiana na ofisi za serikali katika jengo la Sauti House, Mombasa, Waziri huyo alitangaza kuwa taasisi zote za serikali zitapata huduma ya intaneti ya kuaminika na thabiti ili kuboresha utoaji wa huduma. Aidha, alithibitisha kuwa mpango wa Taifa Care unaosimamiwa na Mamlaka ya Afya ya Jamii unafanya kazi kwa ufanisi. “Haujakamilika kabisa, lakini unafanya kazi,” alisema Waziri huyo, akielezea kuridhishwa na ushuhuda kutoka kwa wagonjwa katika Hospitali ya Rufaa ya Mafunzo ya Coast General. Ili kuzuia ufasidi na kuboresha ufanisi, Waziri Kabogo alisema kuwa wizara zote za serikali zitahamia katika matumizi ya mifumo isiyo ya karatasi (paperless operations). Pia aliahidi kufufua Shirika la Utangazaji la Kenya (KBC), kwa lengo la kuligeuza kuwa shirika la kisasa linaloweza kushindana na kujipatia mapato, kufuatia mae-

ndeleo ya haraka ya kiteknolojia. Akitambua kuwa shirika hilo la utangazaji liko katika “hali mahututi,” alisisitiza kuwa hakuna fedha zitakazoelekezwa humo kabla ya usafi na mageuzi kufanyika. “Mimi ndiye mtu atakayelifanya KBC kuwa kituo cha kimataifa cha utangazaji. Naeleza hivi wazi, hilo linawezekana, lakini lazima tufanye usafi kwanza,” alitangaza. Waziri huyo alimuelekeza Mratibu wa Vipindi wa KBC Kanda ya Pwani kuwasilisha ombi

rasmi la kupatiwa mpiga video ili kusaidia kuchakata zaidi ya nyimbo 100 ambazo zimekwama katika Studio Mashinani. “Nataka kujua hali ya shughuli za KBC kote nchini, ili tuchukue hatua zinazofaa kulifanya kuwa shirika bora la utangazaji. Hilo litatekelezwa,” aliahidi. Waziri pia aliahidi kuhakikisha kuwa Shirika la Habari la Kenya (KNA) linapata ufaadhili wa kutosha ili kutekeleza majukumu yake ipasavyo.

Serikali inajenga masoko ya Skisasa 400 kote nchini ili kutoa mazingira bora ya kufanyia biashara kwa wanawake na wanaume, Naibu Rais Prof. Kithure Kindiki amesema. Prof. Kindiki alieleza kuwa ujenzi wa masoko 200 kati ya hayo uko katika hatua mbalimbali za kukamilika. Akizungumza katika Shule ya Sekondari ya AIC Mukuyuni, Naibu Rais alisema kuwa masoko hayo yatakuwa na vyumba vya baridi na vituo vya ICT, kila kimoja kikiwa na kompyuta 100, ili kuwasaidia vijana kutafuta nafasi za ajira mtandaoni na kuboresha maisha yao. “Tunataka wanawake na wanaume wafanye kazi katika mazingira ya heshima na yaliyo bora. Hawatakuwa tena wazi kwa mvua. Mradi huu utarejesha heshima yao,” alisema wakati wa harambee kwa vikundi vya kina mama na waendesha bodaboda katika eneo bunge la Kaiti. “Vijana wetu wataweza kutafuta kazi mtandaoni. Watafanya biashara kwa njia ya mtandao – hiyo ndiyo njia ya kuibadilisha nchi,” aliongeza. Kwa sasa, serikali inajenga masoko katika mji wa Makindu,

vituo vya biashara vya Kilala na Mutulani, vyote vikiwa katika Kaunti ya Makueni. Alisema pia kuwa serikali imetangaza zabuni za ujenzi wa masoko katika miji ya Kikima na Mbumbuni, katika Tarafa za Mbooni Magharibi na Mashariki mtawalia. Prof. Kindiki alisema zaidi kuwa serikali inapanga kuajiri vijana 10,000 katika kila kaunti kupitia mpango wa Kazi Mtaani uliorejeshwa. Vijana hao watarajiwa kupanda miti, kusafisha mazingira na kufanya kazi nyinginezo za kijamii kwa lengo la kupunguza ukosefu wa ajira miongoni mwa vijana nchini.

Katibu Mkuu (PS) wa Idara ya Utangazaji na Mawasiliano ya Simu amewataka wataalamu wa mahusiano ya umma kuwa vinara wa mawasiliano ya kidijitali salama, yenye uwajibikaji na jumuishi ili kusaidia kuunda mustakabali wa Afrika. Akizungumza mjini Mombasa wakati wa hafla ya kufunga Mkutano wa 36 wa Mwaka wa Chama cha Mahusiano ya Umma Afrika (APRA), Katibu Mkuu Stephen Isaboke alisisitiza umuhimu wa mawasiliano yenye uwajibikaji katika enzi hii ya kidijitali inayosheheni maendeleo ya kasi ya kiteknolojia. Isaboke alieleza haja ya kuwa na mazoea salama, ya kimaadili na jumuishi ya kidijitali huku

bara la Afrika likikabiliana na mabadiliko makubwa katika tasnia ya vyombo vya habari. Aliwataka wataalamu hao kuanzisha maswali muhimu kama vile: namna ya kushughulikia mtiririko wa kasi wa taarifa za kidijitali, jinsi ya kutumia kwa uwajibikaji zana kama akili bandia (AI) na uchambuzi wa data, na namna ya kuhakikisha mawasiliano yanabaki kuwa ya kibinadamu, yenye huruma, na yanayozingatia maadili ya Kiafrika kupitia usimulizi wa hadithi. “Mahusiano ya umma si taaluma tu, bali ni nguvu ya kuunganisha, kusonga mbele, na kuleta ukweli. Wakati taarifa zinasambaa kwa kasi ya ajabu, ni lazima tujiulize jinsi tunavyoweza kudumisha maadili, kulinda maadili ya kitamaduni, na kutumia zana kama akili bandia kwa uwajibikaji,” alisema. Mkutano huo uliowakusanya zaidi

ya wajumbe 700 kutoka nchi 24 za Afrika zikiwemo Ghana, Nigeria, Uganda, Cameroon na Gabon, uliandaliwa kwa kaulimbiu “Kubadilisha Afrika kupitia Mawasiliano Salama na Yenye Uwajibikaji ya Kidijitali: Kuanzisha Miaka 50 ya APRA.” Isaboke aliipongeza Chama cha Mahusiano ya Umma Kenya (PRSK) kwa kuandaa mkutano huo na akathibitisha kuwa serikali inatambua mchango wa wataalamu wa mahusiano ya umma katika maendeleo ya taifa. Alisema serikali ya Kenya imejitolea kushirikiana na wataalamu wa mawasiliano ili kuendeleza malengo ya maendeleo ya kitaifa, kupambana na upotoshaji wa taarifa, na kujenga jamii yenye ustahimilivu wa kidijitali. Hata hivyo, ni asilimia tisa pekee ya plastiki yote iliyowahi kuzalishwa ndiyo inayorejelewa. “Tunapoadhimisha Siku ya Mazingira Duniani 2025 chini ya kaulimbiu Kukomesha Uchafuzi wa Plastiki, Kenya inathibitisha upya dhamira yake ya kulinda mazingira,” alisema Waziri huyo. Alibainisha kuwa Kenya imejitokeza kama kinara katika kupambana na uchafuzi wa plastiki, kuanzia marufuku ya mifuko ya plastiki mwaka 2017, ambayo ilizingatiwa kwa zaidi ya asilimia 80 na kupunguza sana takataka mitaani. “Mpango wa Kitaifa wa Kudhibiti Taka Baharini (2021-2030) unaendeleza mafanikio haya kwa kulenga taka za plastiki katika mazingira ya pwani na maji safi kupitia kupunguza taka kutoka chanzo, usafi wa mazingira, uhamasishaji

na utafiti, sambamba na sera kama Sheria ya Usimamizi Endelevu wa Taka,” alisema. “Leo, tunaungana na jamii ya kimataifa kuadhimisha siku hii kwa kuimarisha tena dhamira yetu ya pamoja ya kukabiliana na mojawapo ya changamoto kubwa za mazingira za wakati wetu—uchafuzi wa plastiki,” alisema. Aliongeza: “Suluhu bunifu zinabadilisha mtazamo kuhusu taka; sasa zinachukuliwa kama rasilimali. Hapa Kenya, tunaona maendeleo ya matumaini katika kubadilisha taka za plastiki kuwa bidhaa muhimu kama vile vifaa rafiki kwa mazingira vya ujenzi, nguzo za uzio, matofali ya kupakia, vigea vya paa na hata fanicha.” Alisema kuwa ubunifu huu haupunguzi tu uchafuzi wa

mazingira, bali pia unazalisha ajira za kijani, hasa kwa vijana na wanawake, na kuchochea maendeleo ya kiuchumi ya ndani. Aidha, alisema harakati za uchumi mduara nchini Kenya zinaendelea kukua, ziki-chochewa na ubunifu wa mashinani, mashirika ya kijamii, na mashujaa wa sekta binafsi. Alibainisha kuwa wakusan-yaji taka wa sekta isiyo rasmi, ambao mara nyingi hupuuziwa, sasa wanatambuliwa na kuingizwa katika mifumo rasmi kupitia ushirikiano kati ya sekta za umma na binafsi pamoja na mipango ya taka katika ngazi ya kaunti. Alizitaka serikali za kaunti, wafanyabiashara, mashirika ya kiraia na jamii kujitokeza kuongoza katika utenganishaji wa taka, upakiaji endelevu, na suluhu za kuchakata taka katika ngazi ya ndani. “Ninapenda kusisitiza nafasi ya jamii za mashinani katika kukomesha uchafuzi wa plastiki kwa uongozi wa serikali za kaunti. Wizara yangu imejitolea kubadilisha nchi kutoka kwa uchumi wa mstari hadi uchumi mduara,” alisema. “Kuanzia sera thabiti, uongozi wa kikanda na majadiliano ya kimataifa hadi hatua za mashinani na ubunifu, tunasonga pamoja kama taifa moja, kwa lengo moja—kulinda mazingira yetu na mustakabali wetu,” alisema. Mfumo wa tathmini ya virutubisho umetengenezwa kama sehemu ya juhudi za kukabiliana na ongezeko la magonjwa yasiyoambukiza yanayohusiana na lishe (NCDs). "Soko la ajira nchini halitoi nafasi za kuto-sha kwa vijana wetu. Ndiyo maana serikali inatazama nje ya mipaka yetu ili kuwasaidia kupata ajira zenye maana

nje ya nchi," alisema. Aidha, aliwahimiza wanafunzi walioko viononi kuwa na malengo, kuwa na shauku, na kufanya bidii katika masomo yao ili kujitayarisha vizuri kwa fursa za kimataifa. Rais William Ruto, alipokuwa mwenyeji wa viongozi wa Kanisa la African Independent Pentecostal Church of Africa (AIPCA) katika Ikulu ya Nairobi, alifichua kuwa serikali yake imewezesha ajira za vijana

400,000 wa Kenya nje ya nchi katika kipindi cha siku 1,000 tangu aingie madarakani. Aliwahimiza vijana wakumbatie fursa hizo kupitia mpango wa Kazi Majuu. Dkt. Sing'oei alitoa kauli hiyo wakati wa uzinduzi wa mradi wa umeme katika Kijiji cha Tuiyok, Kaptuktuk, katika Eneo Bunge la Moiben, Kaunti ya Uasin Gishu. Alikuwa ameandamana na Mbunge wa Moiben, Prof. Phylis Bartoo, pamoja na Katibu Mkuu

wa Nishati, Alex Wachira. Mradi huo wa Shilingi milioni 220 ni sehemu ya mpango mpana wa serikali unaolenga kusambaza umeme kwa nyumba 1,245 katika Eneo Bunge la Moiben. Kwa mujibu wa Katibu Wachira, mradi huo unalenga kuziba pengo la upatikanaji wa nishati katika maeneo ya vijijini, hivyo kufungua fursa za uwezeshaji wa kiuchumi, elimu na kuinua ubora wa maisha kwa mujibu wa dhamira ya serikali.

Kenya imeweka ajira kuwa kiini cha mkakati wake wa maendeleo ya kitaifa. Akizungumza wakati wa Mkutano wa Shirika la Kazi Duniani (ILO) uliofanyika mjini Geneva, Uswizi, Katibu Mkuu wa Idara ya Serikali ya Kazi na Maendeleo ya Ujuzi, Shadrack Mwadime, alisema kuwa serikali imechukua hatua makusudi kuhamasisha ajira katika sekta zote kupitia mbinu shirikishi. Hatua hizi zinajumuisha uwekezaji katika miundombinu, motisha mahsusi kwa Biashara Ndogo, Ndogo Sana na za Kati (MSMEs), na upanuzi wa upatikanaji wa mikopo kupitia Hazina ya Hustler. Alisema serikali inaendelea kuendeleza uchumi kwa kuunda nafasi za ajira kwa vijana, hasa kupitia Mpango wa Makazi Nafuu, ambao tayari umezalishwa zaidi ya ajira 244,232 katika sekta ya ujenzi. Akijibu ripoti ya Mkurugenzi Mkuu wa ILO, Gilbert F. Houngho, wakati wa ufunguzi wa mkutano huo, Katibu Mkuu alikaribisha mada ya ripoti ya mwaka huu, akieleza kuwa inalingana kwa karibu na malengo ya Ajenda ya Mabadiliko ya Kiuchumi kwa Njia ya Chini-Kuelekea Juu ya serikali ya Kenya (BETA). Alisema BETA inazingatia kukuza ukuaji juumuishi na endelevu wa uchumi kupitia ajira zenye tija na haki ya kijamii. Katibu huyo aliongeza kuwa Kenya imeimarisha usimamizi wa uhamiaji wa wafanyakazi kupitia utekelezaji wa Mkakati wa Usimamizi wa Uhamiaji wa Kazi, unaolenga kuhughulikia changamoto ya ukosefu wa ajira miongoni mwa vijana na kutokuwepo kwa uwiano

kati ya ujuzi na mahitaji ya soko la ajira nchini. Mkakati huu unajumuisha mikataba ya ajira ya kimataifa na nchi lengwa, mafunzo ya awali kabla ya kusafiri, na huduma za kuwawezesha wahamiaji kurejea nyumbani na kujiendeleza. "Hatua hizi zimechangia pakubwa kulinda haki na kuongeza tija kwa wafanyakazi wa Kenya wanaofanya kazi nje ya nchi," alisema. Alibainisha kuwa Kenya imeharakisha mchakato wa kuingiza mikataba ya ILO iliyoridhiwa kwenye sheria za kitaifa. "Hii inajumuisha marekebisha ya hivi karibuni ya Sheria ya Ajira, Sheria ya Taasisi za Kazi na Sheria ya Usalama na Afya Kazini, ambazo sasa zimeambatana na mfumo wa kisheria wa nchi na vipaumbele vina- vyoibuka kuhusu kazi zenye staha," alisema. Aidha, aliongeza kuwa Mfumo wa Ukaguzi na Uzingatiji wa Kazi wa Kenya umebore-

shwa kupitia matumizi ya teknolojia ya kidijitali na kujenga uwezo wa maafisa wa ukaguzi. "Tunaripti kwa fahari kuwa ufuatiliaji umeongezeka na utekelezaji umeimarika katika sekta rasmi na isiyo rasmi, hasa kuhusiana na viwango vya afya na usalama kazini, usajili wa hifadhi ya jamii, na kutokomeza ajira ya watoto," alisema. Akilitambua suala la mabadiliko ya tabianchi kama changamoto kubwa yenye athari pana na madhara katika soko la ajira, Katibu huyo alisema Kenya inaweza kutilia mkazo unazishaji wa ajira za kijani. "Kenya inaweza katika ajira za kijani kupitia Mkakati na Mpango wa Utekelezaji wa Uchumi wa Kijani (GESIP), kwa kukuza kanuni za uchumi mzunguko na kujenga uwezo wa wafanyakazi kupitia mafunzo kwa ajili ya mpito wenye haki," alisema Mwadime. Hivyo basi, Kenya ilitoa wito wa "msaada mkubwa zaidi wa kimataifa katika kufadhili miundombinu yenye msisitizo wa ajira, kuimarisha mfumo wa hifadhi ya kijamii, na kusaidia mabadiliko ya haki katika nchi zilizoathiriwa na tabianchi."

NA WANGARI NDIRANGU, KNA

Mamlaka ya Kitaifa ya Usalama wa Baioteknolojia (National Biosafety Authority) imeidhinisha majaribio ya chanjo zilizobadilishwa vinasaba (GMO) kwa ajili ya kudhibiti ugonjwa wa Rift Valley Fever (RVF) kwa ng'ombe, mbuzi, kondoo na ngamia. RVF ni ugonjwa wa virusi unaoenezwa kati ya wanyama na binadamu (zoonotic) kupitia mbu na wadudu wengine, na ni kawaida katika maeneo ya Afrika na Mashariki ya Kati. Akizungumza pembeni mwa Mkutano wa 13 wa Kila Mwaka wa Usalama wa Baioteknolojia, Dkt. Martin Mwirigi, Mkurugenzi wa Taasisi ya Utafiti wa Baioteknolojia ka-

tika Shirika la Utafiti wa Kilimo na Mifugo nchini Kenya (KALRO), alisema Kenya inaachana na mbinu za jadi za kutengeneza chanjo na kuhamia kwenye baioteknolojia. “Watafiti wa Kenya wanaendelea kwa kasi katika kutengeneza chanjo za kisasa kwa ajili ya kukabiliana na magonjwa ya mifugo kwa kutumia baioteknolojia ya hali ya juu,” alisema. KALRO inashiriki kikamilifu katika utafiti na utengenezaji wa chanjo dhidi ya RVF, ikitumia baioteknolojia pia kutengeneza vifaa vya uchunguzi. “Kwenye chanjo za jadi, tunatumia virusi au bakteria kamili kuchochea kinga mwilini. Lakini kwa kutumia baioteknolojia, tunaweza kuchambua sehemu mahususi kama

vile protini au antijeni ambazo huchochea kinga bila kuingiza kiumbe chote,” alieleza. Dkt. Mwirigi aliongeza kuwa mbinu hii ya kisasa inaruhusu kutengeneza chanjo za sehemu ndogo (subunit vaccines), ambazo ni salama zaidi na zina madhara kidogo. Alitoa mfano wa chanjo ya kawaida ya RVF ambayo huweza kusababisha mimba kuharibika kwa wanyama wajawazito, lakini kutumia chanjo ya sehemu ndogo huondoa hatari hii kwa kuwa inalenga tu sehemu ya virusi inayosababisha kinga. Dkt. Mwirigi alisema chanjo zinazotokana na teknolojia hii ni bora zaidi, salama, na hutoa kinga ya muda mrefu kwa mnyama. Aliongeza kuwa KALRO pia

inafanya kazi kwenye chanjo nyingine kama ile ya peste des petits ruminants (PPR), ugonjwa wa virusi unaowaathiri mbuzi. Dkt. Mwirigi alithibitisha kuwa chanjo nyingi zinazotumika nchini hutengenezwa hapa nchini na Taasisi ya Uzalishaji Chanjo za Mifugo ya Kenya (KEVEVAPI), na kwamba chanjo za baioteknolojia zitafuata mchakato huo huo wa kutengenezwa na kuzalishwa hapa nchini. Mchakato wa kutengeneza chanjo unajumuisha kutambua protini lengwa, kujaribiwa kwa wanyama wa maabara, kuhamia kwa wanyama wakubwa, kufanyiwa tathmini mashambani, na hatimaye kuomba idhini ya kisheria. Dkt. Musa Mulongo, mtaalamu

wa utengenezaji chanjo kutoka Taasisi ya Utafiti wa Mifugo ya Kimataifa (ILRI), alisema taasisi hiyo kwa sasa inatengeneza chanjo mpya dhidi ya ugonjwa wa homa ya nguruwe wa Afrika (ASF), ugonjwa hatari unaoua karibu nguruwe wote walioambukizwa ndani ya wiki moja, kwa kutumia teknolojia ya kuhariri vinasaba (gene editing). Homa ya nguruwe wa Afrika ni virusi tata sana na hadi sasa hakuna chanjo rasmi, hivyo watu wamekuwa wakitumia mbinu mbalimbali. “Tumeunda mkakati ambao tumeyonesha kuwa unaleta ulinzi wa asilimia 100 dhidi ya aina moja ya virusi vya ASF, na tunatafuta njia ya kupanua ugonduzi huu kwa aina nyingine za virusi ili kupata chanjo kamili kwa bara lote,” alisema. Dkt. Mulongo alieleza kuwa kutengeneza chanjo si kazi rahisi; ni mchakato mgumu unaochukua zaidi ya miaka 10 kutoka wakati wazo linapobuniwa, ugonduzi kufanyika, hadi chanjo hiyo kupitishwa rasmi kuingia sokoni. Alisema nchini Kenya, mchakato huo unadhibitiwa kwa ukaribu sana na unafanywa kwa kushirikiana na Mamlaka ya Kitaifa ya Usalama wa Baioteknolojia kwa miradi ya GMO, pamoja na Mamlaka ya Dawa za Mifugo (VMD) kwa ajili ya usajili wa bidhaa. Dkt. Mulongo alihakikishia kuwa chanjo zote hupitia hatua kali za majaribio na uhakiki kabla ya kufikishwa kwa mfugaji, na hakuna chanjo inayotolewa ikiwa kuna dalili yoyote kuwa inaweza kuleta madhara. “Nataka kusisitiza bidhaa zinazofika kwa mfugaji kama chanjo za mifugo hazitawahi kuruhusiwa kama kuna shaka yoyote kuwa zinaweza kuleta tatizo. Kanuni kuu tunayoongozwa nayo na wadhibiti ni ‘kutoleta madhara’ kwanza,” alisema.

Turkana kuwekeza Sh13m katika kituo cha matumizi ya plastiki kuzuia uchafuzi

Serikali ya Kaunti ya Turkana inapanga kuwekeza Shilingi milioni 13 kumilisha na kuwezesha kituo cha kurejeleza plastiki. Waziri wa Kaunti (CECM) anayesimamia Rasilimali Asilia, Madini, Nishati, na Mabadiliko ya Tabianchi, Leah Audan Lokaala, alisema kuwa kituo hicho kitasaidia kuunda ajira na kupunguza uharibifu wa mazingira. Aliyasema hayo alipokuwa akiongoza maadhimisho ya Siku ya Mazingira Duniani katika Shule ya Msingi ya Kikristo ya Muli, kijiji cha Lokaparaparae, Turkana ya Kati. Kaunti hiyo iliungana na dunia nzima kuadhimisha Siku ya Mazingira Duniani 2025 kwa wito wa kuchukua hatua za dharura kukomesha uchafuzi wa plastiki na kulinda mi-

fumo ya ikolojia asilia. CECM Lokaala alisisitiza umuhimu wa kuwajibika kwa pamoja katika kupunguza taka za plastiki, akiongeza kuwa sasa uchafuzi huo unaaathiri hata afya ya binadamu kupitia vipande vidogo vya plastiki (microplastics). “Uchafuzi wa plastiki ni tatizo tunaloweza kuli-tatua. Mabadiliko hutokea kupitia sisi sote,” alisema. Matukio ya siku hiyo yalijumuisha upandaji miti na shughuli za ukusanyaji wa plastiki zilizoandaliwa kwa ushirikiano na mashirika ya kitaifa na asasi za kiraia. Afisa Mkuu wa Mabadiliko ya Tabianchi, Imoni Ekalale, alieleza faida za ukusanyaji katika kuokoa nishati na matumizi mengine, lakini akatahadharisha kuwa mgogoro wa uchafuzi unaozidi kukua unatishia afya ya binadamu na sayari kwa ujumla.

Ugawaji maradufu wa barabara ya Mombasa-Mtwapa yenye urefu wa kilomita 13.5 unaendelea kwa kasi na bado upo kwenye ratiba licha ya matatizo ya awali kuhusiana na utwaaji wa ardhi.

Ukifadhiliwa na Benki ya Maendeleo ya Afrika, Umoja wa Ulaya, na Serikali ya Kenya kwa gharama ya Sh7.5 bilioni, mradi huo—ambao kwa sasa ni asilimia 42 umeka-

milika—unatarajiwa kumimarisha mawasiliano ya kikanda, kukuza biashara na kuchochea utalii.

Wigo wa kazi hiyo ni pamoja na ujenzi wa njia ya magari mawili yenye njia nne, barabara za kutolea huduma, makutano yaliyotenganishwa na daraja sita, madaraja sita ya miguu, na vifaa kwa ajili ya magari yasiyo ya magari kutoka Daraja la Nyali hadi mwanzo wa Daraja la Mtwapa.

Zaidi ya hayo, mfumo wa mifereji ya maji wenye

Kulingana na Mhandisi Mkaazi wa Mamlaka ya Kitaifa ya Barabara za Kenya (KeNHA) Joseph Gichuru, mradi huo un-

ahusu zaidi kuboresha barabara hiyo kuwa njia ya magari mawili na kujenga barabara zinazoambatanana na huduma.

Ili kutatua tishio la mafuriko lililozidishwa na eneo tambarare la Mombasa, mfumo wa mifereji ya maji chini ya ardhi unajengwa kando ya barabara.

“Itakusanya maji yote kutoka barabarani na baadhi ya mali zinazopakana, hasa ndani ya eneo la Bombolulu,” alielezea Eng. Gichuru.

Hatua hii ni sehemu ya Ajenda ya Mageuzi ya Kiuchumi kwa Njia ya Chini Kuenda Juu (BETA), ambayo ni msingi wa mkakati wa serikali ya Kenya Kwanza wa kukuza ukuaji jumuishi wa kiuchumi kwa kuongeza uzalishaji, kujenga ustahimilivu, na kuwawezeshajamiizavijijini. Fedha hizo zinatarijiwa kuongeza kwa kiwango kikubwa uzalishaji wa kilimo kutoka tani 800,000 za sasa hadi lengo la tani mil-

ioni mbili. Hili litatimiza kupitia uwekezaji wa kimkakati katika matengenezo na upanuzi wa miundombinu ya umwagiliaji, mafunzo na ujenzi wa uwezo kwa wakulima, maendeleo ya miundombinu, uhifadhi wa mazingira, na ununuzi wa vifaa vya kisasa vya kilimo. Vituo vya kuhifadhi mazao baada ya mavuno na kuongeza thamani pia vitajengwa ili kupunguza upotevu na kuboresha maendeleo ya kuingia sokoni. Katibu Harsama alisisitiza kujitolea kwa serikali katika kusaidia jamii za maeneo kame, akisema kuwa mpango huu ni zaidi ya programu ya kilimo; ni chombo muhimu cha mabadiliko ya kijamii na kiuchumi na uwezeshaji wa jamii. Mkurugenzi Mkuu wa Mamlaka ya Maendeleo ya Bonde la Kerio (KVDA), Sammy N-

poros, alisisitiza umuhimu wa ufadhili huo, akisema kuwa ni hatua muhimu katika kisasa cha kilimo katika eneo hilo. 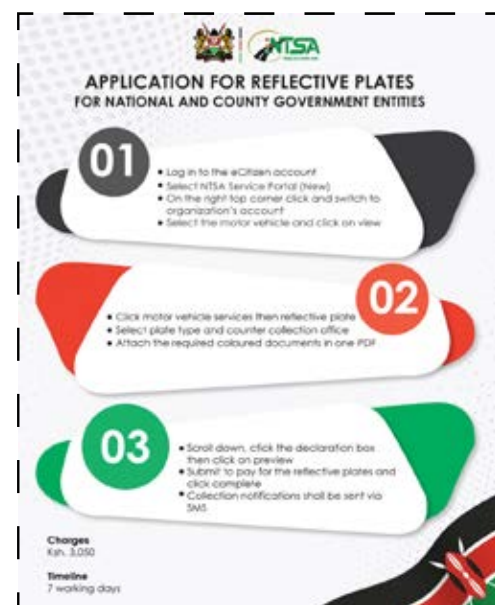

ODPP yaimarisha matumizi ya teknolojia katika vita dhidi ya uhalifu wa kimataifa

O fisi ya Mkurugenzi wa Mashtaka ya Umma (ODPP) inatumia teknolojia kuboresha mifumo yake katika vita dhidi ya ugaidi, uhalifu wa uhamishaji wa pesa, na utakatishaji wa fedha. Mkurugenzi wa Mashtaka ya Umma (DPP) Renson Ingonga alieleza kuwa mashirika ya kimataifa ya uhalifu yanazidi kutegemea teknolojia za kisasa, jambo linaloonyesha umuhimu wa teknolojia katika kukabiliana na uhalifu wa aina hii duniani. Akizungumza na wanahabari mjini Mombasa, alisisitiza haja ya ushirikiano kati ya nchi wana-chama ili kukabiliana na uhalifu tata unaovuka mipaka ya kitaifa. DPP alisema kuwa ugaidi, kama

uhalifu, unahitaji ushirikiano wa kimataifa, akitolea mfano uchunguzi uliofuata baada ya shambulio la Dusit, ambapo mamlaka za Kenya zililazimika kutegemea wataalamu wa uchunguzi wa kisayansi na washirika wa kimataifa ili kukusanya na kuchambua ushahidi. “Hizi ni jinai za asili ya kimataifa. Haziwezi kushughulikiwa na taasisi moja pekee; ndiyo maana tunahitaji aina hii ya ushirikiano ili kupambana kwa ufanisi na makosa haya,” alisema. DPP pia alieleza kuhusu kesi ya hadhi ya juu iliyohusisha kuachiwa huru kwa raia wa kigeni waliokuwa wamehukum-iwa kifungo cha maisha, uamuzi ambao sasa umekatiwa rufaa. Alieleza kuwa walifanikiwa kupata hukumu hiyo baada ya kukata rufaa dhidi ya uamuzi wa

awali wa mahakama uliokataa ushahidi wa kielektroniki. Lakini baada ya mahakama kuruhusu ushahidi huo, ulitolewa na kusebabisha hukumu hiyo, na akaongeza kuwa magaidi sasa hutumia teknolojia katika shughuli zao. Alifanua kuwa ODPP ni taasisi huru na kwamba DPP hufuata miongozo madhubuti wakati wa kuamua iwapo kesi inapaswa kufikishwa mahakamani au la. “Si kila kesi inayofikishwa mahakamani huwa na hukumu ya hatia. Ushahidi ni jambo la msingi, na unaweza kubadilika. Ikiwa ushahidi hautoshi, DPP anaweza kuamua kuondoa kesi,” aliongeza. Alibainisha kuwa ushahidi ni sehemu muhimu ya mchakato huo, kwani wakati mwingine kesi huondolewa baada ya mawakili wa utetezi kuwasili-

isha ushahidi mpya unaoweza kudhoofisha hoja za upande wa mashtaka. Katika hali nyingine, watuhumiwa huachiliwa huru baada ya timu zao za utetezi kufanikiwa kupinga ushahidi wa upande wa mashtaka. Changamoto mojawapo, kwa mujibu wa Ingonga, ni kupata mawakili walioboea wenye uwezo wa kutoa msaada wa kiteknolojia na utaalumu katika kesi za kimataifa. Alisema ni vigumu kupata utaalumu sahihi wa kisheria hasa wakati wa kushughulikia kesi tata zinazohitaji maarifa maalum. Mwanasheria Mkuu wa Kenya (AG) Dorcas Agik Oduor alisema kuna haja ya mataifa kutumia uvumbuzi wa kiteknolojia ili kuongoza katika vita dhidi ya ugaidi wa mtandaoni na uhalifu wa utakatishaji fedha.

“Lazima tuunde mbinu bora katika sekta ya sheria na tushirikiane na sekta ya kifedha ili kupambana na uhalifu wa kifedha. Uhalifu wa kifedha hauishii tu katika sekta ya fedha, bali huathiri nyanja mbalimbali za maisha yetu ya kila siku. Hivyo basi, inahitaji mbinu ya kitaifa kwa ujumla kama nchi za Jumuiya ya Madola,” alisema. Agik aliongeza kuwa tatizo la mtiririko haramu wa fedha (IFFs) huvuka mipaka na linathiri sana uwezo wa nchi kujipatia rasilimali za kuwekeza katika maendeleo endelevu. wa kifedha muhimu unaowasaidia kubaki shuleni na kuendelea na masomo yao hadi kumaliza. Katibu pia alisisitiza juhudi zinazoendelea za kutoa vifaa vya kusaidia watoto wenye mahitaji maalumu ili kuwawezesha kuhudhuria shule na kushiriki katika shughuli nyingine zinazoboresha maisha yao. Alisema chakula, maji, na upatikanaji wa elimu kupitia ufadhili wa masomo ni maeneo makuu ya wasiwasi kwa watoto, na akatoa wito kwa wadai kuhirikiana kikamilifu kuhakikisha masuala hayo yanashughulikiwa ipasavyo. Bi. Ageng'o, ambaye aliandamana na Mkurugenzi Mtendaji wa Baraza la Kitaifa la Huduma za Watoto, Abinur Sheikh, alishukuru wadai wote waliokuwa wamejitokeza kushiriki katika tukio hilo. Takriban watoto 1,000 kutoka shule mbalimbali za Kaunti ya Bungoma walihudhuria hafla hiyo. Tukio kuu la kitaifa la maadhimisho ya Siku ya Mtoto wa Afrika mwaka huu lilifanyika jana katika Kaunti ya Makueni.
